Health in Columbus Junction: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Columbus Junction,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Columbus Junction ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Columbus Junction's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Columbus Junction. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Columbus Junction that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Columbus Junction, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Columbus Junction compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,029, Columbus Junction's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In Iowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 16.8% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 843rd out of 958 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 16.3%, which ranks 872nd out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 10.8% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 468th out of 958 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 10.5%, which ranks 727th out of 905 lowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 13.8% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 291st out of 958 lowa communities (50th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 14.0%, which ranks 57th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 19.7% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 511th out of 958 lowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 20.3%, which ranks 58th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 15.9% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 286th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 16.1%, which ranks 204th out of 905 lowa communities (38th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 30.2% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 881st out of 958 lowa communities (128th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 29.7%, which ranks 887th out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 31.9% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 809th out of 958 lowa communities (126th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 32.2%, which ranks 706th out of 905 lowa communities (114th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Arthritis

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 22.6% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 86th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 21.4%, which ranks 79th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 29.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 193rd out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 27.9%, which ranks 602nd out of 905 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 6.3% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 66th out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 5.9%, which ranks 1st out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 8.9% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 80th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 8.9%, which ranks 45th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities).



Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 5.5% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 199th out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 5.1%, which ranks 511th out of 905 lowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 5.9%, which ranks 260th out of 905 lowa communities (48th out of 138 small communities).





Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 10.7% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 629th out of 958 lowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 10.2%, which ranks 883rd out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 29.9%, which ranks 501st out of 905 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 41.1%, which ranks 845th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).







Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 16.0% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 953rd out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 16.5%, which ranks 901st out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 59.6%, which ranks 179th out of 905 lowa communities (22nd out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 82.4%, which ranks 657th out of 905 lowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 72.9%, which ranks 333rd out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 80.2% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 805th out of 958 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 79.4%, which ranks 364th out of 905 lowa communities (65th out of 138 small communities).



Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 68.6% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 848th out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 68.5%, which ranks 813th out of 905 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities).



Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 43.0% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 541st out of 958 lowa communities (88th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 43.1%, which ranks 496th out of 905 lowa communities (90th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 35.1% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 814th out of 958 lowa communities (112th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 37.5%, which ranks 717th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 63.1% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 817th out of 958 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 62.9%, which ranks 748th out of 905 lowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities).



Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 75.7% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 573rd out of 958 lowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 73.6%, which ranks 499th out of 905 lowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Hearing disability

Columbus Junction has a crude rate of 6.5% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 232nd out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Columbus Junction is 6.1%, which ranks 544th out of 905 lowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities).



The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
