

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Health in Jesup: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Jesup,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Jesup ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Jesup's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Jesup. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Jesup that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Jesup, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Jesup compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,502, Jesup's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In lowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Jesup has a crude rate of 12.3% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 175th out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 11.7%, which ranks 215th out of 905 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Physical Health

Jesup has a crude rate of 9.5% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 151st out of 958 lowa communities (27th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 9.1%, which ranks 210th out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Mental Health

Jesup has a crude rate of 14.7% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 625th out of 958 lowa communities (58th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 15.1%, which ranks 270th out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Jesup has a crude rate of 23.3% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 909th out of 958 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 24.2%, which ranks 892nd out of 905 lowa communities (100th out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Smoking

Jesup has a crude rate of 16.4% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 380th out of 958 lowa communities (52nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 16.7%, which ranks 273rd out of 905 lowa communities (42nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Physical Inactivity

Jesup has a crude rate of 23.9% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 240th out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 23.1%, which ranks 296th out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 102 midsized communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Jesup has a crude rate of 31.7% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 775th out of 958 lowa communities (85th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 32.0%, which ranks 666th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Jesup has a crude rate of 24.7% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 183rd out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 23.0%, which ranks 401st out of 905 lowa communities (45th out of 102 midsized communities).



High Blood Pressure

Jesup has a crude rate of 28.3% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 136th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 26.5%, which ranks 262nd out of 905 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Jesup has a crude rate of 7.0% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 177th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 6.4%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Asthma

Jesup has a crude rate of 9.3% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 405th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 9.3%, which ranks 241st out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 5.1% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 137th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 4.7%, which ranks 187th out of 905 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 6.2% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 155th out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 5.8%, which ranks 226th out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 17.7% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 356th out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 18.0%, which ranks 95th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 8.3% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 127th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 7.6%, which ranks 190th out of 905 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities).



High Cholesterol

Jesup has a crude rate of 34.7% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 261st out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 30.5%, which ranks 701st out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 2.7% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 135th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 2.5%, which ranks 142nd out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 34.9% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 131st out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 34.8%, which ranks 105th out of 905 lowa communities (18th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 2.7% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 152nd out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 2.4%, which ranks 116th out of 905 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 11.9% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 300th out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 11.8%, which ranks 261st out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 102 midsized communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Jesup has a crude rate of 7.0% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 338th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 7.1%, which ranks 234th out of 905 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities).



Taking BP Medication

Jesup has a crude rate of 76.7% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 795th out of 958 lowa communities (78th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 58.2%, which ranks 709th out of 905 lowa communities (84th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 84.1% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 284th out of 958 lowa communities (33rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 84.4%, which ranks 168th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 74.0% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 703rd out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 73.0%, which ranks 301st out of 905 lowa communities (39th out of 102 midsized communities).



Cholesterol Screening

Jesup has a crude rate of 80.9% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 738th out of 958 lowa communities (66th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 79.7%, which ranks 296th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 102 midsized communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Jesup has a crude rate of 72.0% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 411th out of 958 lowa communities (44th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 72.5%, which ranks 209th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Jesup has a crude rate of 45.4% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 306th out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 45.6%, which ranks 271st out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Jesup has a crude rate of 39.8% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 407th out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 41.3%, which ranks 330th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Dental Visit

Jesup has a crude rate of 69.5% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 257th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 69.4%, which ranks 216th out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 76.4% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 432nd out of 958 lowa communities (53rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 75.0%, which ranks 246th out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 102 midsized communities).

Disability



Jesup has a crude rate of 6.1% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 160th out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 5.6%, which ranks 163rd out of 905 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities).





Jesup has a crude rate of 10.8% for cognitive disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 330th out of 958 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 10.9%, which ranks 223rd out of 905 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities).



Jesup has a crude rate of 9.6% for mobility disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 154th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jesup is 8.7%, which ranks 198th out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 102 midsized communities).



Self-care disability

Jesup has a crude rate of 2.8% for self-care disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 142nd out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities). 



The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
