Health in Le Mars: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Le Mars,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Le Mars ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Le Mars's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Le Mars. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Le Mars that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Le Mars, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Le Mars compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 10,549, Le Mars's similarly sized communities are defined as mid-large communities. In lowa, mid-large communities have an average population of 20,750, and there are 31 communities that are considered mid-large communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Le Mars has a crude rate of 13.3% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 312th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 12.3%, which ranks 327th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Poor Physical Health

Le Mars has a crude rate of 10.2% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 293rd out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 9.4%, which ranks 300th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Poor Mental Health

Le Mars has a crude rate of 14.3% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 464th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 15.2%, which ranks 302nd out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 31 mid-large communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Le Mars has a crude rate of 20.1% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 572nd out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 22.1%, which ranks 478th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Current Smoking

Le Mars has a crude rate of 15.9% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 286th out of 958 lowa communities (15th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 16.6%, which ranks 259th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Physical Inactivity

Le Mars has a crude rate of 24.2% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 265th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 22.9%, which ranks 278th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Le Mars has a crude rate of 27.9% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 81st out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 28.5%, which ranks 68th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 31 mid-large communities).

Health Outcomes



Le Mars has a crude rate of 26.1% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 301st out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 22.5%, which ranks 261st out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 31 mid-large communities).



High Blood Pressure

Le Mars has a crude rate of 31.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 424th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 27.8%, which ranks 572nd out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 31 mid-large communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Le Mars has a crude rate of 7.9% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 418th out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Current Asthma

Le Mars has a crude rate of 9.3% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 405th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 9.4%, which ranks 330th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities).







Le Mars has a crude rate of 9.5% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 327th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 8.1%, which ranks 401st out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 30.5%, which ranks 701st out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Le Mars has a crude rate of 7.6% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 570th out of 958 lowa communities (18th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 7.9%, which ranks 498th out of 905 lowa communities (18th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Le Mars has a crude rate of 79.5% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 505th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 60.0%, which ranks 91st out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 31 mid-large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 83.4%, which ranks 372nd out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Le Mars has a crude rate of 76.2% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 273rd out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 74.1%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Le Mars has a crude rate of 83.1% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 365th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 80.6%, which ranks 124th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Le Mars has a crude rate of 71.7% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 454th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 72.2%, which ranks 250th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Le Mars has a crude rate of 46.8% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 205th out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 47.2%, which ranks 161st out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Le Mars has a crude rate of 37.7% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 601st out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 40.0%, which ranks 439th out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 31 mid-large communities).



Dental Visit

Le Mars has a crude rate of 69.6% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 246th out of 958 lowa communities (15th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 69.2%, which ranks 234th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Le Mars has a crude rate of 74.4% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 772nd out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Le Mars is 72.3%, which ranks 695th out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 31 mid-large communities).

Disability



Hearing disability

Le Mars has a crude rate of 7.0% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 358th out of 958 lowa communities (18th out of 31 mid-large communities). This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
