

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Health in Guttenberg: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Guttenberg,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Guttenberg ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Guttenberg's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Guttenberg. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Guttenberg that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Guttenberg, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Guttenberg compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,667, Guttenberg's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In Iowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 15.2% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 649th out of 958 lowa communities (101st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 12.3%, which ranks 327th out of 905 lowa communities (64th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 11.4% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 656th out of 958 lowa communities (99th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 9.5%, which ranks 342nd out of 905 lowa communities (64th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 12.8% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 57th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 15.4%, which ranks 370th out of 905 lowa communities (60th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 17.2% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 110th out of 958 Iowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 22.8%, which ranks 686th out of 905 Iowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 15.8% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 270th out of 958 lowa communities (59th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 17.5%, which ranks 431st out of 905 lowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 28.4% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 754th out of 958 lowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 24.6%, which ranks 487th out of 905 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 28.6% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 154th out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 30.5%, which ranks 291st out of 905 lowa communities (47th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 31.8% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 858th out of 958 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 22.4%, which ranks 230th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 37.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 901st out of 958 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 27.5%, which ranks 492nd out of 905 lowa communities (82nd out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 10.3% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 913th out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 8.9% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 80th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 9.3%, which ranks 241st out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities).



Coronary Heart Disease

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 8.3% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 883rd out of 958 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 4.9%, which ranks 324th out of 905 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 8.3% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 721st out of 958 lowa communities (107th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 6.0%, which ranks 305th out of 905 lowa communities (56th out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 15.9% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 30th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 18.1%, which ranks 114th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 11.4% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 771st out of 958 lowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 7.8%, which ranks 268th out of 905 lowa communities (50th out of 138 small communities).



High Cholesterol

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 40.2% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 897th out of 958 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 29.9%, which ranks 501st out of 905 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 3.9% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 867th out of 958 lowa communities (120th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 2.5%, which ranks 142nd out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 37.5% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 448th out of 958 lowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 38.0%, which ranks 509th out of 905 lowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 4.0% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 832nd out of 958 lowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 2.5%, which ranks 230th out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 13.5% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 581st out of 958 lowa communities (88th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 12.8%, which ranks 448th out of 905 lowa communities (80th out of 138 small communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 6.9% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 296th out of 958 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 7.8%, which ranks 458th out of 905 lowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 84.1% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 34th out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 59.6%, which ranks 179th out of 905 lowa communities (22nd out of 138 small communities).



Cervical Cancer Screening

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 82.4% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 679th out of 958 lowa communities (114th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 82.5%, which ranks 639th out of 905 lowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities).



Annual Checkup

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 79.0% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 28th out of 958 lowa communities (1st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 73.3%, which ranks 211th out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 138 small communities).



Cholesterol Screening

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 86.1% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 39th out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 79.5%, which ranks 341st out of 905 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 72.4% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 370th out of 958 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 71.0%, which ranks 437th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 46.6% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 212th out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 46.6%, which ranks 203rd out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 36.4% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 717th out of 958 lowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 39.6%, which ranks 491st out of 905 lowa communities (85th out of 138 small communities).



Dental Visit

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 68.3% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 350th out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 67.1%, which ranks 401st out of 905 lowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities).



Mammography

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 71.4% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 945th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 70.0%, which ranks 839th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).

Disability


This section includes measures of physical and cognitive disabilities. Respondents were asked to report on six disabilities: hearing, vision, cognition, mobility, self-care, and independent living. Hearing disability

Guttenberg has a crude rate of 9.2% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 861st out of 958 lowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 5.8%, which ranks 287th out of 905 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities).





Guttenberg has a crude rate of 10.4% for cognitive disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 223rd out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 11.3%, which ranks 331st out of 905 lowa communities (60th out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 13.9% for mobility disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 788th out of 958 lowa communities (106th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 9.1%, which ranks 307th out of 905 lowa communities (59th out of 138 small communities).



Guttenberg has a crude rate of 3.7% for self-care disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 618th out of 958 lowa communities (96th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Guttenberg is 2.7%, which ranks 248th out of 905 lowa communities (45th out of 138 small communities).





Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
