

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Health in Davenport: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Davenport,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Davenport ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Davenport's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Davenport. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Davenport that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Davenport, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Davenport compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 101,448, Davenport's similarly sized communities are defined as large communities. In lowa, large communities have an average population of 91,321, and there are 11 communities that are considered large communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Davenport has a crude rate of 15.5% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 696th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 15.4%, which ranks 817th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).



Poor Physical Health

Davenport has a crude rate of 10.5% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 375th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 10.4%, which ranks 707th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).



Poor Mental Health

Davenport has a crude rate of 16.3% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 907th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 16.2%, which ranks 686th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Davenport has a crude rate of 19.9% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 549th out of 958 lowa communities (1st out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 20.0%, which ranks 37th out of 905 lowa communities (2nd out of 11 large communities).



Current Smoking

Davenport has a crude rate of 19.3% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 851st out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 19.9%, which ranks 792nd out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).



Physical Inactivity

Davenport has a crude rate of 26.6% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 524th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 26.5%, which ranks 742nd out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Davenport has a crude rate of 33.6% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 943rd out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 33.9%, which ranks 884th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Davenport has a crude rate of 23.6% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 121st out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 23.2%, which ranks 465th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).



High Blood Pressure

Davenport has a crude rate of 31.2% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 373rd out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 30.9%, which ranks 895th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Davenport has a crude rate of 6.4% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 80th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 6.3%, which ranks 16th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 10.1% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 917th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 10.1%, which ranks 831st out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 5.4% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 172nd out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 5.3%, which ranks 674th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 7.1% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 363rd out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 6.9%, which ranks 734th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).





Davenport has a crude rate of 10.0% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 444th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 9.7%, which ranks 857th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 33.5% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 147th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 30.4%, which ranks 669th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 2.8%, which ranks 762nd out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).









Davenport has a crude rate of 9.4% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 885th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 9.6%, which ranks 819th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).



Taking BP Medication

Davenport has a crude rate of 76.6% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 802nd out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 61.6%, which ranks 17th out of 905 lowa communities (2nd out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 82.1% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 728th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 83.2%, which ranks 442nd out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 74.4% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 630th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 74.2%, which ranks 66th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 78.4% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 914th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 78.6%, which ranks 603rd out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 70.6% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 630th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 71.1%, which ranks 417th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Davenport has a crude rate of 36.3% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 931st out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 36.8%, which ranks 827th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Davenport has a crude rate of 42.2% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 241st out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 43.7%, which ranks 150th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 63.2% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 810th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 63.1%, which ranks 733rd out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).



Davenport has a crude rate of 82.6% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 10th out of 958 lowa communities (1st out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 79.6%, which ranks 18th out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 11 large communities).

Disability



Davenport has a crude rate of 6.3% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 188th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Davenport is 6.1%, which ranks 544th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).





This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
