

Health in La Porte City: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of La Porte City,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how La Porte City ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify La Porte City's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to La Porte City. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in La Porte City that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of La Porte City, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how La Porte City compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,347, La Porte City's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In Iowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

La Porte City has a crude rate of 13.5% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 346th out of 958 lowa communities (59th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 12.2%, which ranks 312th out of 905 lowa communities (61st out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

La Porte City has a crude rate of 10.3% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 323rd out of 958 lowa communities (54th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 9.4%, which ranks 300th out of 905 lowa communities (57th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

La Porte City has a crude rate of 14.4% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 514th out of 958 lowa communities (87th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 15.9%, which ranks 596th out of 905 lowa communities (93rd out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

La Porte City has a crude rate of 20.5% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 637th out of 958 Iowa communities (96th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 23.1%, which ranks 753rd out of 905 Iowa communities (117th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

La Porte City has a crude rate of 16.1% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 316th out of 958 Iowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 16.7%, which ranks 273rd out of 905 Iowa communities (54th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

La Porte City has a crude rate of 25.0% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 344th out of 958 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 23.1%, which ranks 296th out of 905 lowa communities (60th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

La Porte City has a crude rate of 31.6% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 748th out of 958 lowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 32.3%, which ranks 717th out of 905 lowa communities (116th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

La Porte City has a crude rate of 30.0% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 714th out of 958 lowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 25.1%, which ranks 867th out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

La Porte City has a crude rate of 31.6% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 408th out of 958 lowa communities (58th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 26.8%, which ranks 319th out of 905 lowa communities (58th out of 138 small communities).



La Porte City has a crude rate of 8.4% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 578th out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

La Porte City has a crude rate of 9.3% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 405th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 9.6%, which ranks 513th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 4.7%, which ranks 187th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 6.1%, which ranks 346th out of 905 lowa communities (66th out of 138 small communities).







La Porte City has a crude rate of 36.4% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 498th out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 30.3%, which ranks 634th out of 905 lowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities).









The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 11.0%, which ranks 151st out of 905 lowa communities (32nd out of 138 small communities).



La Porte City has a crude rate of 6.7% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 217th out of 958 lowa communities (35th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 6.9%, which ranks 168th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

La Porte City has a crude rate of 78.7% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 606th out of 958 lowa communities (96th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 57.5%, which ranks 830th out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).



La Porte City has a crude rate of 86.1% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 54th out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 85.1%, which ranks 79th out of 905 Iowa communities (15th out of 138 small communities).



La Porte City has a crude rate of 78.3% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 57th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 75.9%, which ranks 18th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities).



La Porte City has a crude rate of 83.5% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 298th out of 958 lowa communities (50th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 80.0%, which ranks 237th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

La Porte City has a crude rate of 75.5% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 60th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 75.4%, which ranks 47th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

La Porte City has a crude rate of 49.0% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 99th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 49.1%, which ranks 87th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

La Porte City has a crude rate of 44.0% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 136th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 47.9%, which ranks 28th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).



La Porte City has a crude rate of 71.3% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 130th out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 71.0%, which ranks 135th out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



La Porte City has a crude rate of 80.5% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 35th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for La Porte City is 78.3%, which ranks 38th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Hearing disability

La Porte City has a crude rate of 7.4% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 470th out of 958 lowa communities (59th out of 138 small communities). The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
