Health in Dyersville: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Dyersville,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Dyersville ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Dyersville's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Dyersville. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Dyersville that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Dyersville, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Dyersville compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 4,318, Dyersville's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In Iowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Dyersville has a crude rate of 12.4% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 189th out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 11.2%, which ranks 150th out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Physical Health

Dyersville has a crude rate of 9.7% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 183rd out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 8.9%, which ranks 160th out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Mental Health

Dyersville has a crude rate of 13.4% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 164th out of 958 lowa communities (16th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 14.6%, which ranks 140th out of 905 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Dyersville has a crude rate of 20.5% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 637th out of 958 lowa communities (71st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 23.3%, which ranks 792nd out of 905 lowa communities (88th out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Smoking

Dyersville has a crude rate of 14.5% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 117th out of 958 lowa communities (22nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 15.4%, which ranks 150th out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 102 midsized communities).



Physical Inactivity

Dyersville has a crude rate of 23.2% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 194th out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 21.6%, which ranks 143rd out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Dyersville has a crude rate of 29.6% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 314th out of 958 lowa communities (49th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 30.6%, which ranks 330th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Outcomes



Arthritis

Dyersville has a crude rate of 24.8% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 192nd out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 20.6%, which ranks 32nd out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 102 midsized communities).



High Blood Pressure

Dyersville has a crude rate of 28.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 161st out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 24.2%, which ranks 19th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 102 midsized communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Dyersville has a crude rate of 8.5% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 606th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Asthma

Dyersville has a crude rate of 8.9% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 80th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 9.1%, which ranks 125th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 102 midsized communities).



Dyersville has a crude rate of 6.1% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 353rd out of 958 lowa communities (37th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 4.6%, which ranks 120th out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities).







Dyersville has a crude rate of 9.0% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 224th out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 7.4%, which ranks 128th out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities).



Dyersville has a crude rate of 35.5% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 362nd out of 958 lowa communities (44th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 29.4%, which ranks 301st out of 905 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 2.4%, which ranks 36th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities).





Dyersville has a crude rate of 6.8% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 255th out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 7.0%, which ranks 193rd out of 905 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 59.0%, which ranks 415th out of 905 lowa communities (50th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 85.5%, which ranks 46th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 72.4%, which ranks 498th out of 905 lowa communities (62nd out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 80.6%, which ranks 124th out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 74.1%, which ranks 95th out of 905 lowa communities (22nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Dyersville has a crude rate of 46.5% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 220th out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 46.5%, which ranks 210th out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Dyersville has a crude rate of 41.7% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 271st out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 43.7%, which ranks 150th out of 905 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities).



Dental Visit

Dyersville has a crude rate of 73.1% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 64th out of 958 lowa communities (16th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 72.7%, which ranks 61st out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 102 midsized communities).



Dyersville has a crude rate of 77.6% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 248th out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Dyersville is 76.6%, which ranks 119th out of 905 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 midsized communities).











This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
