

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Health in Hamburg: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Hamburg,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Hamburg ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Hamburg's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Hamburg. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Hamburg that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Hamburg, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Hamburg compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,087, Hamburg's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Hamburg has a crude rate of 16.4% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 811th out of 958 lowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 14.8%, which ranks 783rd out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Hamburg has a crude rate of 12.1% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 830th out of 958 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 11.0%, which ranks 806th out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Hamburg has a crude rate of 15.3% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 788th out of 958 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 16.4%, which ranks 744th out of 905 lowa communities (121st out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Hamburg has a crude rate of 17.9% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 203rd out of 958 lowa communities (38th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 20.6%, which ranks 95th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Hamburg has a crude rate of 18.0% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 694th out of 958 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 19.5%, which ranks 758th out of 905 lowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Hamburg has a crude rate of 29.1% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 816th out of 958 lowa communities (120th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 27.2%, which ranks 784th out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Hamburg has a crude rate of 31.5% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 728th out of 958 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 32.8%, which ranks 816th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Hamburg has a crude rate of 28.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 518th out of 958 lowa communities (65th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 23.3%, which ranks 494th out of 905 lowa communities (72nd out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Hamburg has a crude rate of 34.0% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 665th out of 958 lowa communities (94th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 28.8%, which ranks 755th out of 905 lowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Hamburg has a crude rate of 8.4% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 578th out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 6.4%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Hamburg has a crude rate of 9.6% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 716th out of 958 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 9.8%, which ranks 696th out of 905 lowa communities (107th out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 7.4% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 715th out of 958 lowa communities (96th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 5.5%, which ranks 759th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 7.0%, which ranks 753rd out of 905 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities).





Hamburg has a crude rate of 11.4% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 771st out of 958 lowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 9.2%, which ranks 782nd out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 38.4% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 770th out of 958 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 31.1%, which ranks 842nd out of 905 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 3.5% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 676th out of 958 lowa communities (84th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 2.8%, which ranks 762nd out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).







Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Hamburg has a crude rate of 8.8% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 831st out of 958 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 9.4%, which ranks 801st out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Hamburg has a crude rate of 80.9% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 310th out of 958 lowa communities (58th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 60.0%, which ranks 91st out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 82.1%, which ranks 700th out of 905 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 75.1% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 490th out of 958 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 72.1%, which ranks 597th out of 905 lowa communities (104th out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 81.1% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 719th out of 958 lowa communities (113th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 78.2%, which ranks 693rd out of 905 lowa communities (116th out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 70.1% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 708th out of 958 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 68.1%, which ranks 853rd out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 37.1% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 925th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 37.3%, which ranks 821st out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Hamburg has a crude rate of 38.6% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 519th out of 958 lowa communities (66th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 39.1%, which ranks 564th out of 905 lowa communities (96th out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 63.7% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 774th out of 958 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 62.7%, which ranks 760th out of 905 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities).



Hamburg has a crude rate of 75.4% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 624th out of 958 lowa communities (85th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 72.4%, which ranks 683rd out of 905 lowa communities (106th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Hamburg has a crude rate of 8.2% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 683rd out of 958 lowa communities (83rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 6.4%, which ranks 736th out of 905 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities).











Hamburg has a crude rate of 7.6% for independent living disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 785th out of 958 lowa communities (116th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Hamburg is 7.1%, which ranks 754th out of 905 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities).



This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
