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Health in Alta: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Alta,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Alta ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Alta's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Alta. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Alta that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Alta, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Alta compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,207, Alta's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In Iowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Alta has a crude rate of 14.3% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 478th out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 13.3%, which ranks 581st out of 905 lowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Alta has a crude rate of 10.0% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 245th out of 958 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 9.5%, which ranks 342nd out of 905 lowa communities (64th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Alta has a crude rate of 13.6% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 231st out of 958 lowa communities (40th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 14.2%, which ranks 79th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Alta has a crude rate of 18.5% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 305th out of 958 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 20.0%, which ranks 37th out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Alta has a crude rate of 15.1% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 187th out of 958 lowa communities (38th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 15.9%, which ranks 180th out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities).



Alta has a crude rate of 25.7% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 421st out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 24.5%, which ranks 478th out of 905 lowa communities (80th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Alta has a crude rate of 28.7% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 169th out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 29.6%, which ranks 155th out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Alta has a crude rate of 22.9% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 96th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 20.1%, which ranks 16th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Alta has a crude rate of 28.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 130th out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 25.1%, which ranks 46th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities).



Alta has a crude rate of 7.6% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 335th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 6.3%, which ranks 16th out of 905 lowa communities (2nd out of 138 small communities).



Alta has a crude rate of 9.4% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 524th out of 958 lowa communities (85th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 9.5%, which ranks 415th out of 905 lowa communities (54th out of 138 small communities).









Alta has a crude rate of 9.3% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 275th out of 958 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 8.2%, which ranks 454th out of 905 lowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities).



Alta has a crude rate of 38.2% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 748th out of 958 lowa communities (112th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 32.8%, which ranks 896th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).









Prevention



Alta has a crude rate of 9.1% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 861st out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 9.3%, which ranks 788th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Alta has a crude rate of 79.5% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 505th out of 958 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 59.3%, which ranks 298th out of 905 lowa communities (47th out of 138 small communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 72.1%, which ranks 597th out of 905 lowa communities (104th out of 138 small communities).





Alta has a crude rate of 70.6% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 630th out of 958 lowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 70.8%, which ranks 474th out of 905 lowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Alta has a crude rate of 44.2% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 396th out of 958 lowa communities (64th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 44.8%, which ranks 332nd out of 905 lowa communities (62nd out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Alta has a crude rate of 40.0% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 392nd out of 958 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 42.1%, which ranks 266th out of 905 lowa communities (54th out of 138 small communities).



Alta has a crude rate of 67.7% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 416th out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 67.3%, which ranks 377th out of 905 lowa communities (74th out of 138 small communities).





Alta has a crude rate of 7.2% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 411th out of 958 lowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Alta is 5.9%, which ranks 360th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities).













This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
