# Health in Corning: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Corning,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Corning ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Corning's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all Iowa communities and communities of similar size to Corning. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

## How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Corning that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Corning, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Corning compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,592, Corning’s similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In Iowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community’s crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all Iowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all Iowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



# Health Status

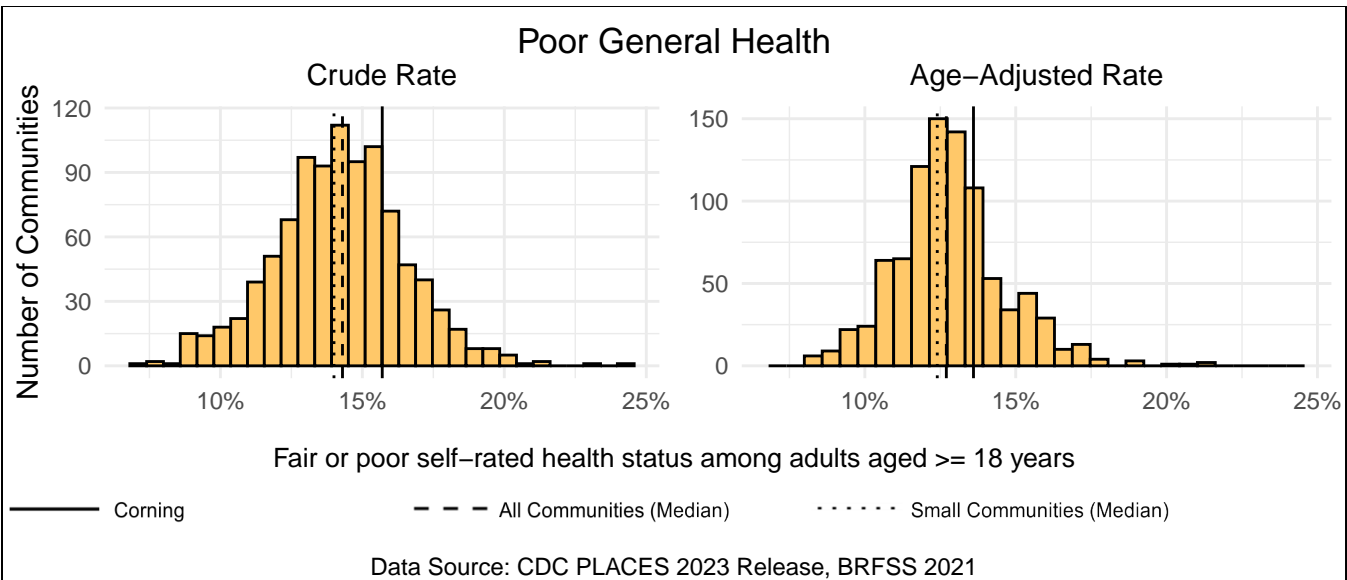
This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country’s population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of “excellent,” “very good,” “good,” “fair,” or “poor,” from which the respondents who answer “fair” or “poor” are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. ## Poor General Health

Corning has a crude rate of 15.7% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 731st out of 958 Iowa communities (112th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 13.6%, which ranks 642nd out of 905 Iowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities).

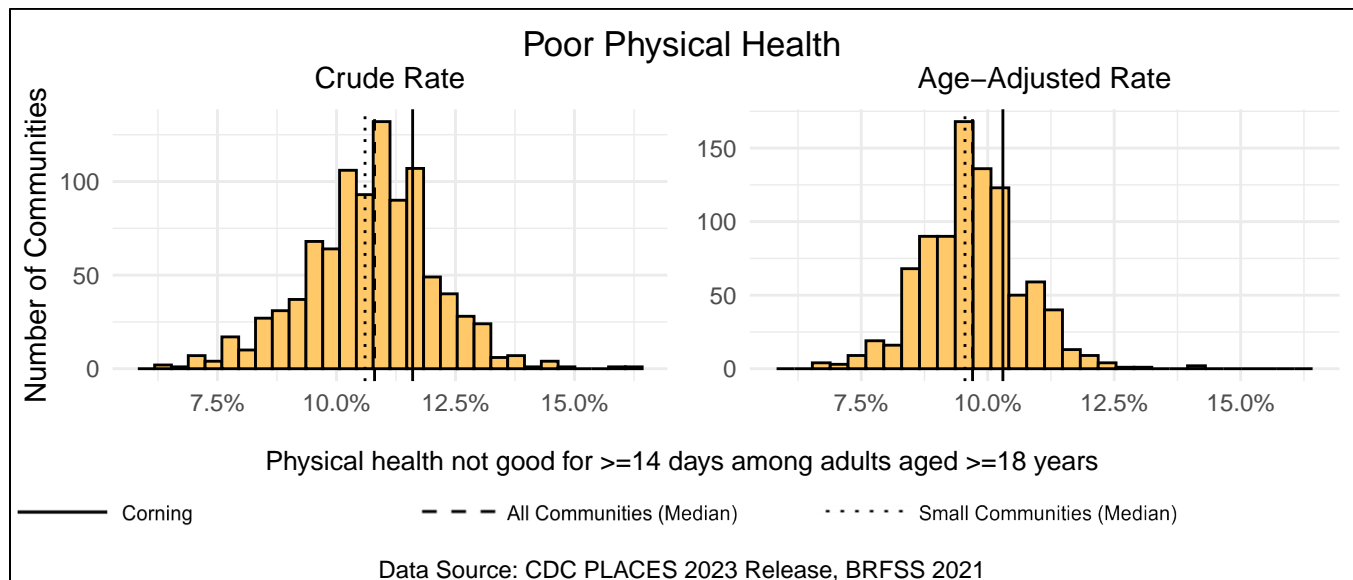




## Poor Physical Health

Corning has a crude rate of 11.6% for physical health not good for  $\geq 14$  days among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 719th out of 958 Iowa communities (114th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 10.3%, which ranks 673rd out of 905 Iowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities).

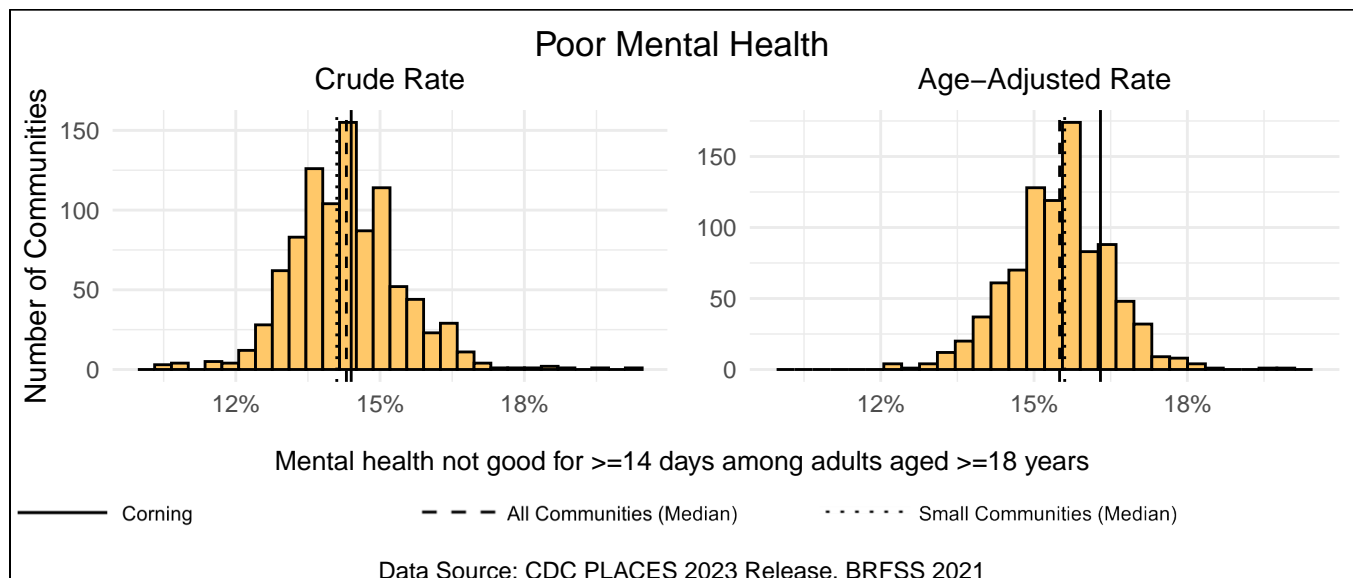

## Poor Mental Health

Corning has a crude rate of 14.4% for mental health not good for  $\geq 14$  days among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 514th out of 958 Iowa communities (87th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 16.3%, which ranks 714th out of 905 Iowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities).

# Health Risk Behaviors

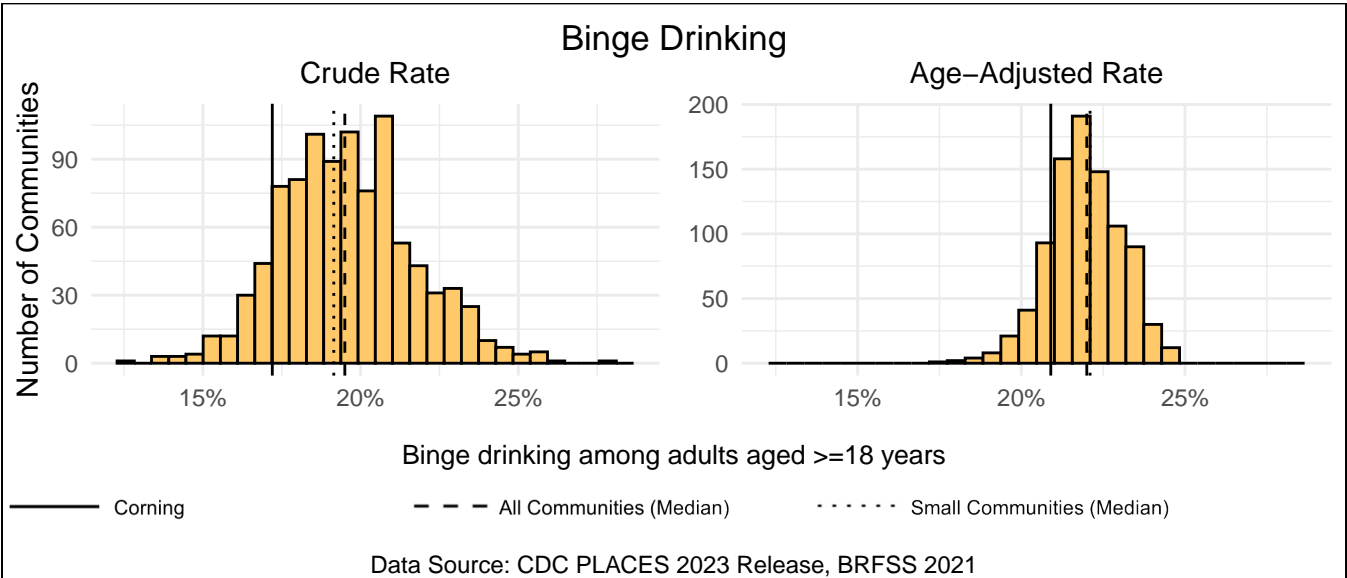
Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. ## Binge Drinking

Corning has a crude rate of 17.2% for binge drinking among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 110th out of 958 Iowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 20.9%, which ranks 136th out of 905 Iowa communities (20th out of 138 small communities).

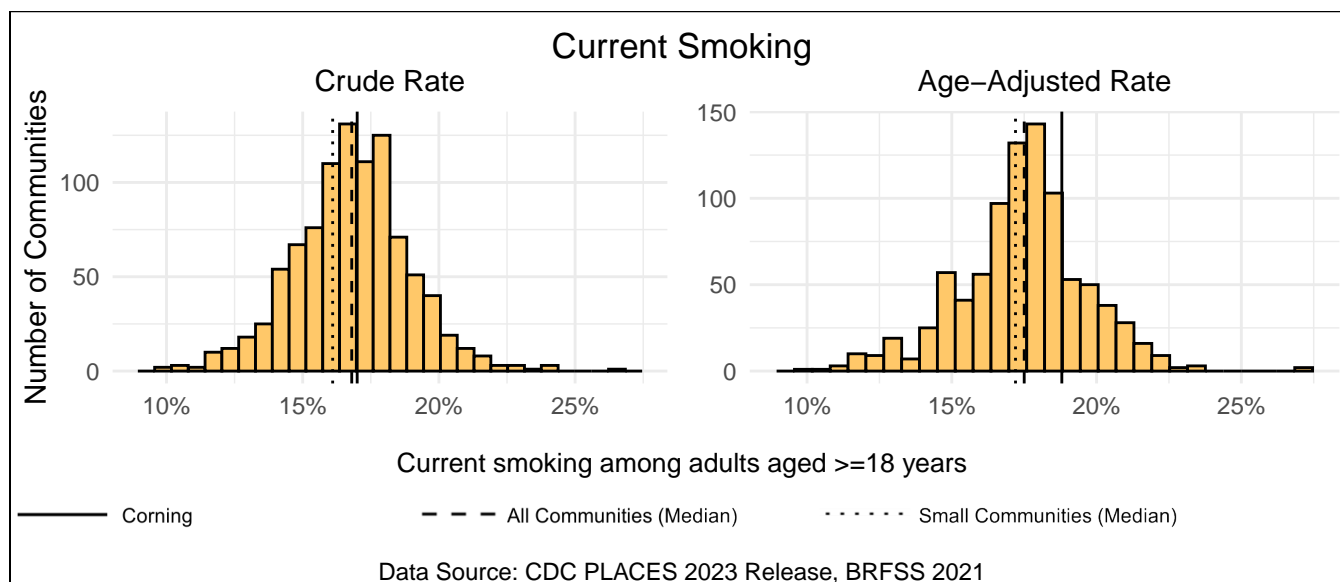

## Current Smoking

Corning has a crude rate of 17.0% for current smoking among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 511th out of 958 Iowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 18.8%, which ranks 690th out of 905 Iowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities).

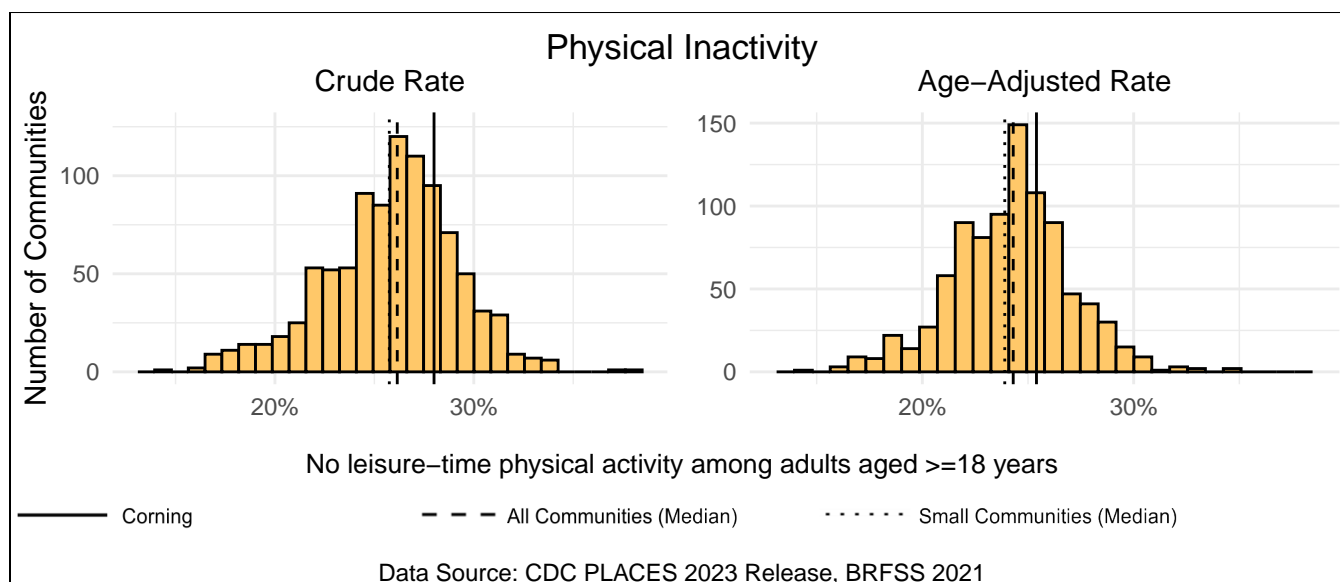

## Physical Inactivity

Corning has a crude rate of 28.0% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 714th out of 958 Iowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 25.4%, which ranks 623rd out of 905 Iowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities).

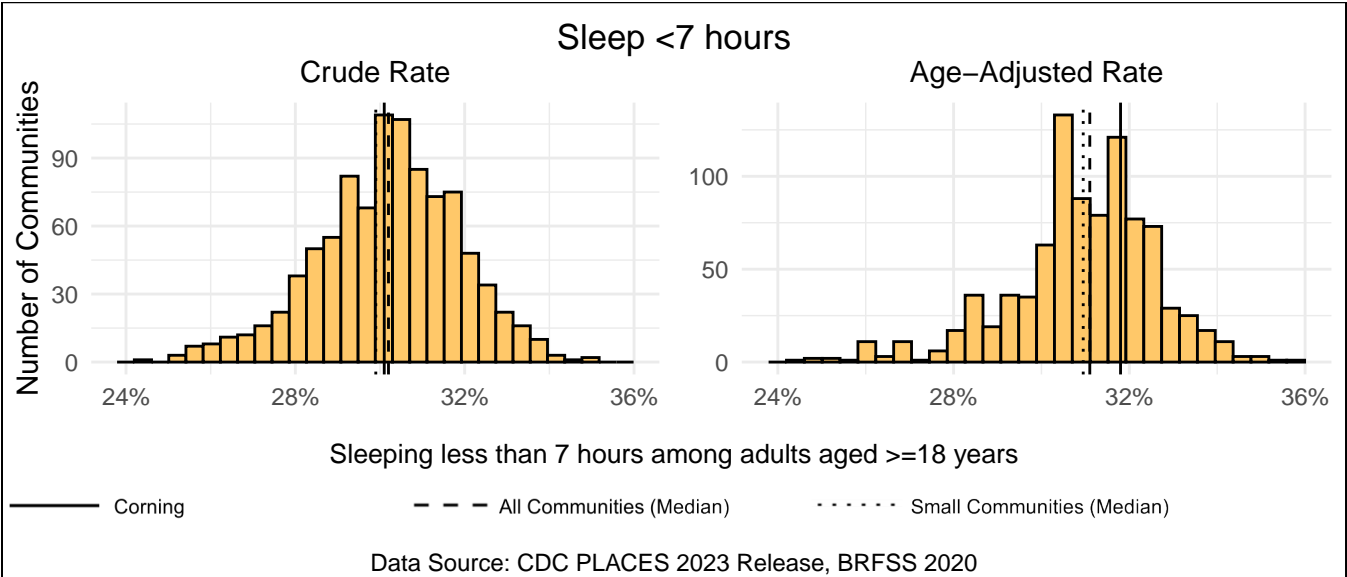

### Sleep <7 hours

Corning has a crude rate of 30.1% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 427th out of 958 Iowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 31.8%, which ranks 613th out of 905 Iowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities).

# Health Outcomes

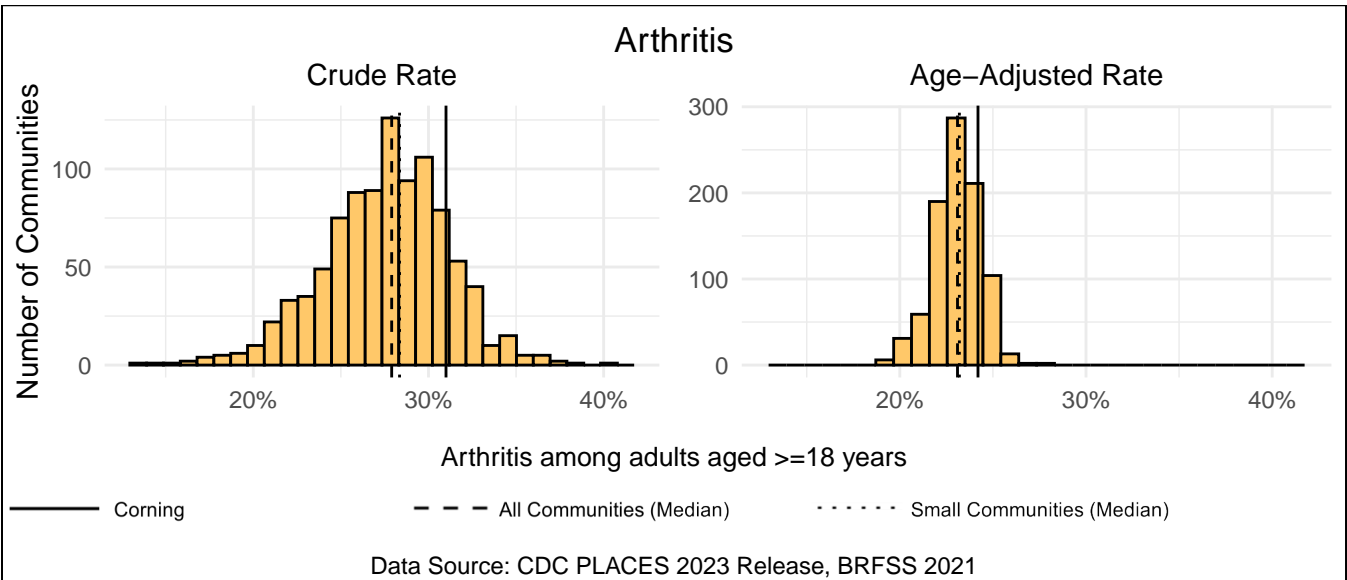
This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. ## Arthritis

Corning has a crude rate of 31.0% for arthritis among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 812th out of 958 Iowa communities (113th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 24.2%, which ranks 736th out of 905 Iowa communities (117th out of 138 small communities).

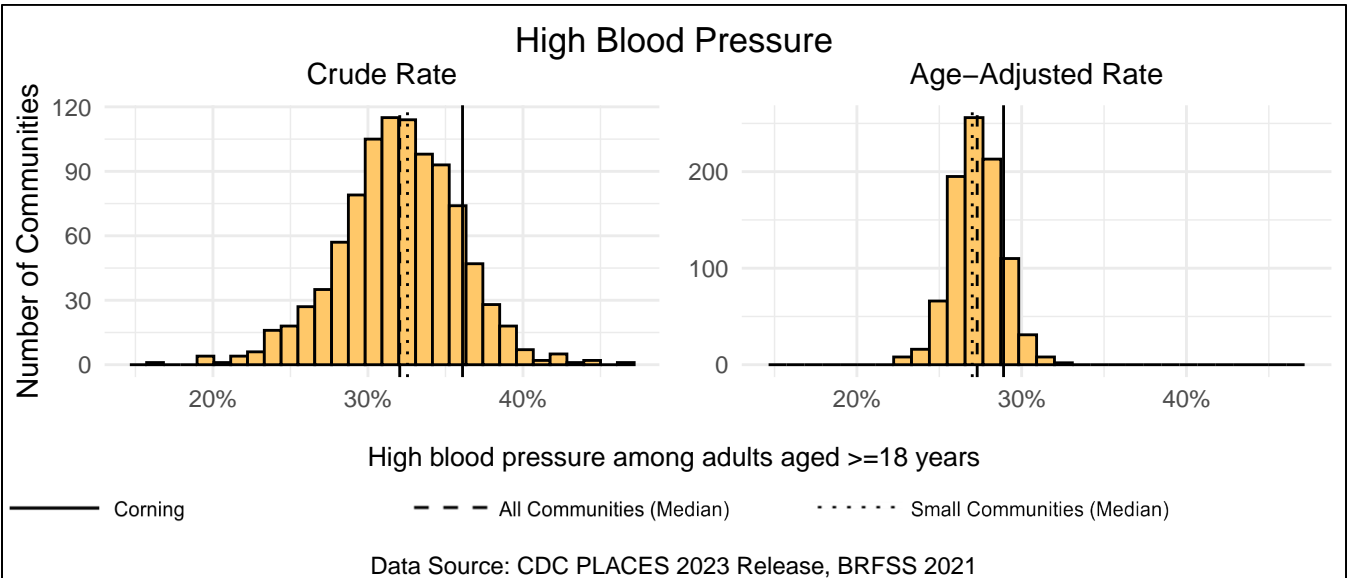

## High Blood Pressure

Corning has a crude rate of 36.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 824th out of 958 Iowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 28.9%, which ranks 766th out of 905 Iowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities).

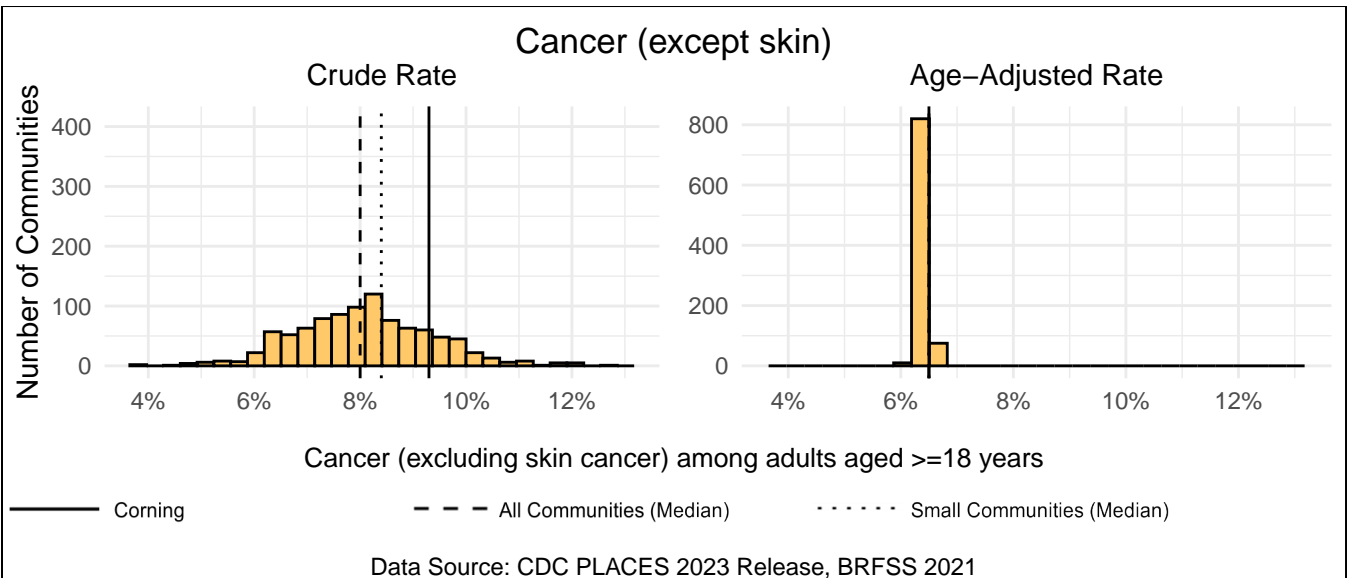

## Cancer (except skin)

Corning has a crude rate of 9.3% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 790th out of 958 Iowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 Iowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).

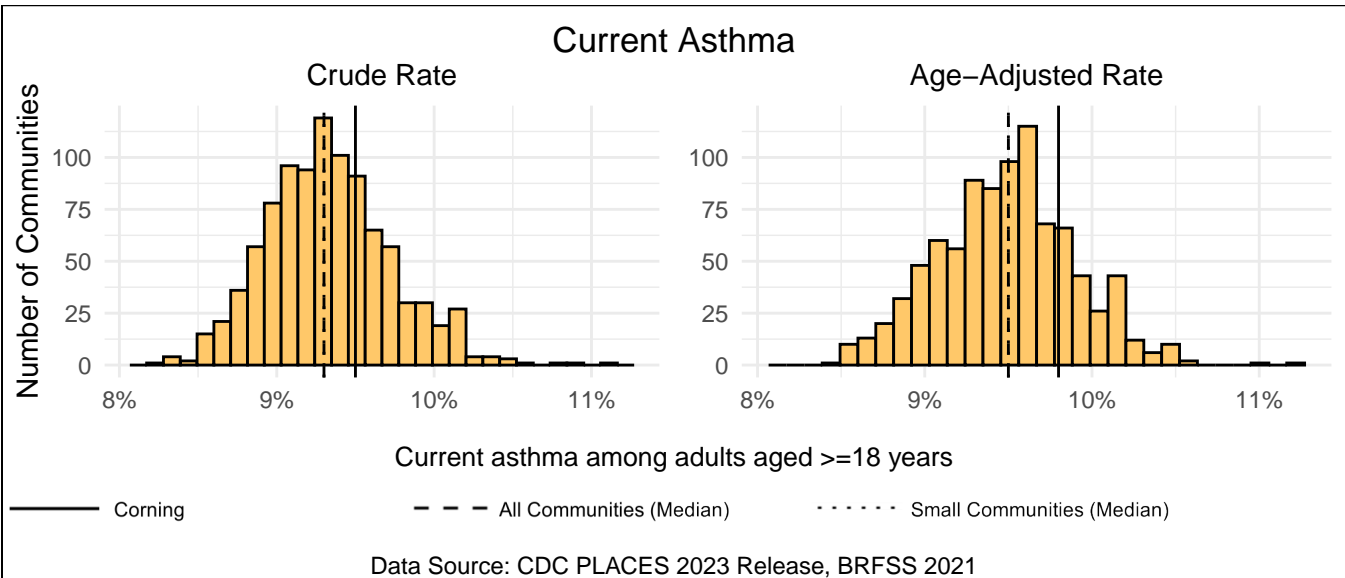

## Current Asthma

Corning has a crude rate of 9.5% for current asthma among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 625th out of 958 Iowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 9.8%, which ranks 696th out of 905 Iowa communities (107th out of 138 small communities).

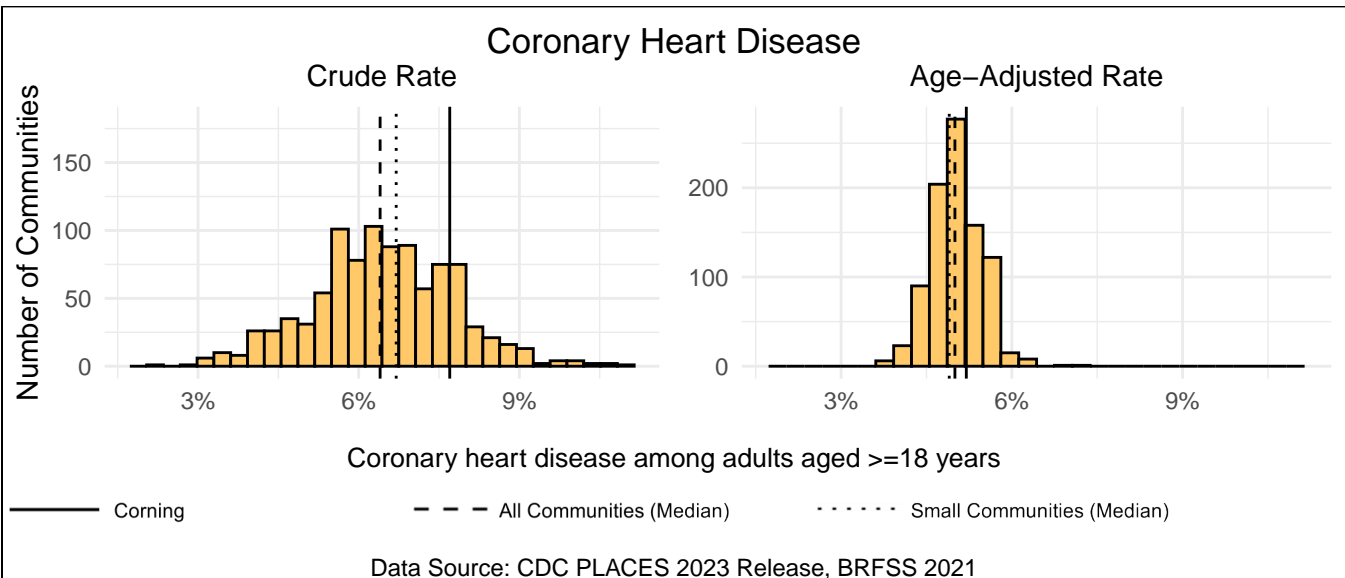

Corning has a crude rate of 7.7% for coronary heart disease among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 790th out of 958 Iowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 5.2%, which ranks 601st out of 905 Iowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities).

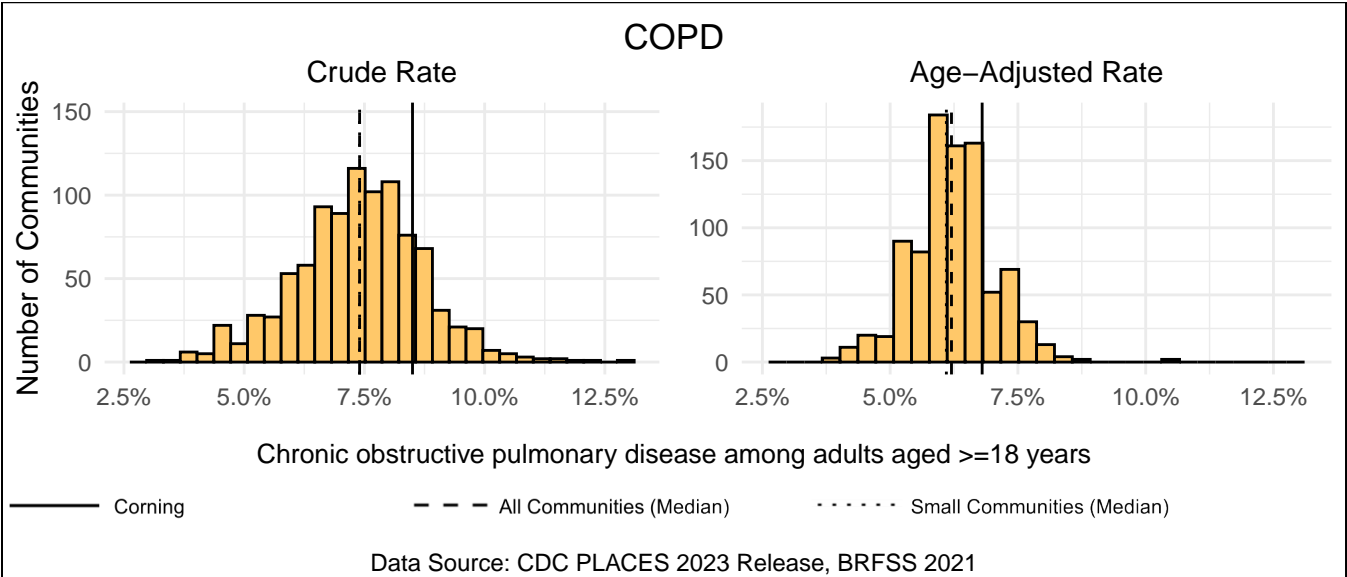

Corning has a crude rate of 8.5% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 770th out of 958 Iowa communities (113th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 6.8%, which ranks 699th out of 905 Iowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities).

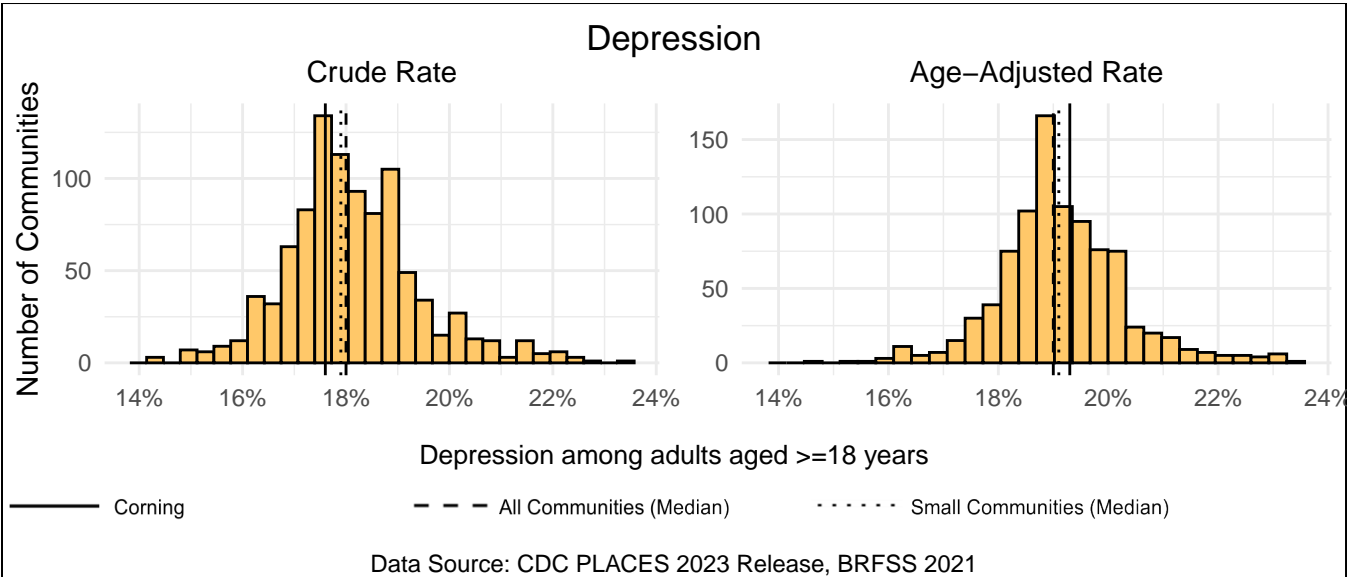

Corning has a crude rate of 17.6% for depression among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 326th out of 958 Iowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 19.3%, which ranks 527th out of 905 Iowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities).

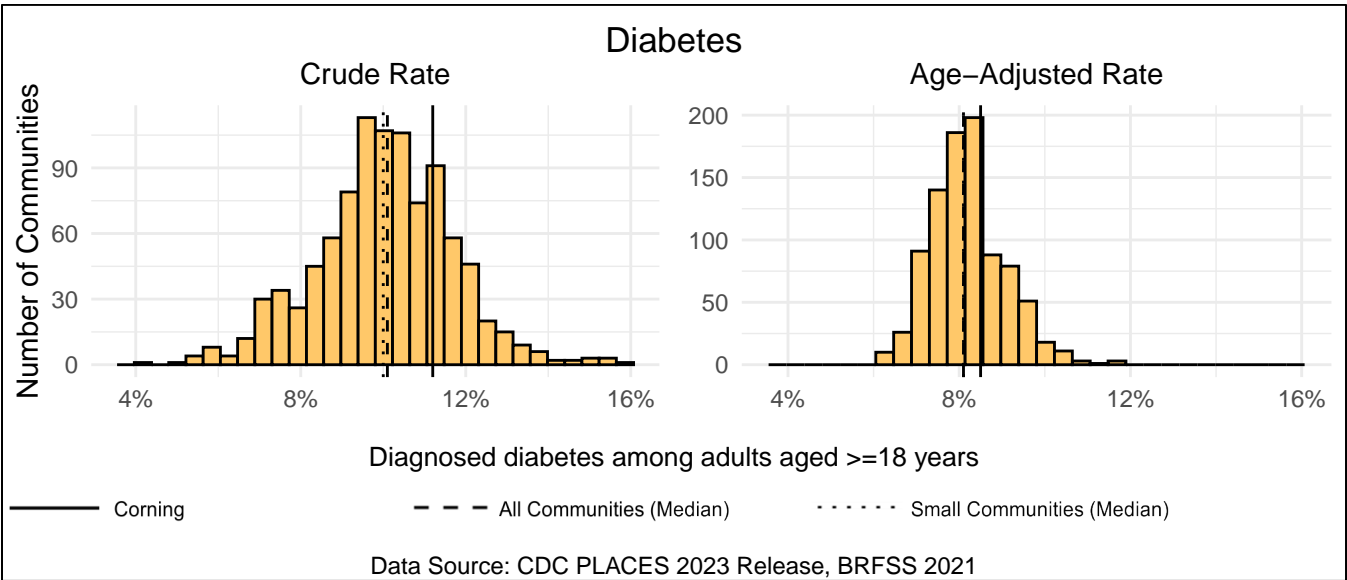




# Diabetes

Corning has a crude rate of 11.2% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 736th out of 958 Iowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 8.5%, which ranks 617th out of 905 Iowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities).

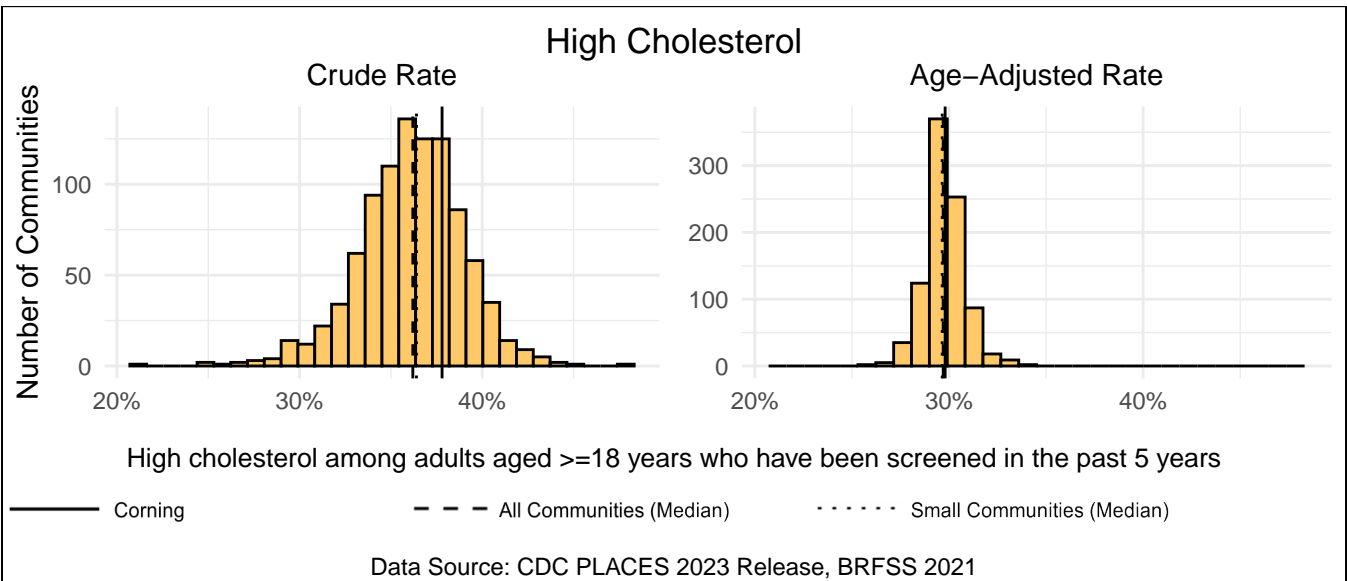

# High Cholesterol

Corning has a crude rate of 37.8% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 695th out of 958 Iowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 29.8%, which ranks 467th out of 905 Iowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities).

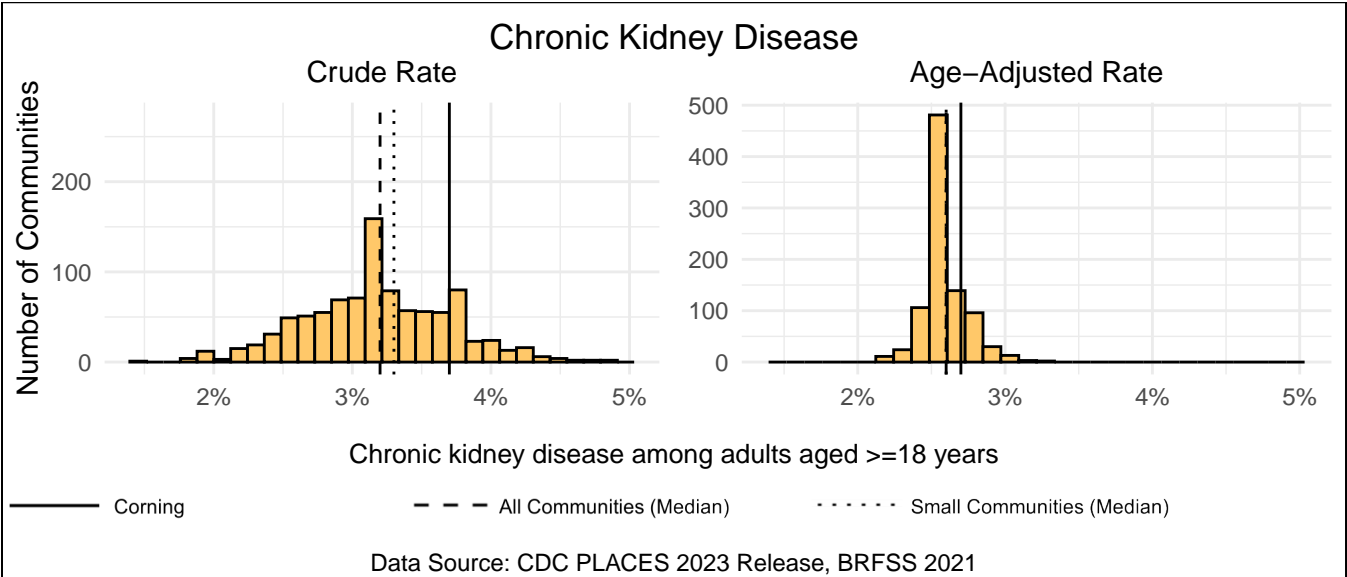

The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 2.7%, which ranks 623rd out of 905 Iowa communities (106th out of 138 small communities).

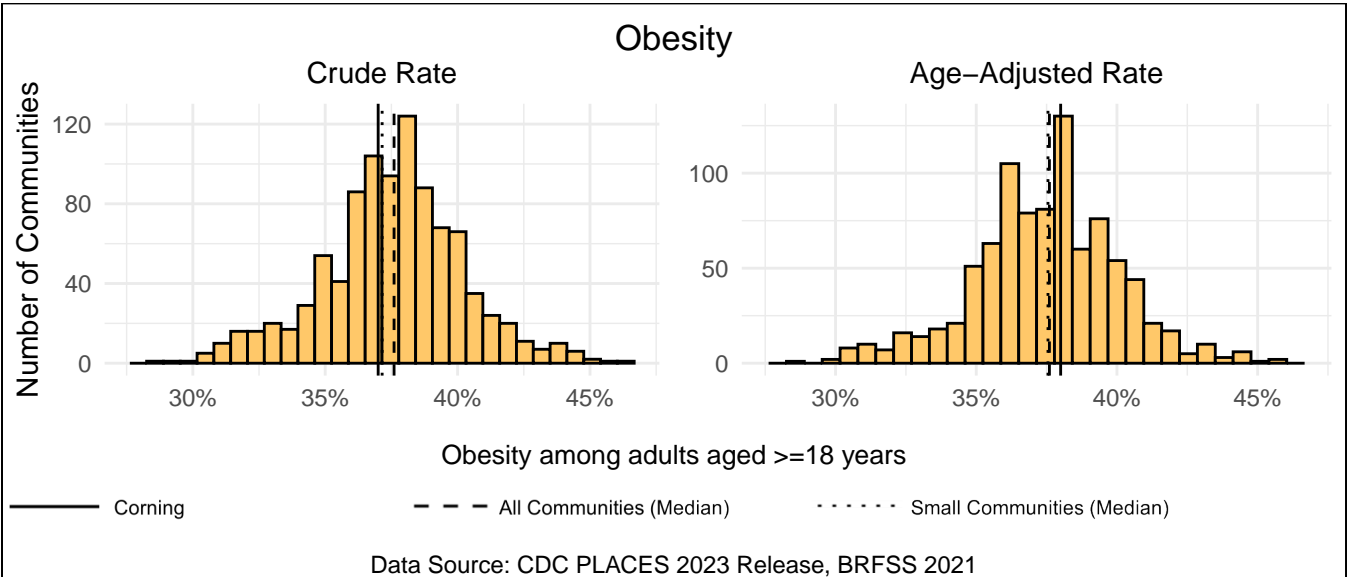

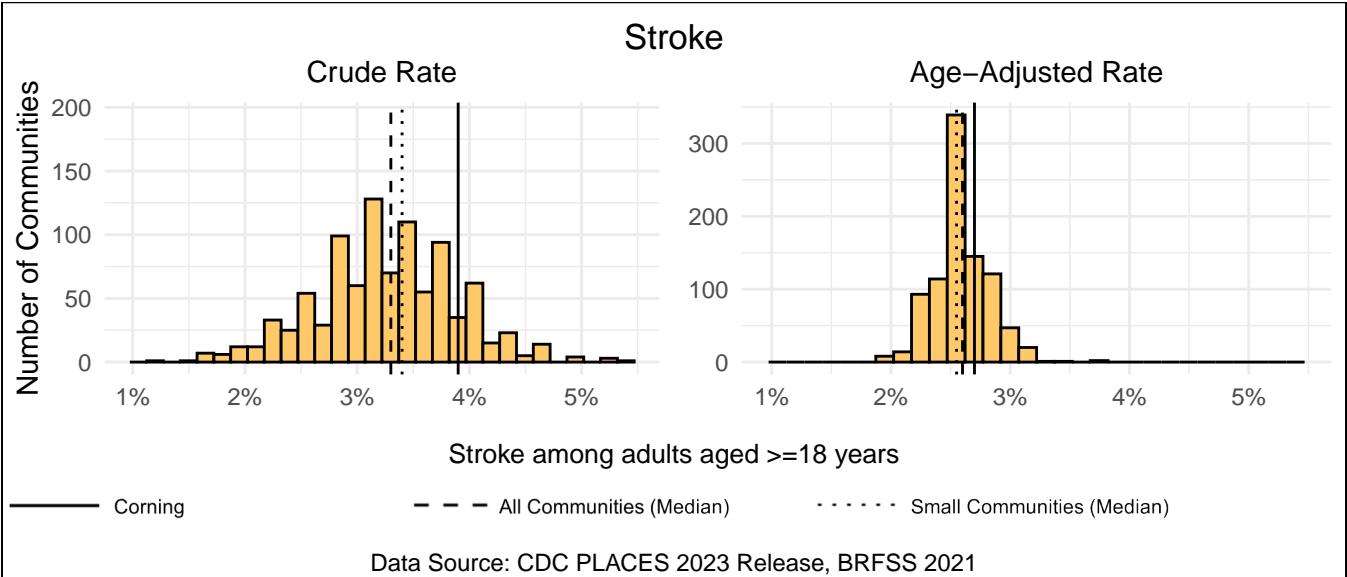

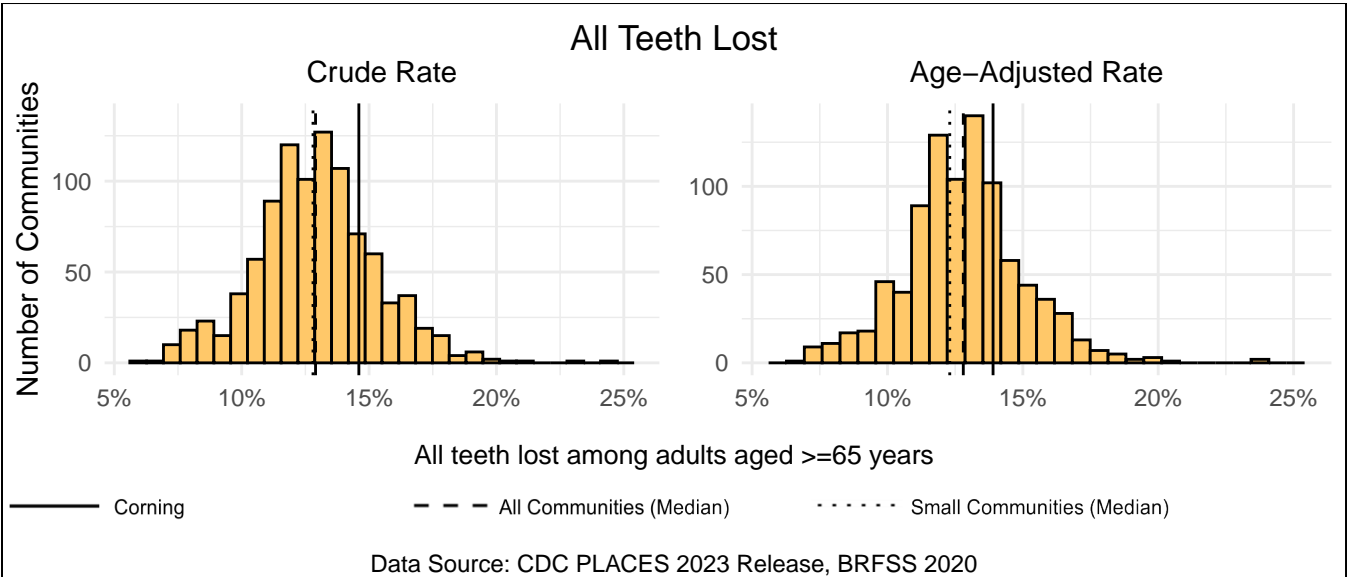

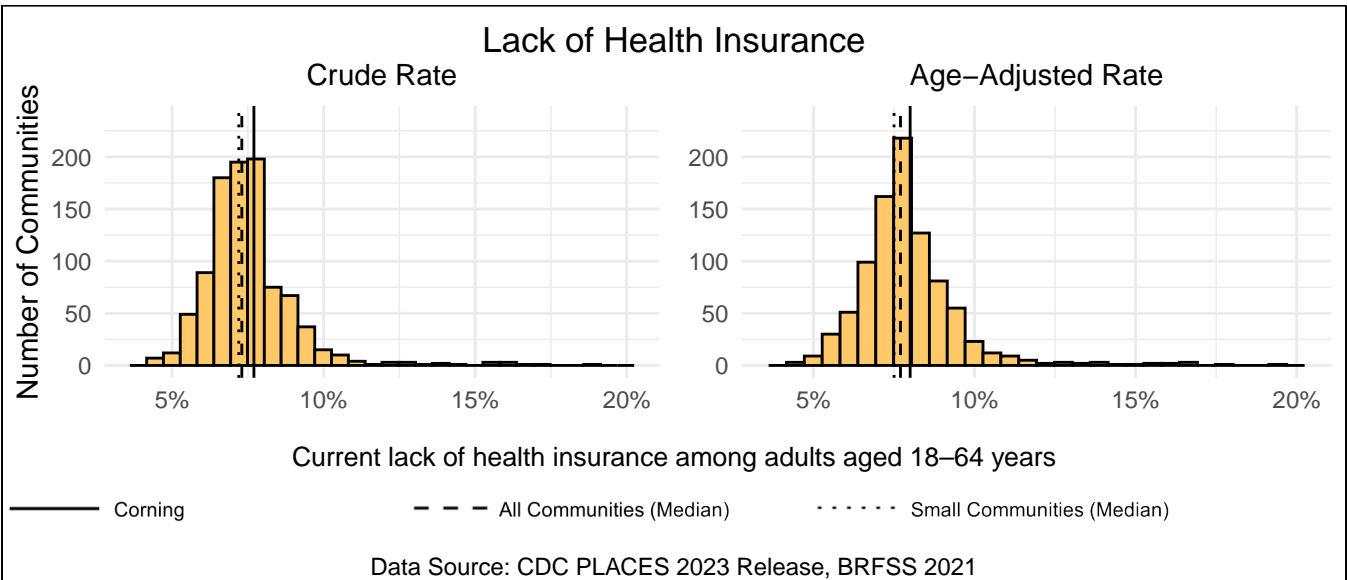

## Lack of Health Insurance

Corning has a crude rate of 7.7% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 598th out of 958 Iowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 8.0%, which ranks 538th out of 905 Iowa communities (94th out of 138 small communities).

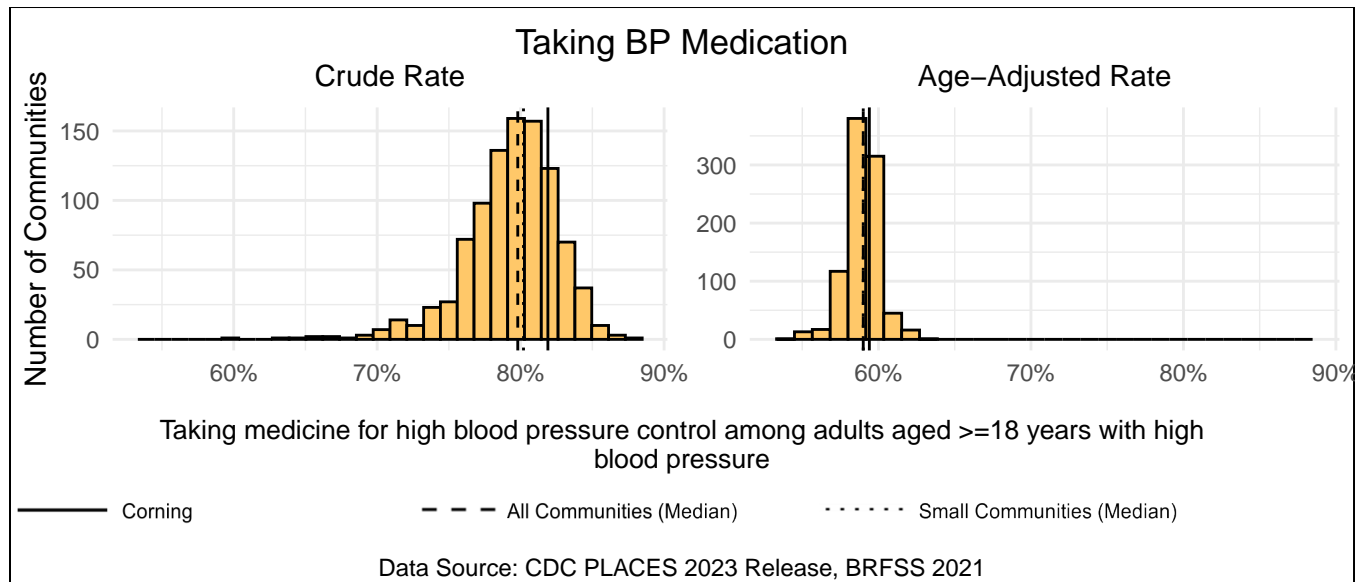

## Taking BP Medication

Corning has a crude rate of 81.9% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years with high blood pressure, which ranks 176th out of 958 Iowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 59.4%, which ranks 251st out of 905 Iowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities).

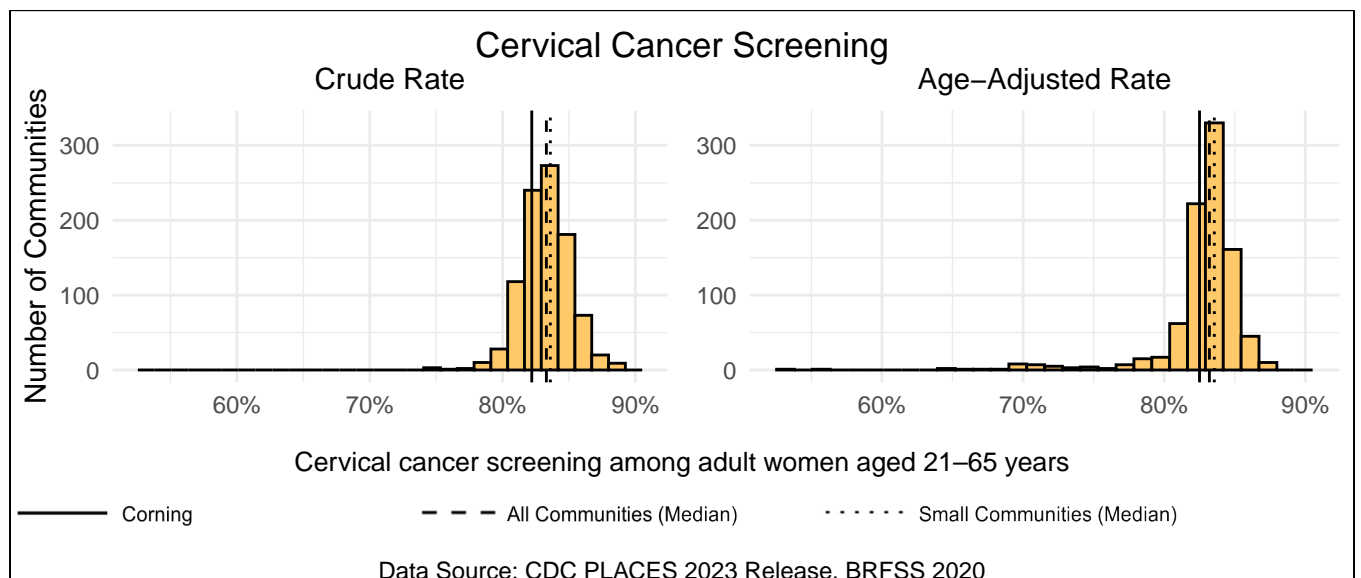

Corning has a crude rate of 82.2% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 710th out of 958 Iowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 82.5%, which ranks 639th out of 905 Iowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities).

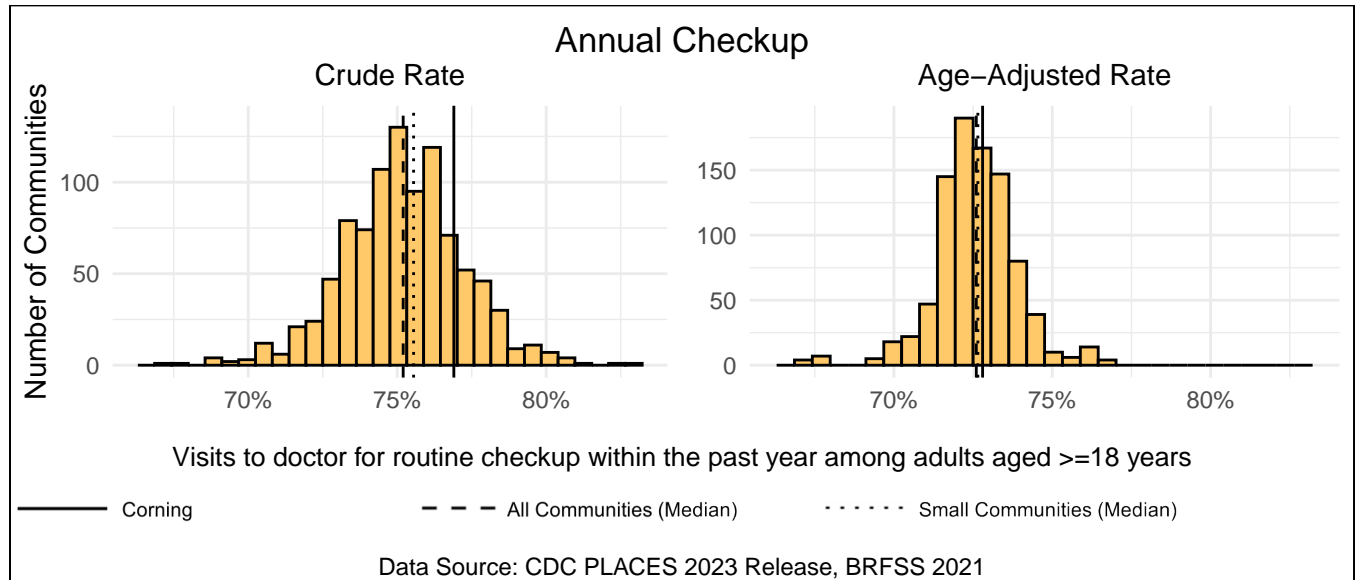

Corning has a crude rate of 76.9% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 177th out of 958 Iowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 72.8%, which ranks 367th out of 905 Iowa communities (60th out of 138 small communities).

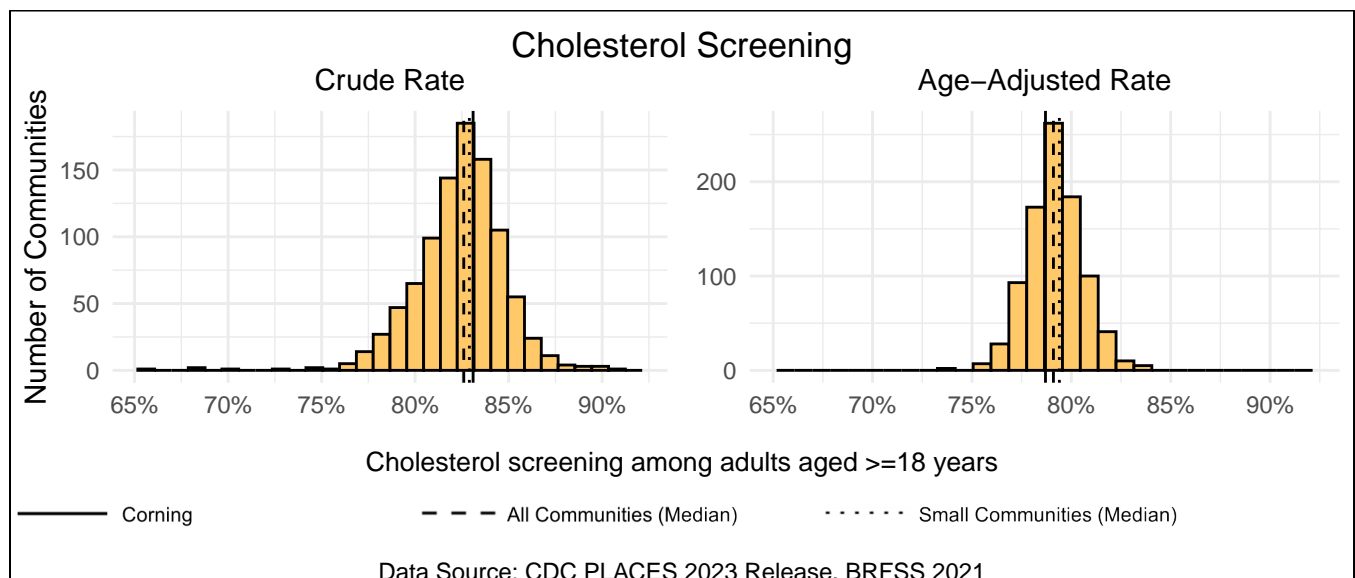

Corning has a crude rate of 83.1% for cholesterol screening among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 365th out of 958 Iowa communities (61st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 78.7%, which ranks 573rd out of 905 Iowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities).

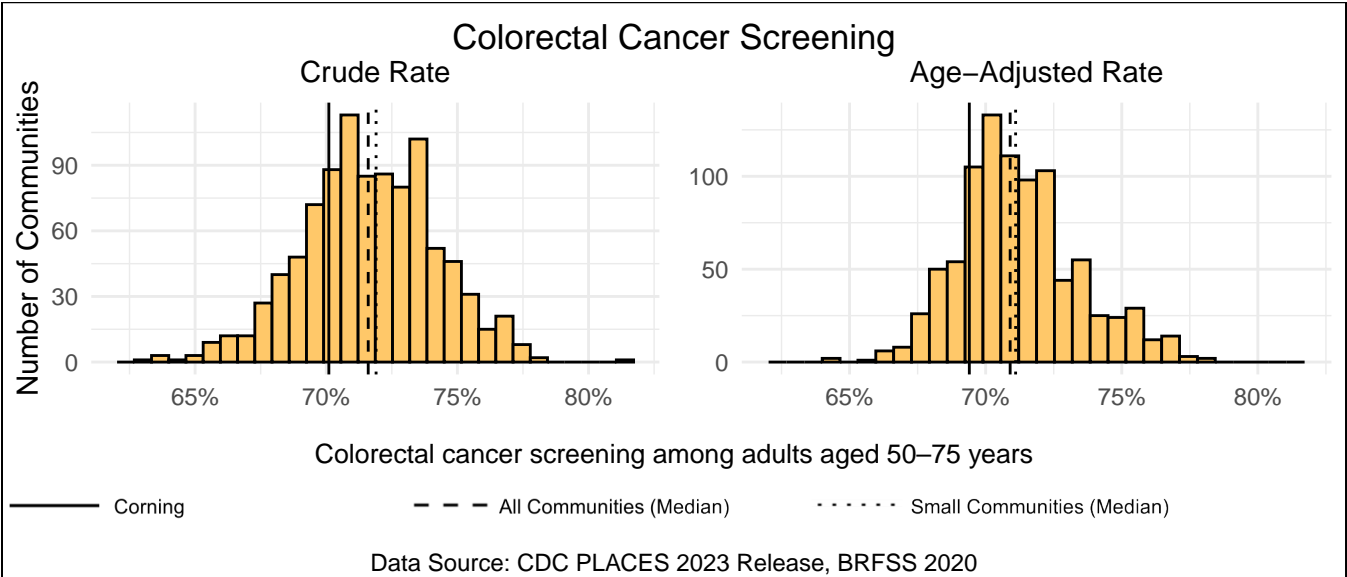

Corning has a crude rate of 70.1% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 708th out of 958 Iowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 69.4%, which ranks 729th out of 905 Iowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities).

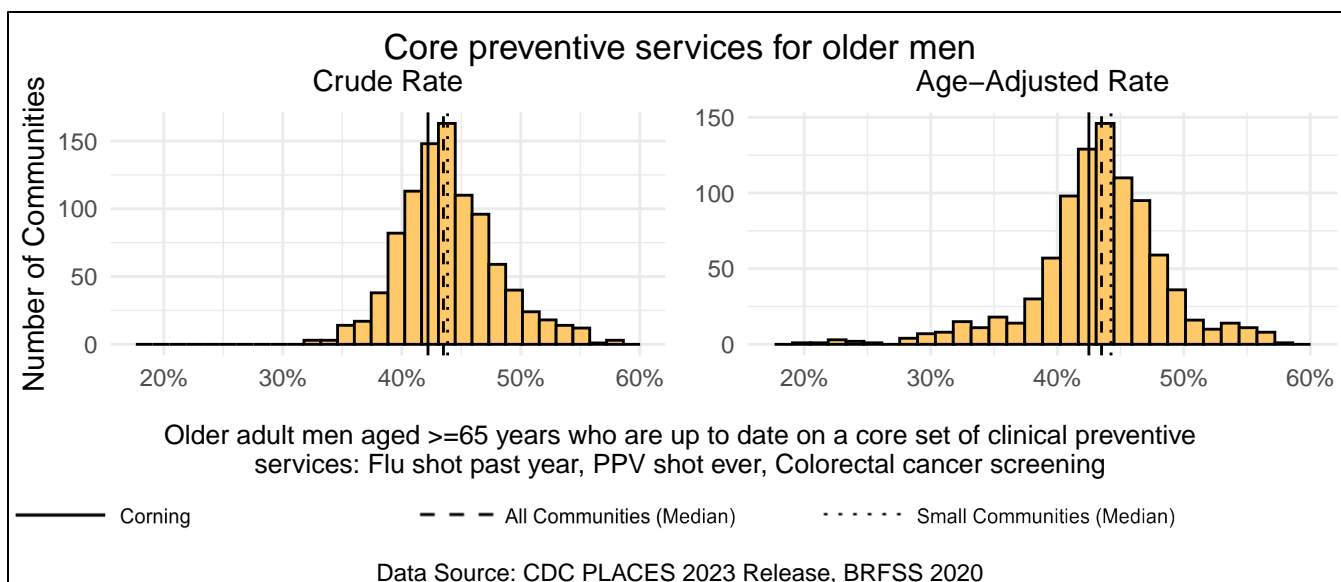

### Core preventive services for older men

Corning has a crude rate of 42.2% for older adult men aged ≥65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 634th out of 958 Iowa communities (101st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 42.5%, which ranks 549th out of 905 Iowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).

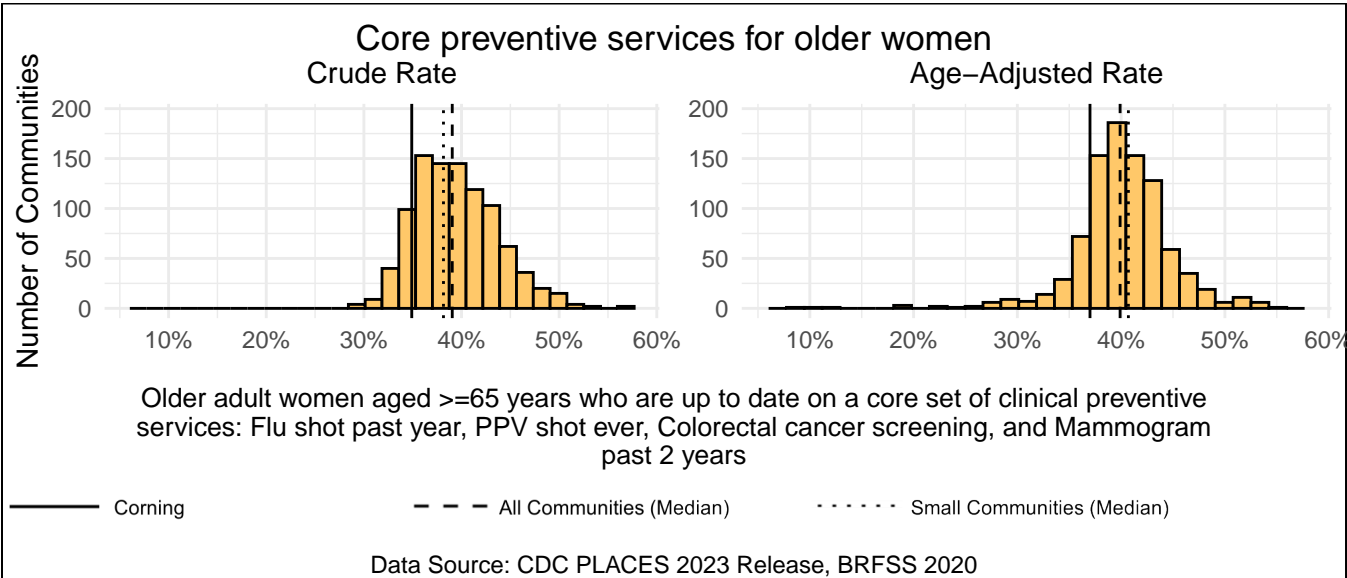




### Core preventive services for older women

Corning has a crude rate of 34.9% for older adult women aged  $\geq 65$  years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 828th out of 958 Iowa communities (116th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 37.0%, which ranks 758th out of 905 Iowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).

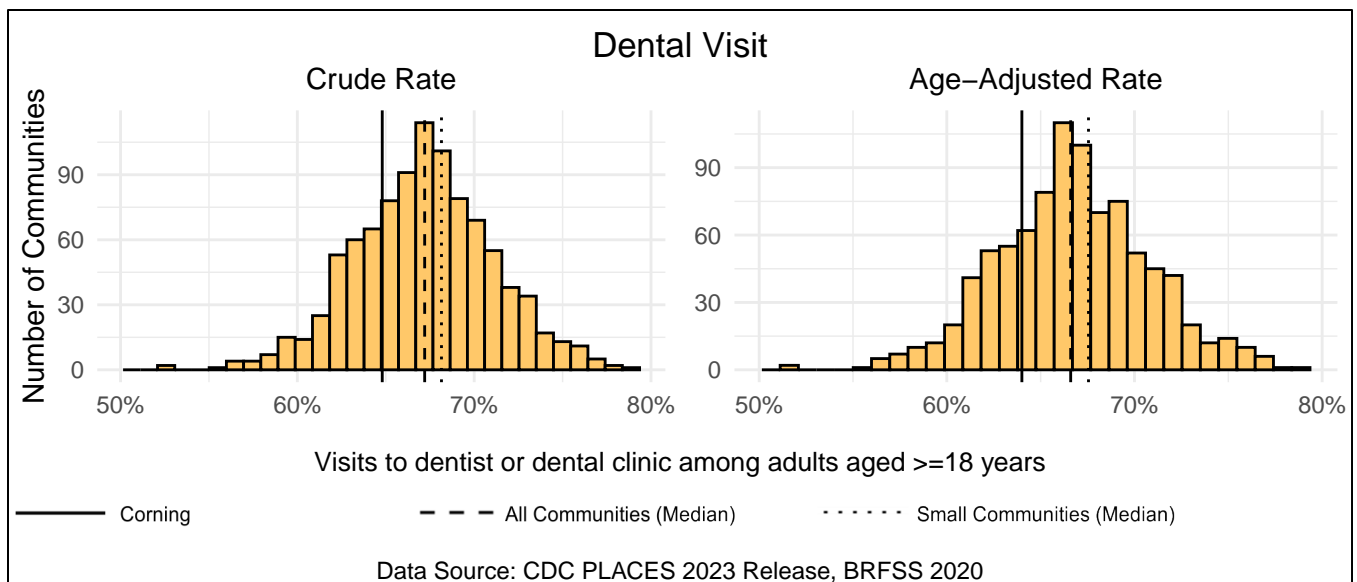

Corning has a crude rate of 64.8% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 706th out of 958 Iowa communities (109th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 64.0%, which ranks 689th out of 905 Iowa communities (112th out of 138 small communities).

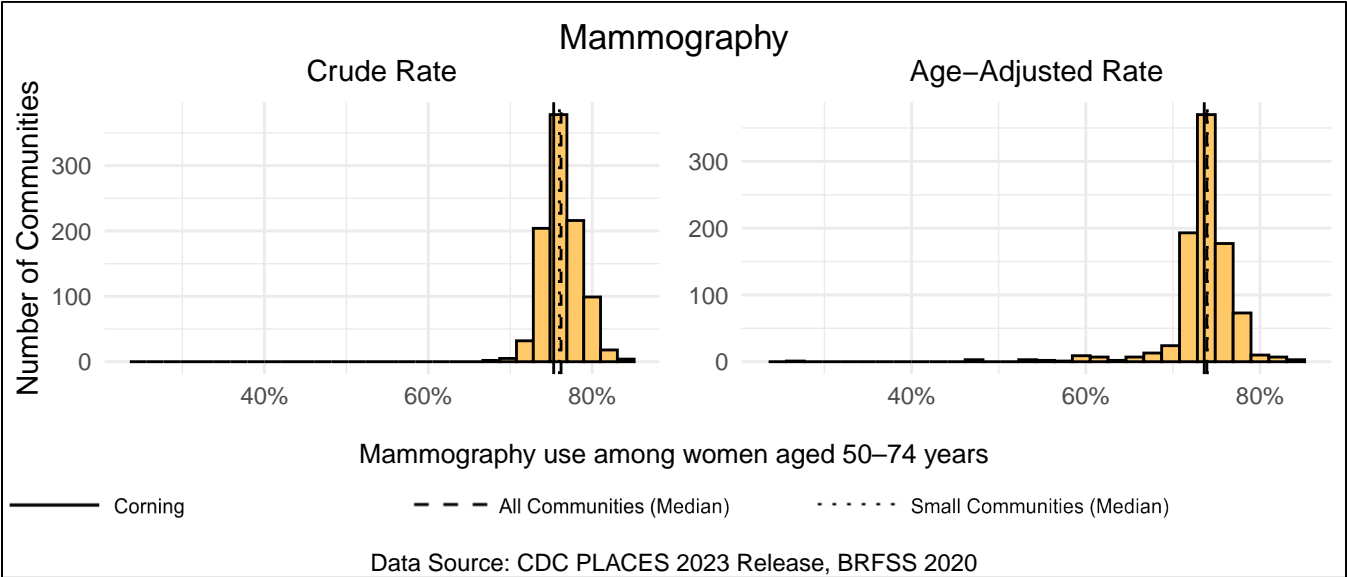

Corning has a crude rate of 75.3% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 642nd out of 958 Iowa communities (88th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 73.6%, which ranks 499th out of 905 Iowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities).

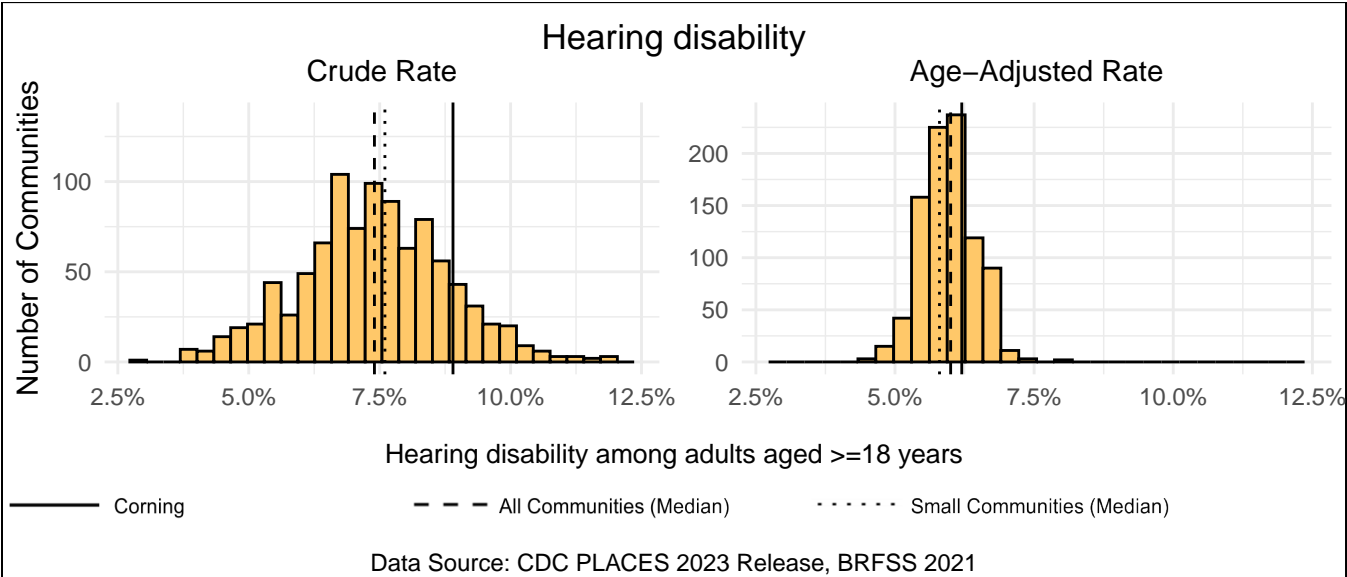

Corning has a crude rate of 8.9% for hearing disability among adults aged  $\geq 18$  years, which ranks 818th out of 958 Iowa communities (109th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Corning is 6.2%, which ranks 621st out of 905 Iowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities).

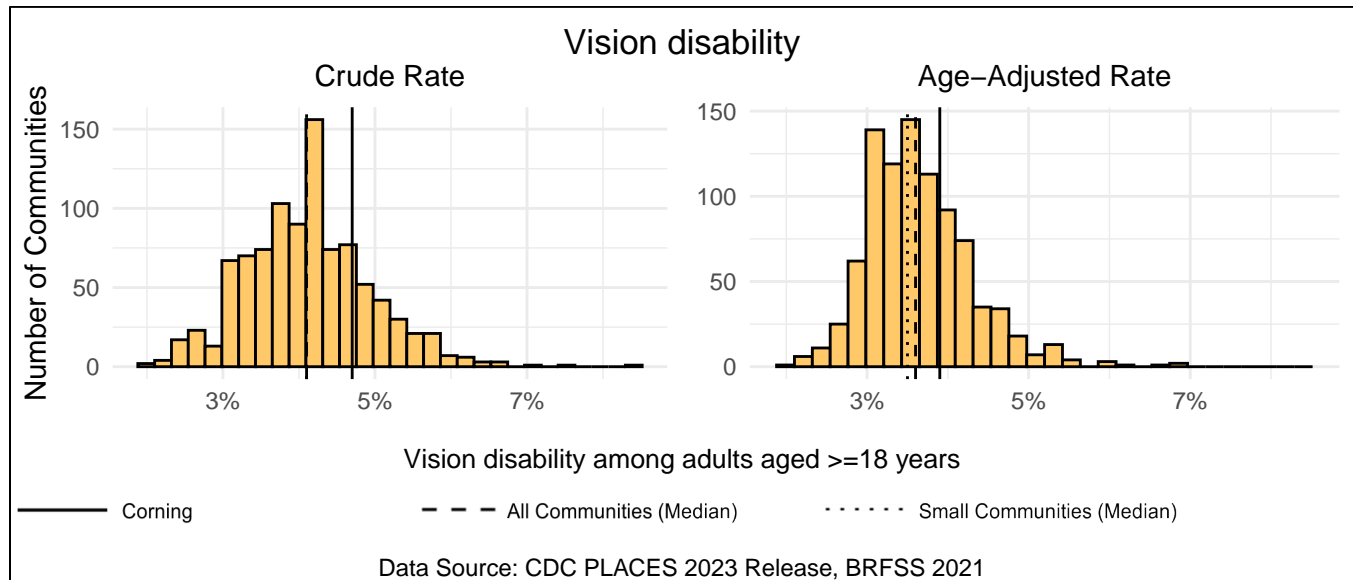

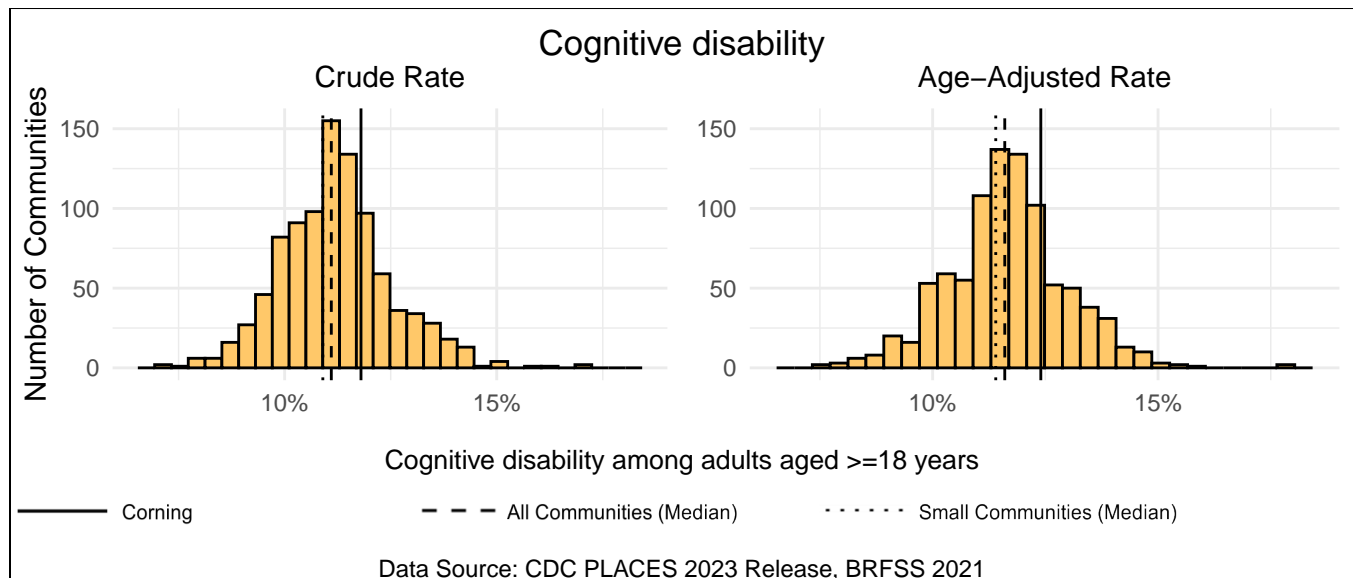

## Cognitive disability

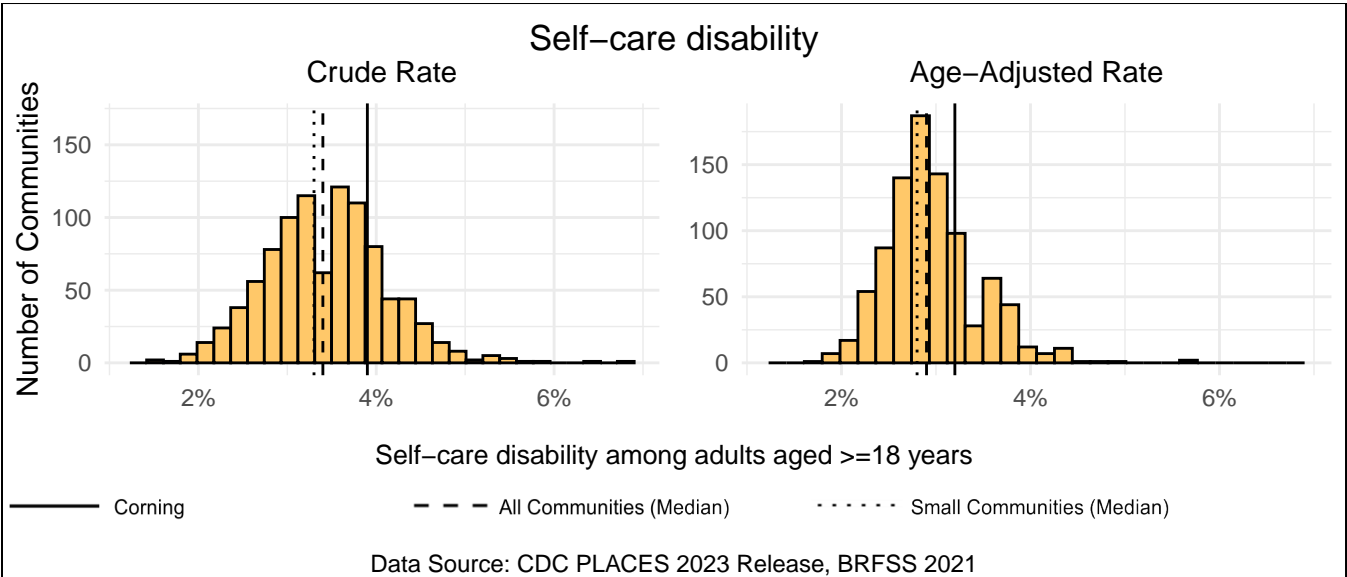

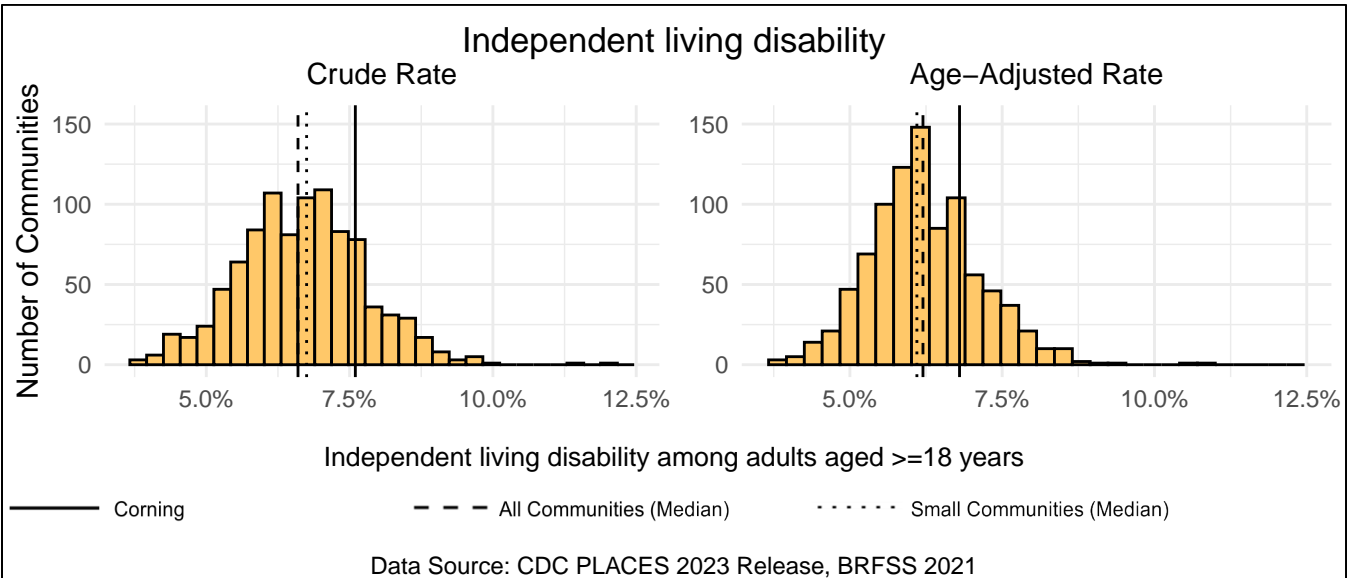

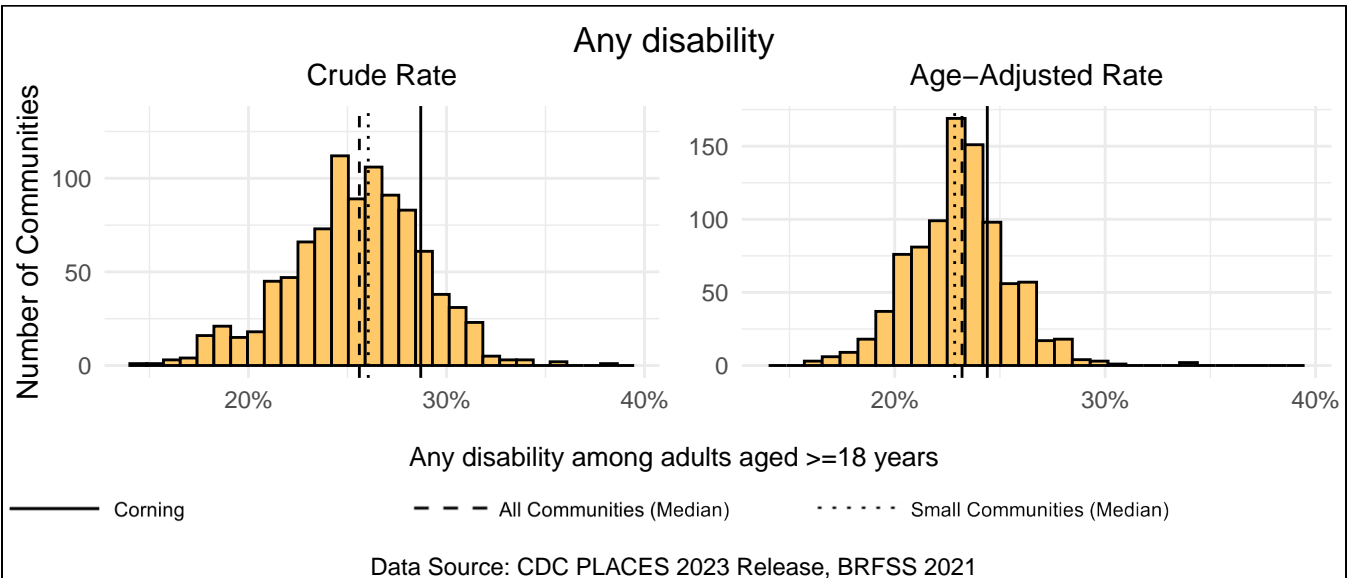

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
