# Health in Monona: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Monona,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Monona ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Monona's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Monona. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

# **How to Use this Report**

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Monona that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Monona, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Monona compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,571, Monona's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

#### Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

## **Health Status**


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. #### **Poor General Health**

Monona has a crude rate of 17.4% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 880th out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 15.6%, which ranks 839th out of 905 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Poor Physical Health**

Monona has a crude rate of 12.5% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 880th out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 11.3%, which ranks 848th out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Poor Mental Health**

Monona has a crude rate of 15.7% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 856th out of 958 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 17.3%, which ranks 874th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).

# **Health Risk Behaviors**


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. ## **Binge Drinking**

Monona has a crude rate of 18.4% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 283rd out of 958 lowa communities (50th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 21.3%, which ranks 230th out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Current Smoking**

Monona has a crude rate of 19.8% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 890th out of 958 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 21.2%, which ranks 868th out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Physical Inactivity**

Monona has a crude rate of 30.8% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 900th out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 28.6%, which ranks 850th out of 905 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities).



# Sleep <7 hours

Monona has a crude rate of 30.7% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 561st out of 958 lowa communities (92nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 31.7%, which ranks 580th out of 905 lowa communities (96th out of 138 small communities).

# **Health Outcomes**



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. #### **Arthritis**

Monona has a crude rate of 29.5% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 654th out of 958 lowa communities (87th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 24.4%, which ranks 768th out of 905 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **High Blood Pressure**

Monona has a crude rate of 35.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 803rd out of 958 lowa communities (113th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 30.0%, which ranks 871st out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).



#### Cancer (except skin)

Monona has a crude rate of 8.7% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 658th out of 958 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



#### **Current Asthma**

Monona has a crude rate of 9.9% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 868th out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 10.2%, which ranks 856th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Coronary Heart Disease**

Monona has a crude rate of 8.0% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 845th out of 958 lowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 5.8%, which ranks 865th out of 905 lowa communities (137th out of 138 small communities).



Monona has a crude rate of 9.1% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 878th out of 958 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 7.7%, which ranks 865th out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Depression**

Monona has a crude rate of 18.3% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 568th out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 19.7%, which ranks 657th out of 905 lowa communities (99th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Diabetes**

Monona has a crude rate of 11.6% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 806th out of 958 lowa communities (120th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 9.4%, which ranks 819th out of 905 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities).



#### **High Cholesterol**

Monona has a crude rate of 37.9% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 704th out of 958 lowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 30.9%, which ranks 790th out of 905 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Chronic Kidney Disease**

Monona has a crude rate of 3.7% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 787th out of 958 lowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 2.8%, which ranks 762nd out of 905 lowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).







Monona has a crude rate of 17.6% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 929th out of 958 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 16.5%, which ranks 861st out of 905 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities).

# **Prevention**



#### **Lack of Health Insurance**

Monona has a crude rate of 9.1% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 861st out of 958 lowa communities (131st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 9.4%, which ranks 801st out of 905 lowa communities (129th out of 138 small communities).



# **Taking BP Medication**

Monona has a crude rate of 81.5% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 229th out of 958 lowa communities (48th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 61.0%, which ranks 30th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 80.7%, which ranks 826th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



Monona has a crude rate of 76.4% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 234th out of 958 lowa communities (45th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 73.4%, which ranks 190th out of 905 lowa communities (35th out of 138 small communities).



## **Cholesterol Screening**

Monona has a crude rate of 81.1% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 719th out of 958 lowa communities (113th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 77.2%, which ranks 842nd out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Colorectal Cancer Screening**

Monona has a crude rate of 67.7% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 899th out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 68.1%, which ranks 853rd out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



#### Core preventive services for older men

Monona has a crude rate of 43.5% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 475th out of 958 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 43.0%, which ranks 507th out of 905 lowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities).



#### Core preventive services for older women

Monona has a crude rate of 34.6% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 855th out of 958 lowa communities (121st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 36.5%, which ranks 790th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).



Monona has a crude rate of 61.9% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 882nd out of 958 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 61.4%, which ranks 823rd out of 905 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities).



# **Mammography**

Monona has a crude rate of 70.7% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 952nd out of 958 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 67.6%, which ranks 870th out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).

# **Disability**



### **Hearing disability**

Monona has a crude rate of 9.0% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 834th out of 958 lowa communities (113th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Monona is 6.7%, which ranks 838th out of 905 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities).









# **Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data**

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
