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Health in Maquoketa: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Maquoketa,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Maquoketa ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Maquoketa's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Maquoketa. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Maquoketa that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Maquoketa, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Maquoketa compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 6,123, Maquoketa's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In lowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Maquoketa has a crude rate of 17.9% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 906th out of 958 lowa communities (92nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 16.3%, which ranks 872nd out of 905 lowa communities (92nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Physical Health

Maquoketa has a crude rate of 12.9% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 914th out of 958 lowa communities (97th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 11.8%, which ranks 886th out of 905 lowa communities (96th out of 102 midsized communities).



Maquoketa has a crude rate of 16.5% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 924th out of 958 lowa communities (95th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 17.9%, which ranks 895th out of 905 lowa communities (99th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Maquoketa has a crude rate of 18.2% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 252nd out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 20.7%, which ranks 108th out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities).



Maquoketa has a crude rate of 20.8% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 933rd out of 958 lowa communities (99th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 22.0%, which ranks 890th out of 905 lowa communities (98th out of 102 midsized communities).



Physical Inactivity

Maquoketa has a crude rate of 30.5% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 891st out of 958 lowa communities (84th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 28.6%, which ranks 850th out of 905 lowa communities (86th out of 102 midsized communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Maquoketa has a crude rate of 31.2% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 675th out of 958 lowa communities (76th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 32.3%, which ranks 717th out of 905 lowa communities (80th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Maquoketa has a crude rate of 30.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 732nd out of 958 lowa communities (87th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 25.4%, which ranks 882nd out of 905 lowa communities (93rd out of 102 midsized communities).



High Blood Pressure

Maquoketa has a crude rate of 34.9% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 742nd out of 958 lowa communities (89th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 29.9%, which ranks 865th out of 905 lowa communities (88th out of 102 midsized communities).



Maquoketa has a crude rate of 8.4% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 578th out of 958 lowa communities (57th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 10.3%, which ranks 874th out of 905 lowa communities (96th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 9.9%, which ranks 870th out of 905 lowa communities (91st out of 102 midsized communities).





Maquoketa has a crude rate of 9.0% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 853rd out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 9.3%, which ranks 788th out of 905 lowa communities (72nd out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 61.2%, which ranks 25th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 102 midsized communities).







The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 76.1%, which ranks 894th out of 905 lowa communities (101st out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 68.9%, which ranks 787th out of 905 lowa communities (79th out of 102 midsized communities).



Maquoketa has a crude rate of 37.6% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 916th out of 958 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 37.8%, which ranks 808th out of 905 lowa communities (95th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Maquoketa has a crude rate of 38.6% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 519th out of 958 lowa communities (45th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 40.5%, which ranks 408th out of 905 lowa communities (51st out of 102 midsized communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Maquoketa is 70.6%, which ranks 834th out of 905 lowa communities (96th out of 102 midsized communities).







Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
