

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Health in Leon: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Leon,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Leon ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Leon's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Leon. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the lowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Leon that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Leon, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Leon compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,707, Leon's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Leon has a crude rate of 17.6% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 895th out of 958 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 15.7%, which ranks 843rd out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Leon has a crude rate of 12.6% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 886th out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 11.4%, which ranks 866th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Leon has a crude rate of 15.7% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 856th out of 958 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 17.1%, which ranks 859th out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Leon has a crude rate of 17.6% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 162nd out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 20.5%, which ranks 78th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Leon has a crude rate of 19.0% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 828th out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 20.8%, which ranks 849th out of 905 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Leon has a crude rate of 30.4% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 887th out of 958 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 28.0%, which ranks 829th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Leon has a crude rate of 31.1% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 656th out of 958 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 32.6%, which ranks 794th out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Leon has a crude rate of 30.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 732nd out of 958 lowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 24.8%, which ranks 834th out of 905 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Leon has a crude rate of 34.4% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 700th out of 958 lowa communities (101st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 28.8%, which ranks 755th out of 905 lowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Leon has a crude rate of 8.7% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 658th out of 958 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 6.4%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Leon has a crude rate of 10.0% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 898th out of 958 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 10.2%, which ranks 856th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).



Leon has a crude rate of 7.7% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 790th out of 958 lowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 5.6%, which ranks 797th out of 905 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities).



Leon has a crude rate of 9.2% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 892nd out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 7.7%, which ranks 865th out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).



Leon has a crude rate of 18.9% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 730th out of 958 lowa communities (111th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 20.2%, which ranks 787th out of 905 lowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities).



Leon has a crude rate of 11.4% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 771st out of 958 lowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 9.2%, which ranks 782nd out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Leon has a crude rate of 38.1% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 737th out of 958 lowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 30.9%, which ranks 790th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



Leon has a crude rate of 3.7% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 787th out of 958 lowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 2.8%, which ranks 762nd out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).







Leon has a crude rate of 17.8% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 931st out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 16.8%, which ranks 871st out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).

Prevention



Leon has a crude rate of 9.1% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 861st out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 9.5%, which ranks 812th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Leon has a crude rate of 81.2% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 271st out of 958 lowa communities (57th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 59.9%, which ranks 107th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 81.4%, which ranks 785th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 71.8%, which ranks 686th out of 905 lowa communities (114th out of 138 small communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 68.9%, which ranks 787th out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Leon has a crude rate of 37.9% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 910th out of 958 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 37.6%, which ranks 813th out of 905 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Leon has a crude rate of 32.5% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 932nd out of 958 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 34.9%, which ranks 837th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 60.5%, which ranks 858th out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).



Disability



Leon has a crude rate of 8.9% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 818th out of 958 lowa communities (109th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 6.6%, which ranks 800th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).













Leon has a crude rate of 30.4% for any disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 905th out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Leon is 26.7%, which ranks 854th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).

Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
