

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# Health in Cedar Rapids: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Cedar Rapids,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Cedar Rapids ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Cedar Rapids's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Cedar Rapids. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

# **How to Use this Report**


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Cedar Rapids that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Cedar Rapids, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Cedar Rapids compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 136,929, Cedar Rapids's similarly sized communities are defined as large communities. In Iowa, large communities have an average population of 91,321, and there are 11 communities that are considered large communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

#### Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

## **Health Status**


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. #### **Poor General Health**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 12.8% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 232nd out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 12.6%, which ranks 410th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Poor Physical Health**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 9.7% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 183rd out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 9.6%, which ranks 377th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Poor Mental Health**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 15.6% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 840th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 15.5%, which ranks 405th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities).

# **Health Risk Behaviors**


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. ## **Binge Drinking**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 21.8% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 814th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 22.1%, which ranks 478th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Current Smoking**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 16.3% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 353rd out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 16.9%, which ranks 311th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Physical Inactivity**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 22.9% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 167th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 22.7%, which ranks 255th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities).



## Sleep <7 hours

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 31.0% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 630th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 31.4%, which ranks 506th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).

# **Health Outcomes**


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. #### **Arthritis**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 22.1% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 72nd out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 21.7%, which ranks 110th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



#### **High Blood Pressure**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 30.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 269th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 29.7%, which ranks 842nd out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).



#### Cancer (except skin)

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 6.6% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 108th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 6.4%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Current Asthma**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 9.7% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 781st out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 9.7%, which ranks 628th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Coronary Heart Disease**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 5.1% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 137th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 4.9%, which ranks 324th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 6.2% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 155th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 6.1%, which ranks 346th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).



Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 21.3% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 931st out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 21.3%, which ranks 869th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Diabetes**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 8.5% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 154th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 8.4%, which ranks 567th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



## **High Cholesterol**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 32.7% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 96th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 29.8%, which ranks 467th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 2.7% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 135th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 2.6%, which ranks 349th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 38.7% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 650th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 39.4%, which ranks 702nd out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).





Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 11.9% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 300th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 11.7%, which ranks 242nd out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).

# **Prevention**



#### **Lack of Health Insurance**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 7.5% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 533rd out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 7.6%, which ranks 397th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Taking BP Medication**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 76.0% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 843rd out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 60.3%, which ranks 63rd out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Cervical Cancer Screening**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 84.3% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 254th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 85.0%, which ranks 87th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



#### **Annual Checkup**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 75.3% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 448th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 75.1%, which ranks 27th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



#### **Cholesterol Screening**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 79.7% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 843rd out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 80.1%, which ranks 212th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



#### **Colorectal Cancer Screening**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 74.7% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 100th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 75.0%, which ranks 64th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities).



#### Core preventive services for older men

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 40.4% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 787th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 40.9%, which ranks 696th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).



#### Core preventive services for older women

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 40.6% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 352nd out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 42.4%, which ranks 249th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).



#### **Dental Visit**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 67.8% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 407th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 67.8%, which ranks 330th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).



## **Mammography**

Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 79.1% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 101st out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 76.4%, which ranks 127th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).

# **Disability**



Cedar Rapids has a crude rate of 6.0% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 139th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 5.8%, which ranks 287th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Cedar Rapids is 11.4%, which ranks 359th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities).



This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
