

Health in Mount Vernon: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Mount Vernon,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Mount Vernon ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Mount Vernon's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Mount Vernon. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Mount Vernon that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Mount Vernon, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Mount Vernon compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 4,529, Mount Vernon's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In Iowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 8.8% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 9th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 9.9%, which ranks 41st out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Physical Health

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 7.3% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 11th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 8.3%, which ranks 52nd out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Mental Health

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 16.0% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 884th out of 958 lowa communities (90th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 14.3%, which ranks 93rd out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 25.1% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 950th out of 958 lowa communities (100th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 23.6%, which ranks 835th out of 905 lowa communities (95th out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Smoking

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 11.7% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 10th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 13.9%, which ranks 51st out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 102 midsized communities).



Physical Inactivity

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 17.3% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 10th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 18.9%, which ranks 35th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 28.4% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 133rd out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 29.7%, which ranks 162nd out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 16.7% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 5th out of 958 lowa communities (1st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 20.7%, which ranks 38th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities).



High Blood Pressure

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 22.6% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 11th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 27.4%, which ranks 469th out of 905 lowa communities (49th out of 102 midsized communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 5.1% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 11th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Asthma

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 9.5% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 625th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 9.2%, which ranks 185th out of 905 lowa communities (22nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Coronary Heart Disease

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 3.4% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 11th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 4.3%, which ranks 30th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 102 midsized communities).



Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 4.2% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 11th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 5.0%, which ranks 45th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 102 midsized communities).



Depression

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 21.9% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 945th out of 958 lowa communities (101st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 21.0%, which ranks 852nd out of 905 lowa communities (95th out of 102 midsized communities).



Diabetes

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 5.7% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 7th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 7.1%, which ranks 57th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 102 midsized communities).



High Cholesterol

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 27.8% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 8th out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 29.2%, which ranks 242nd out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities).



Chronic Kidney Disease

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 2.0% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 12th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 2.4%, which ranks 36th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities).



Obesity

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 33.2% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 61st out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 36.9%, which ranks 353rd out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 102 midsized communities).



Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 1.8% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 10th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 2.3%, which ranks 49th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 102 midsized communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 8.6%, which ranks 32nd out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 5.5% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 32nd out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 5.6%, which ranks 26th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 102 midsized communities).



Taking BP Medication

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 71.5% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 934th out of 958 lowa communities (97th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 58.5%, which ranks 631st out of 905 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities).



Cervical Cancer Screening

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 83.4% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 447th out of 958 lowa communities (43rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 86.6%, which ranks 13th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 102 midsized communities).



Annual Checkup

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 73.4% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 788th out of 958 lowa communities (82nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 75.0%, which ranks 28th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 102 midsized communities).



Cholesterol Screening

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 76.6% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 947th out of 958 lowa communities (100th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 82.1%, which ranks 22nd out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 102 midsized communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 77.0% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 15th out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 77.0%, which ranks 7th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 43.0% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 541st out of 958 lowa communities (48th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 44.1%, which ranks 380th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 43.3% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 169th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 45.5%, which ranks 84th out of 905 lowa communities (18th out of 102 midsized communities).



Dental Visit

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 74.4% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 33rd out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 73.2%, which ranks 54th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 102 midsized communities).



Mammography

Mount Vernon has a crude rate of 79.4% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 86th out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Mount Vernon is 77.8%, which ranks 58th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 102 midsized communities).





This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
