

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Health in Lone Tree: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Lone Tree,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Lone Tree ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Lone Tree's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Lone Tree. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the lowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Lone Tree that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Lone Tree, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Lone Tree compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,261, Lone Tree's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 12.1% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 153rd out of 958 lowa communities (27th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 11.2%, which ranks 150th out of 905 lowa communities (32nd out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 9.4% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 137th out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 8.8%, which ranks 140th out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 14.2% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 432nd out of 958 lowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 15.1%, which ranks 270th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 21.2% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 758th out of 958 lowa communities (111th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 22.7%, which ranks 668th out of 905 lowa communities (98th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 14.8% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 153rd out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 14.8%, which ranks 97th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 21.9% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 114th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 20.9%, which ranks 95th out of 905 lowa communities (18th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 28.9% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 196th out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 29.1%, which ranks 111th out of 905 lowa communities (20th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 24.8% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 192nd out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 22.0%, which ranks 163rd out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 27.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 96th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 24.3%, which ranks 23rd out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 7.6% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 335th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 6.6%, which ranks 831st out of 905 lowa communities (126th out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 9.5% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 625th out of 958 lowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 9.6%, which ranks 513th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 5.4% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 172nd out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 4.6%, which ranks 120th out of 905 lowa communities (24th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 6.1% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 137th out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 5.5%, which ranks 144th out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 19.4% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 827th out of 958 lowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 20.1%, which ranks 758th out of 905 lowa communities (116th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 8.2% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 121st out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 7.3%, which ranks 103rd out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 31.4% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 54th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 27.0%, which ranks 7th out of 905 lowa communities (2nd out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 2.8% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 186th out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 2.5%, which ranks 142nd out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 32.7% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 47th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 32.3%, which ranks 33rd out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities).





Lone Tree has a crude rate of 10.9% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 164th out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 10.5%, which ranks 115th out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 6.8% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 255th out of 958 lowa communities (44th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 7.1%, which ranks 234th out of 905 lowa communities (49th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 76.1% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 838th out of 958 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 56.2%, which ranks 882nd out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 84.5% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 217th out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 84.3%, which ranks 182nd out of 905 lowa communities (40th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 73.0% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 838th out of 958 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 71.3%, which ranks 803rd out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 82.5% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 501st out of 958 lowa communities (80th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 80.0%, which ranks 237th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 71.5% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 486th out of 958 lowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 72.9%, which ranks 176th out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 42.7% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 581st out of 958 lowa communities (94th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 43.1%, which ranks 496th out of 905 lowa communities (90th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 42.1% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 245th out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 45.7%, which ranks 75th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities).



Dental Visit

Lone Tree has a crude rate of 68.7% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 318th out of 958 lowa communities (58th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 68.5%, which ranks 284th out of 905 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities).



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 79.7% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 65th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 76.4%, which ranks 127th out of 905 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Lone Tree has a crude rate of 6.3% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 188th out of 958 lowa communities (27th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Lone Tree is 5.5%, which ranks 110th out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities).







Lone Tree has a crude rate of 3.0% for self-care disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 220th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities). 



The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
