Health in Jewell Junction: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Jewell Junction,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Jewell Junction ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Jewell Junction's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Jewell Junction. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Jewell Junction that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Jewell Junction, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Jewell Junction compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,284, Jewell Junction's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 12.0% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 141st out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 11.1%, which ranks 141st out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 9.5% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 151st out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 8.8%, which ranks 140th out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 13.6% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 231st out of 958 lowa communities (40th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 14.5%, which ranks 121st out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 20.9% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 720th out of 958 lowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 22.5%, which ranks 609th out of 905 lowa communities (91st out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 15.5% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 233rd out of 958 lowa communities (47th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 15.1%, which ranks 123rd out of 905 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 22.5% for no leisuretime physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 148th out of 958 lowa communities (27th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 21.6%, which ranks 143rd out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 29.2% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 240th out of 958 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 29.2%, which ranks 124th out of 905 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 25.9% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 282nd out of 958 lowa communities (38th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 22.6%, which ranks 287th out of 905 lowa communities (42nd out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 29.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 228th out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 26.4%, which ranks 244th out of 905 lowa communities (38th out of 138 small communities).



Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 7.5% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 302nd out of 958 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 9.2% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 311th out of 958 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 9.3%, which ranks 241st out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 4.6%, which ranks 120th out of 905 lowa communities (24th out of 138 small communities).







The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 7.5%, which ranks 147th out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 28.9%, which ranks 133rd out of 905 lowa communities (24th out of 138 small communities).







Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 6.3% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 133rd out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 6.7%, which ranks 132nd out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 138 small communities).



Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 77.8% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 710th out of 958 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 58.6%, which ranks 579th out of 905 lowa communities (89th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 84.7%, which ranks 126th out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 73.3%, which ranks 211th out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 80.4%, which ranks 157th out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities).



Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 71.4% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 501st out of 958 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 71.9%, which ranks 295th out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 42.4% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 617th out of 958 lowa communities (98th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 42.5%, which ranks 549th out of 905 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 40.4% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 364th out of 958 lowa communities (50th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 41.2%, which ranks 345th out of 905 lowa communities (60th out of 138 small communities).



Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 68.3% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 350th out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 68.0%, which ranks 315th out of 905 lowa communities (61st out of 138 small communities).



Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 76.3% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 448th out of 958 lowa communities (58th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 74.4%, which ranks 338th out of 905 lowa communities (57th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Hearing disability

Jewell Junction has a crude rate of 6.1% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 160th out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Jewell Junction is 5.5%, which ranks 110th out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities).





This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
