

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Health in Ackley: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Ackley,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Ackley ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Ackley's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Ackley. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Ackley that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Ackley, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Ackley compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,699, Ackley's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Ackley has a crude rate of 15.3% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 660th out of 958 lowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 12.7%, which ranks 438th out of 905 lowa communities (76th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Ackley has a crude rate of 11.4% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 656th out of 958 lowa communities (99th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 9.6%, which ranks 377th out of 905 lowa communities (70th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Ackley has a crude rate of 12.8% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 57th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 15.4%, which ranks 370th out of 905 lowa communities (60th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Ackley has a crude rate of 16.1% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 33rd out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Ackley is 21.4%, which ranks 249th out of 905 lowa communities (38th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Ackley has a crude rate of 14.5% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 117th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 16.5%, which ranks 241st out of 905 lowa communities (49th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Ackley has a crude rate of 28.1% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 726th out of 958 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 24.7%, which ranks 504th out of 905 lowa communities (85th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Ackley has a crude rate of 28.5% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 147th out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 30.6%, which ranks 330th out of 905 lowa communities (54th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Ackley has a crude rate of 34.4% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 941st out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Ackley is 24.6%, which ranks 803rd out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Ackley has a crude rate of 36.6% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 860th out of 958 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 26.7%, which ranks 304th out of 905 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Ackley has a crude rate of 10.4% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 920th out of 958 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Ackley has a crude rate of 9.2% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 311th out of 958 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 9.6%, which ranks 513th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities).



Coronary Heart Disease

Ackley has a crude rate of 8.3% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 883rd out of 958 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 4.9%, which ranks 324th out of 905 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 8.2% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 696th out of 958 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 6.0%, which ranks 305th out of 905 lowa communities (56th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 16.6% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 82nd out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 18.9%, which ranks 368th out of 905 lowa communities (56th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 11.7% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 822nd out of 958 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 8.2%, which ranks 454th out of 905 lowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities).



High Cholesterol

Ackley has a crude rate of 40.1% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 892nd out of 958 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 30.1%, which ranks 565th out of 905 lowa communities (89th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 4.0% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 890th out of 958 lowa communities (128th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 2.6%, which ranks 349th out of 905 lowa communities (65th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 35.4% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 178th out of 958 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Ackley is 36.5%, which ranks 302nd out of 905 lowa communities (45th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 4.1% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 867th out of 958 lowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Ackley is 2.6%, which ranks 375th out of 905 lowa communities (70th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 12.5% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 396th out of 958 lowa communities (58th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 12.1%, which ranks 314th out of 905 lowa communities (60th out of 138 small communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Ackley has a crude rate of 7.7% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 598th out of 958 lowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 8.4%, which ranks 658th out of 905 lowa communities (116th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Ackley has a crude rate of 84.0% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 39th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Ackley is 59.3%, which ranks 298th out of 905 lowa communities (47th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 82.8% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 591st out of 958 lowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 83.3%, which ranks 402nd out of 905 lowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 78.6% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 40th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 72.9%, which ranks 333rd out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



Cholesterol Screening

Ackley has a crude rate of 85.8% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 47th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 79.6%, which ranks 318th out of 905 lowa communities (59th out of 138 small communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Ackley has a crude rate of 74.4% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 125th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 72.2%, which ranks 250th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Ackley has a crude rate of 43.1% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 530th out of 958 lowa communities (83rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 43.0%, which ranks 507th out of 905 lowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Ackley has a crude rate of 36.5% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 704th out of 958 lowa communities (93rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 39.3%, which ranks 534th out of 905 lowa communities (92nd out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 67.7% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 416th out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 66.4%, which ranks 475th out of 905 lowa communities (85th out of 138 small communities).



Ackley has a crude rate of 75.5% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 603rd out of 958 Iowa communities (83rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 74.4%, which ranks 338th out of 905 Iowa communities (57th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Hearing disability

Ackley has a crude rate of 9.4% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 880th out of 958 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Ackley is 5.8%, which ranks 287th out of 905 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities).











The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
