

Health in Audubon: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Audubon,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Audubon ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Audubon's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Audubon. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Audubon that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Audubon, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Audubon compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,089, Audubon's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Audubon has a crude rate of 18.5% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 930th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 15.5%, which ranks 828th out of 905 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Audubon has a crude rate of 13.1% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 929th out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 11.1%, which ranks 816th out of 905 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Audubon has a crude rate of 14.4% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 514th out of 958 lowa communities (87th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 17.0%, which ranks 850th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Audubon has a crude rate of 16.0% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 29th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 20.8%, which ranks 124th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Audubon has a crude rate of 18.0% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 694th out of 958 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 20.5%, which ranks 840th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Audubon has a crude rate of 31.2% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 917th out of 958 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 27.3%, which ranks 795th out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Audubon has a crude rate of 30.4% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 498th out of 958 lowa communities (87th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 32.6%, which ranks 794th out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Audubon has a crude rate of 34.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 934th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 25.0%, which ranks 855th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Audubon has a crude rate of 38.8% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 930th out of 958 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 29.2%, which ranks 798th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Audubon has a crude rate of 10.3% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 913th out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Audubon has a crude rate of 9.5% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 625th out of 958 lowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 10.0%, which ranks 805th out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Coronary Heart Disease

Audubon has a crude rate of 9.1% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 935th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 5.6%, which ranks 797th out of 905 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 10.0% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 937th out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 7.5%, which ranks 842nd out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 17.9% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 424th out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 20.3%, which ranks 797th out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).



Diabetes

Audubon has a crude rate of 13.0% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 930th out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 9.3%, which ranks 802nd out of 905 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities).



High Cholesterol

Audubon has a crude rate of 40.1% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 892nd out of 958 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 30.4%, which ranks 669th out of 905 lowa communities (111th out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 4.3% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 938th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 2.8%, which ranks 762nd out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 38.3% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 586th out of 958 lowa communities (99th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 39.6%, which ranks 725th out of 905 lowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 4.6% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 937th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 2.9%, which ranks 781st out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 16.5% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 885th out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 15.8%, which ranks 820th out of 905 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Audubon has a crude rate of 8.9% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 841st out of 958 lowa communities (128th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 9.3%, which ranks 788th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Audubon has a crude rate of 83.6% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 55th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 59.8%, which ranks 126th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities).



Cervical Cancer Screening

Audubon has a crude rate of 81.8% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 768th out of 958 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 81.7%, which ranks 762nd out of 905 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 77.9% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 81st out of 958 lowa communities (15th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 72.6%, which ranks 435th out of 905 lowa communities (70th out of 138 small communities).



Cholesterol Screening

Audubon has a crude rate of 83.4% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 317th out of 958 lowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 77.1%, which ranks 851st out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Audubon has a crude rate of 70.5% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 643rd out of 958 lowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 68.1%, which ranks 853rd out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Audubon has a crude rate of 39.6% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 848th out of 958 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 40.0%, which ranks 754th out of 905 lowa communities (126th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Audubon has a crude rate of 34.0% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 886th out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 36.6%, which ranks 781st out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 62.1% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 874th out of 958 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 61.1%, which ranks 839th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Audubon has a crude rate of 72.3% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 929th out of 958 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 70.9%, which ranks 825th out of 905 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Audubon has a crude rate of 10.3% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 935th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Audubon is 6.5%, which ranks 766th out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).





Cognitive disability

Audubon has a crude rate of 12.7% for cognitive disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 839th out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). 



This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
