Health in Lenox: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Lenox,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Lenox ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Lenox's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Lenox. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Lenox that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Lenox, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Lenox compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,488, Lenox's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Lenox has a crude rate of 19.3% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 941st out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 17.2%, which ranks 887th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Lenox has a crude rate of 13.0% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 921st out of 958 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 11.6%, which ranks 880th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Lenox has a crude rate of 14.9% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 674th out of 958 lowa communities (114th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 16.4%, which ranks 744th out of 905 lowa communities (121st out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Lenox has a crude rate of 17.2% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 110th out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 20.4%, which ranks 68th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Lenox has a crude rate of 18.4% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 759th out of 958 lowa communities (126th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 20.3%, which ranks 822nd out of 905 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Lenox has a crude rate of 33.0% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 947th out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 30.5%, which ranks 892nd out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Lenox has a crude rate of 31.3% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 690th out of 958 lowa communities (109th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 32.9%, which ranks 826th out of 905 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Arthritis

Lenox has a crude rate of 30.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 732nd out of 958 lowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Lenox is 23.9%, which ranks 652nd out of 905 lowa communities (101st out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Lenox has a crude rate of 36.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 824th out of 958 lowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 29.4%, which ranks 817th out of 905 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities).



Lenox has a crude rate of 8.9% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 704th out of 958 lowa communities (86th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 6.3%, which ranks 16th out of 905 lowa communities (2nd out of 138 small communities).



Lenox has a crude rate of 9.6% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 716th out of 958 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 9.9%, which ranks 762nd out of 905 lowa communities (120th out of 138 small communities).





















Lenox has a crude rate of 12.9% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 944th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 13.7%, which ranks 892nd out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).











The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 67.3%, which ranks 886th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



Lenox has a crude rate of 40.5% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 774th out of 958 lowa communities (117th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 40.6%, which ranks 712th out of 905 lowa communities (120th out of 138 small communities).



Lenox has a crude rate of 34.7% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 844th out of 958 lowa communities (120th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 37.9%, which ranks 683rd out of 905 lowa communities (117th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 58.7%, which ranks 883rd out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).





Lenox has a crude rate of 9.8% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 913th out of 958 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lenox is 6.8%, which ranks 868th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).







The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
