Health in Forest City: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Forest City,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Forest City ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Forest City's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Forest City. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Forest City that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Forest City, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Forest City compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 4,254, Forest City's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In lowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Forest City has a crude rate of 13.6% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 361st out of 958 lowa communities (42nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 13.1%, which ranks 533rd out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Physical Health

Forest City has a crude rate of 10.2% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 293rd out of 958 lowa communities (38th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 9.9%, which ranks 518th out of 905 lowa communities (51st out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Mental Health

Forest City has a crude rate of 15.5% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 825th out of 958 lowa communities (82nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 15.7%, which ranks 516th out of 905 lowa communities (59th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Forest City has a crude rate of 20.1% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 572nd out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 21.4%, which ranks 249th out of 905 lowa communities (49th out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Smoking

Forest City has a crude rate of 16.1% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 316th out of 958 lowa communities (44th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 18.0%, which ranks 536th out of 905 lowa communities (61st out of 102 midsized communities).



Physical Inactivity

Forest City has a crude rate of 25.0% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 344th out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 24.5%, which ranks 478th out of 905 lowa communities (48th out of 102 midsized communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Forest City has a crude rate of 30.7% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 561st out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 32.0%, which ranks 666th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Forest City has a crude rate of 25.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 216th out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 23.6%, which ranks 574th out of 905 lowa communities (59th out of 102 midsized communities).



High Blood Pressure

Forest City has a crude rate of 28.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 161st out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 27.0%, which ranks 368th out of 905 lowa communities (42nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Forest City has a crude rate of 7.2% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 223rd out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 6.4%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 9.6%, which ranks 513th out of 905 lowa communities (48th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 5.0%, which ranks 419th out of 905 lowa communities (49th out of 102 midsized communities).







The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 8.4%, which ranks 567th out of 905 lowa communities (56th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 30.0%, which ranks 537th out of 905 lowa communities (58th out of 102 midsized communities).





Forest City has a crude rate of 7.6% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 570th out of 958 lowa communities (50th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 7.9%, which ranks 498th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 102 midsized communities).



Forest City has a crude rate of 78.7% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 606th out of 958 lowa communities (64th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 59.8%, which ranks 126th out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 83.0%, which ranks 519th out of 905 lowa communities (60th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 72.4%, which ranks 498th out of 905 lowa communities (62nd out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 79.1%, which ranks 435th out of 905 lowa communities (50th out of 102 midsized communities).



Forest City has a crude rate of 70.0% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 720th out of 958 lowa communities (74th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 70.0%, which ranks 626th out of 905 lowa communities (67th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Forest City has a crude rate of 44.3% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 384th out of 958 lowa communities (37th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 45.1%, which ranks 309th out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Forest City has a crude rate of 35.2% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 807th out of 958 lowa communities (82nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 37.6%, which ranks 713th out of 905 lowa communities (81st out of 102 midsized communities).



Forest City has a crude rate of 67.8% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 407th out of 958 lowa communities (44th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 66.8%, which ranks 427th out of 905 lowa communities (49th out of 102 midsized communities).



Forest City has a crude rate of 76.4% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 432nd out of 958 lowa communities (53rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 73.1%, which ranks 594th out of 905 lowa communities (69th out of 102 midsized communities).

Disability



Forest City has a crude rate of 6.8% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 303rd out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Forest City is 5.9%, which ranks 360th out of 905 lowa communities (44th out of 102 midsized communities).



Vision disability

Forest City has a crude rate of 4.1% for vision disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 464th out of 958 lowa communities (43rd out of 102 midsized communities). This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
