

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Health in Holstein: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Holstein,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Holstein ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Holstein's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Holstein. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Holstein that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Holstein, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Holstein compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,560, Holstein's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Holstein has a crude rate of 13.8% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 391st out of 958 lowa communities (64th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 11.8%, which ranks 238th out of 905 lowa communities (45th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Holstein has a crude rate of 10.6% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 404th out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 9.2%, which ranks 238th out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Holstein has a crude rate of 13.1% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 102nd out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 15.0%, which ranks 241st out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Holstein has a crude rate of 17.8% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 188th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 21.7%, which ranks 358th out of 905 lowa communities (57th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Holstein has a crude rate of 14.7% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 141st out of 958 lowa communities (27th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 16.3%, which ranks 216th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Holstein has a crude rate of 25.6% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 415th out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 22.6%, which ranks 241st out of 905 lowa communities (50th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Holstein has a crude rate of 27.9% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 81st out of 958 lowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 29.4%, which ranks 142nd out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Holstein has a crude rate of 28.6% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 574th out of 958 lowa communities (74th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 21.8%, which ranks 124th out of 905 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Holstein has a crude rate of 32.5% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 517th out of 958 lowa communities (69th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 25.3%, which ranks 69th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Holstein has a crude rate of 9.6% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 841st out of 958 lowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 6.4%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Holstein has a crude rate of 8.8% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 44th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 9.2%, which ranks 185th out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 7.3% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 696th out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 4.7%, which ranks 187th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 7.4% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 448th out of 958 lowa communities (66th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 5.8%, which ranks 226th out of 905 lowa communities (40th out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 16.2% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 48th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 17.9%, which ranks 88th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities).



Diabetes

Holstein has a crude rate of 10.3% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 523rd out of 958 lowa communities (82nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 7.9%, which ranks 307th out of 905 lowa communities (57th out of 138 small communities).



High Cholesterol

Holstein has a crude rate of 36.7% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 539th out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 29.0%, which ranks 167th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 3.6% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 732nd out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 2.5%, which ranks 142nd out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 33.6% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 73rd out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 34.7%, which ranks 98th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 3.7% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 703rd out of 958 lowa communities (92nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 2.5%, which ranks 230th out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 12.7% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 433rd out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 11.7%, which ranks 242nd out of 905 lowa communities (45th out of 138 small communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Holstein has a crude rate of 6.9% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 296th out of 958 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 7.2%, which ranks 266th out of 905 lowa communities (54th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Holstein has a crude rate of 81.8% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 190th out of 958 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 58.1%, which ranks 737th out of 905 lowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities).



Cervical Cancer Screening

Holstein has a crude rate of 83.8% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 352nd out of 958 lowa communities (58th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 83.7%, which ranks 294th out of 905 lowa communities (60th out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 76.9% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 177th out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 72.7%, which ranks 396th out of 905 lowa communities (64th out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 84.3% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 172nd out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 79.9%, which ranks 258th out of 905 lowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Holstein has a crude rate of 72.1% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 397th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 71.6%, which ranks 347th out of 905 lowa communities (62nd out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Holstein has a crude rate of 45.3% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 309th out of 958 lowa communities (47th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 45.5%, which ranks 277th out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Holstein has a crude rate of 35.4% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 796th out of 958 lowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 39.7%, which ranks 472nd out of 905 lowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 70.3% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 184th out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 69.8%, which ranks 190th out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities).



Holstein has a crude rate of 77.3% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 282nd out of 958 lowa communities (37th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 75.1%, which ranks 233rd out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Holstein has a crude rate of 8.7% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 781st out of 958 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Holstein is 5.7%, which ranks 219th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities).



This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
