

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Health in Lamoni: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Lamoni,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Lamoni ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Lamoni's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Lamoni. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Lamoni that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Lamoni, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Lamoni compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,284, Lamoni's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Lamoni has a crude rate of 14.1% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 436th out of 958 lowa communities (70th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 15.7%, which ranks 843rd out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Lamoni has a crude rate of 9.9% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 221st out of 958 lowa communities (37th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 11.4%, which ranks 866th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Lamoni has a crude rate of 18.6% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 955th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 16.9%, which ranks 834th out of 905 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Lamoni has a crude rate of 20.7% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 687th out of 958 lowa communities (104th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 20.0%, which ranks 37th out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Lamoni has a crude rate of 14.3% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 92nd out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 19.7%, which ranks 771st out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Lamoni has a crude rate of 25.3% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 384th out of 958 lowa communities (62nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 27.2%, which ranks 784th out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Lamoni has a crude rate of 30.2% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 456th out of 958 lowa communities (82nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 32.8%, which ranks 816th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Lamoni has a crude rate of 20.6% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 29th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 25.0%, which ranks 855th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Lamoni has a crude rate of 25.2% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 47th out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 29.5%, which ranks 829th out of 905 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Lamoni has a crude rate of 5.9% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 29th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Lamoni has a crude rate of 10.5% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 952nd out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 10.3%, which ranks 874th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 5.4% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 172nd out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 5.7%, which ranks 836th out of 905 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 6.5% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 213th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 7.6%, which ranks 855th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).





Lamoni has a crude rate of 8.1% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 113th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 9.8%, which ranks 864th out of 905 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 31.0% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 45th out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 31.0%, which ranks 818th out of 905 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 2.7% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 135th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 2.9%, which ranks 858th out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 33.1% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 58th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 39.3%, which ranks 688th out of 905 lowa communities (107th out of 138 small communities).





Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Lamoni has a crude rate of 9.0% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 853rd out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 9.2%, which ranks 781st out of 905 lowa communities (126th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Lamoni has a crude rate of 74.5% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 889th out of 958 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 60.6%, which ranks 50th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 75.0% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 957th out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 81.8%, which ranks 744th out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 71.8% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 914th out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 72.6%, which ranks 435th out of 905 lowa communities (70th out of 138 small communities).



Cholesterol Screening

Lamoni has a crude rate of 69.8% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 955th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 77.5%, which ranks 805th out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 71.2% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 530th out of 958 lowa communities (87th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 69.1%, which ranks 766th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 37.8% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 912th out of 958 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 37.6%, which ranks 813th out of 905 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Lamoni has a crude rate of 33.0% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 922nd out of 958 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 35.1%, which ranks 833rd out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 62.7% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 842nd out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 60.9%, which ranks 847th out of 905 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities).



Lamoni has a crude rate of 73.5% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 873rd out of 958 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 70.0%, which ranks 839th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Hearing disability

Lamoni has a crude rate of 6.6% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 254th out of 958 lowa communities (37th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 6.7%, which ranks 838th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).







Lamoni has a crude rate of 10.4% for mobility disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 245th out of 958 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 11.9%, which ranks 872nd out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).





Lamoni has a crude rate of 8.1% for independent living disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 863rd out of 958 lowa communities (126th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lamoni is 7.9%, which ranks 868th out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).



Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
