

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### Health in Lisbon: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Lisbon,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Lisbon ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Lisbon's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Lisbon. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

#### How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Lisbon that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Lisbon, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Lisbon compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,874, Lisbon's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

#### Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

### **Health Status**


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. #### **Poor General Health**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 10.2% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 45th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 9.9%, which ranks 41st out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Poor Physical Health**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 8.7% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 69th out of 958 lowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 8.3%, which ranks 52nd out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Poor Mental Health**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 14.1% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 390th out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 14.4%, which ranks 103rd out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities).

### **Health Risk Behaviors**


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. #### **Binge Drinking**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 23.1% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 902nd out of 958 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 23.5%, which ranks 828th out of 905 lowa communities (128th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Current Smoking**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 14.5% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 117th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 14.0%, which ranks 55th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Physical Inactivity**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 19.1% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 38th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 18.9%, which ranks 35th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities).



#### Sleep <7 hours

Lisbon has a crude rate of 29.9% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 374th out of 958 lowa communities (66th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 29.6%, which ranks 155th out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities).

### **Health Outcomes**


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. #### Arthritis

Lisbon has a crude rate of 22.0% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 66th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Lisbon is 20.8%, which ranks 41st out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities).



#### **High Blood Pressure**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 28.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 161st out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 27.4%, which ranks 469th out of 905 lowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities).



#### Cancer (except skin)

Lisbon has a crude rate of 6.7% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 126th out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



#### **Current Asthma**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 9.3% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 405th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 9.3%, which ranks 241st out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Coronary Heart Disease**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 4.5% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 66th out of 958 lowa communities (15th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 4.3%, which ranks 30th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities).



Lisbon has a crude rate of 5.3% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 61st out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 5.0%, which ranks 45th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities).



#### Depression

Lisbon has a crude rate of 21.1% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 928th out of 958 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 21.3%, which ranks 869th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).



#### Diabetes

Lisbon has a crude rate of 7.6% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 73rd out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 7.1%, which ranks 57th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities).



#### **High Cholesterol**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 32.5% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 90th out of 958 lowa communities (22nd out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Lisbon is 29.2%, which ranks 242nd out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



#### **Chronic Kidney Disease**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 2.5% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 86th out of 958 Iowa communities (18th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 2.4%, which ranks 36th out of 905 Iowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities).



#### Obesity

Lisbon has a crude rate of 38.2% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 568th out of 958 lowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Lisbon is 37.1%, which ranks 380th out of 905 lowa communities (57th out of 138 small communities).



Lisbon has a crude rate of 2.3% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 59th out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Lisbon is 2.3%, which ranks 49th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities).



#### All Teeth Lost

Lisbon has a crude rate of 8.5% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 38th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Lisbon is 8.7%, which ranks 35th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities).

### Prevention



#### Lack of Health Insurance

Lisbon has a crude rate of 5.4% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 25th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 5.6%, which ranks 26th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Taking BP Medication**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 75.7% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 858th out of 958 lowa communities (120th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 58.6%, which ranks 579th out of 905 lowa communities (89th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Cervical Cancer Screening**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 87.2% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 21st out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 86.7%, which ranks 11th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Annual Checkup**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 75.6% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 395th out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 75.0%, which ranks 28th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Cholesterol Screening**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 83.4% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 317th out of 958 lowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 82.0%, which ranks 27th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Colorectal Cancer Screening**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 76.4% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 33rd out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 76.9%, which ranks 10th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities).



#### Core preventive services for older men

Lisbon has a crude rate of 43.7% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 453rd out of 958 lowa communities (70th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 43.8%, which ranks 417th out of 905 lowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities).



#### Core preventive services for older women

Lisbon has a crude rate of 46.6% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 62nd out of 958 Iowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 45.4%, which ranks 88th out of 905 Iowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Dental Visit**

Lisbon has a crude rate of 73.3% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 55th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 73.3%, which ranks 52nd out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities).



#### Mammography

Lisbon has a crude rate of 78.5% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 157th out of 958 Iowa communities (18th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 77.7%, which ranks 64th out of 905 Iowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities).

### Disability



Lisbon has a crude rate of 5.2% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 60th out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 5.2%, which ranks 41st out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities).





Lisbon has a crude rate of 9.4% for cognitive disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 59th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lisbon is 9.6%, which ranks 48th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities).









This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
