Health in Northwood: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Northwood,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University’s Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Northwood ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Northwood’s strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all Iowa communities and communities of similar size to Northwood. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community’s strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

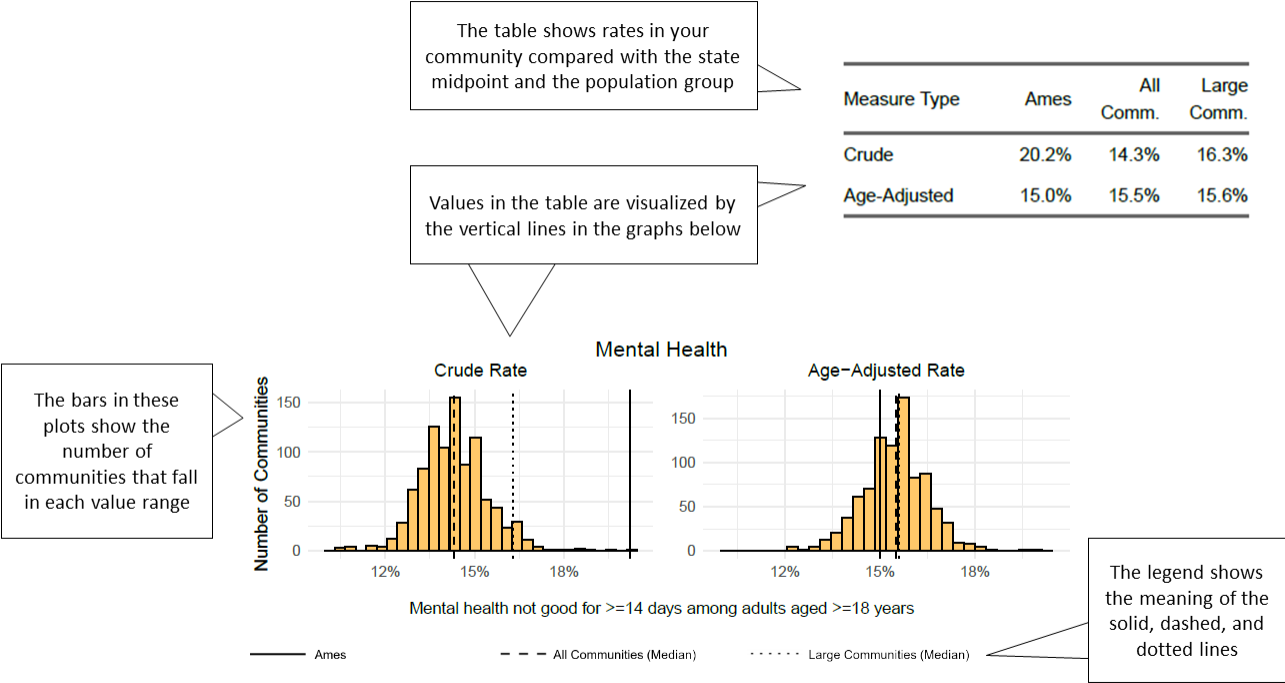
The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Northwood that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Northwood, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Northwood compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,142, Northwood’s similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In Iowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all Iowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all Iowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status

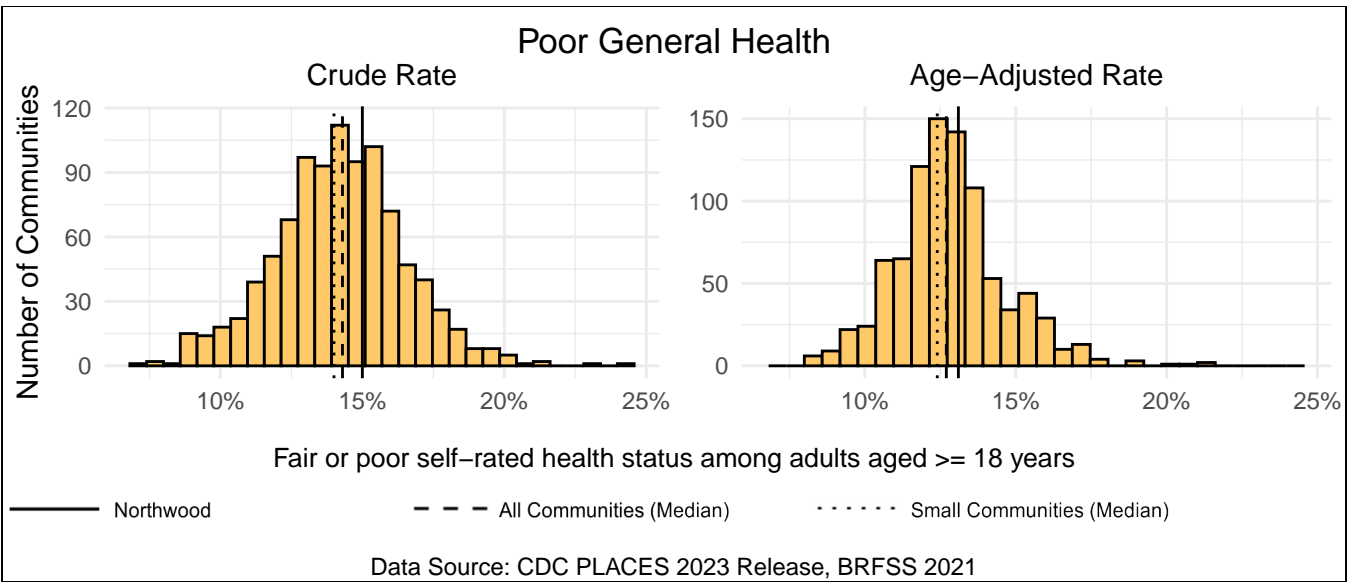
This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country’s population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of “excellent,” “very good,” “good,” “fair,” or “poor,” from which the respondents who answer “fair” or “poor” are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Northwood has a crude rate of 15.0% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 615th out of 958 Iowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 13.1%, which ranks 533rd out of 905 Iowa communities (87th out of 138 small communities).

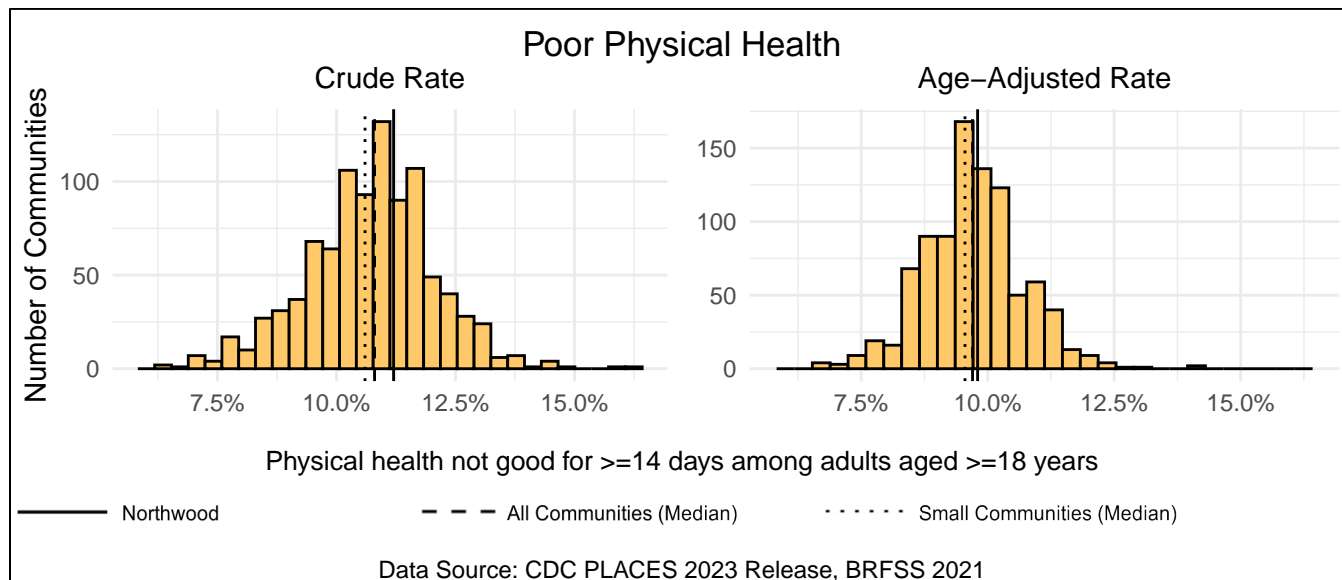

Poor Physical Health

Northwood has a crude rate of 11.2% for physical health not good for ≥ 14 days among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 600th out of 958 Iowa communities (94th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 9.8%, which ranks 468th out of 905 Iowa communities (80th out of 138 small communities).

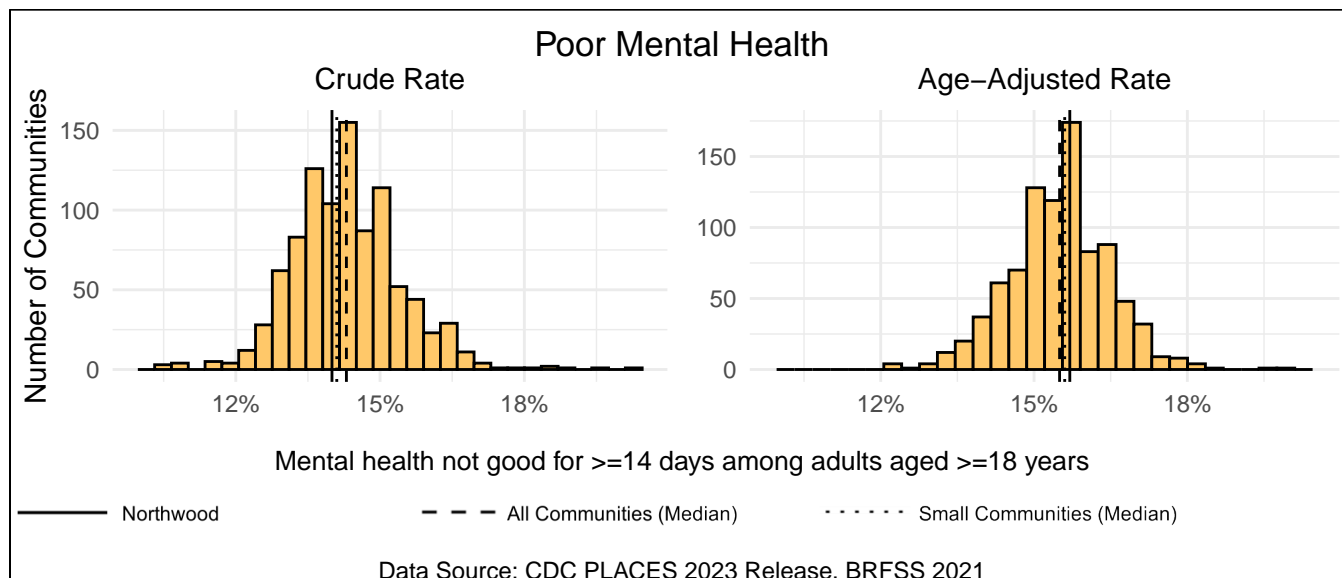

Poor Mental Health

Northwood has a crude rate of 14.0% for mental health not good for ≥ 14 days among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 356th out of 958 Iowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 15.7%, which ranks 516th out of 905 Iowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors

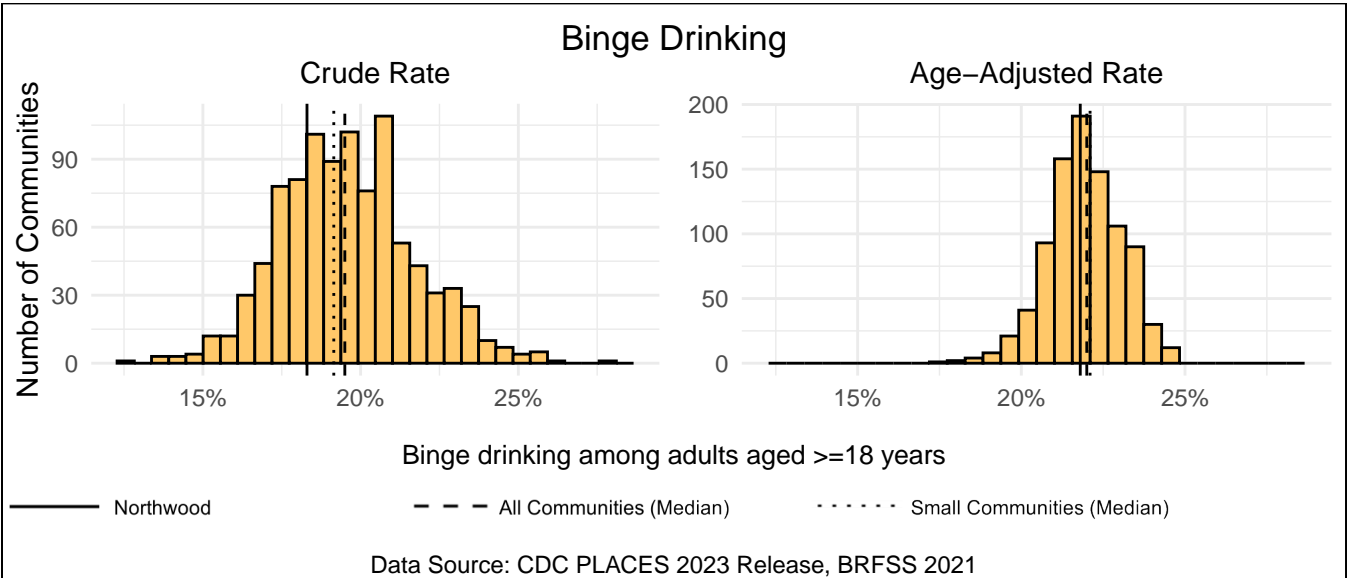
Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Northwood has a crude rate of 18.3% for binge drinking among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 269th out of 958 Iowa communities (44th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 21.8%, which ranks 389th out of 905 Iowa communities (61st out of 138 small communities).

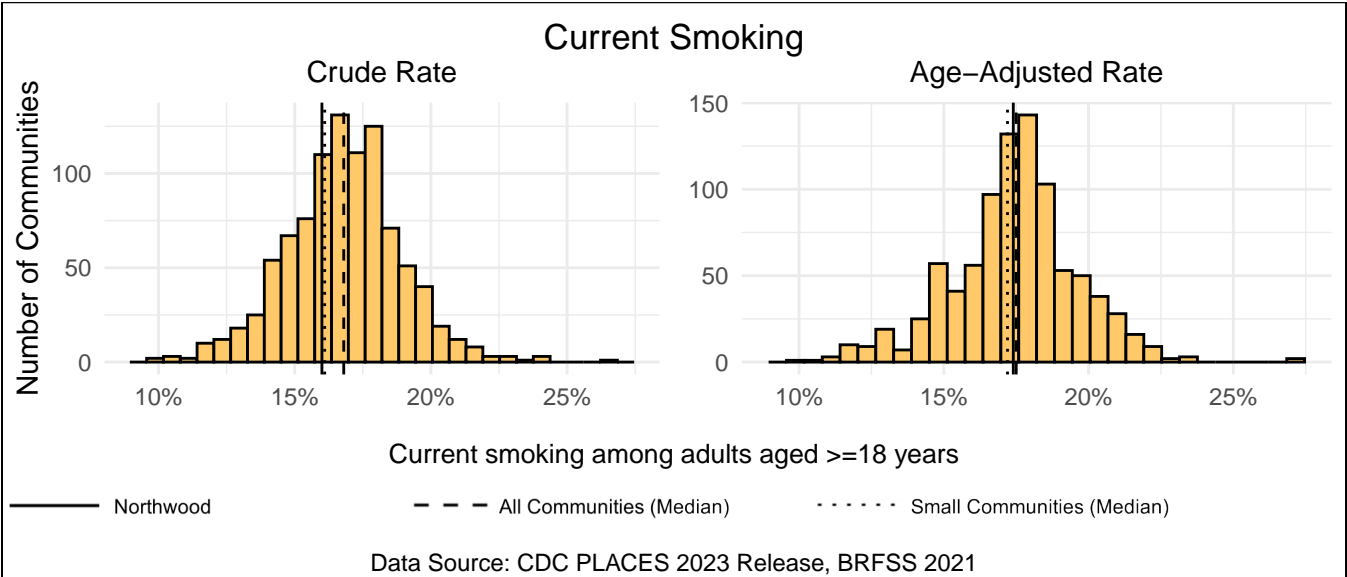

Current Smoking

Northwood has a crude rate of 16.0% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 305th out of 958 Iowa communities (66th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 17.4%, which ranks 398th out of 905 Iowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities).

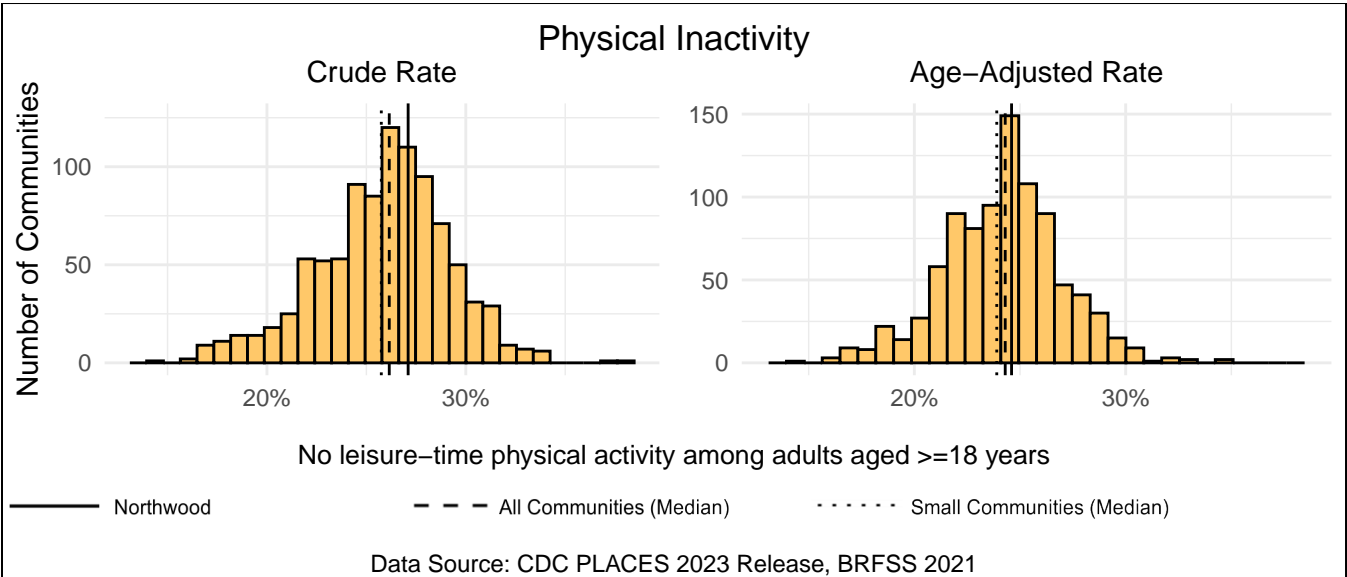

Physical Inactivity

Northwood has a crude rate of 27.1% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 602nd out of 958 Iowa communities (90th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 24.6%, which ranks 487th out of 905 Iowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities).

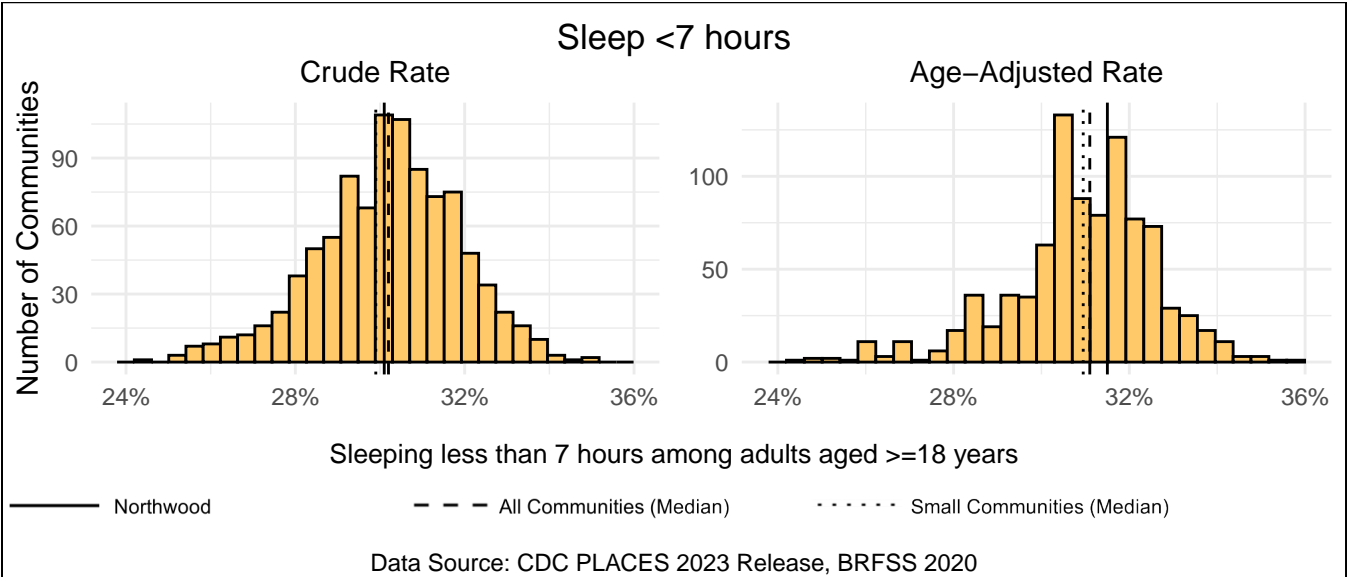

Sleep <7 hours

Northwood has a crude rate of 30.1% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 427th out of 958 Iowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 31.5%, which ranks 522nd out of 905 Iowa communities (88th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes

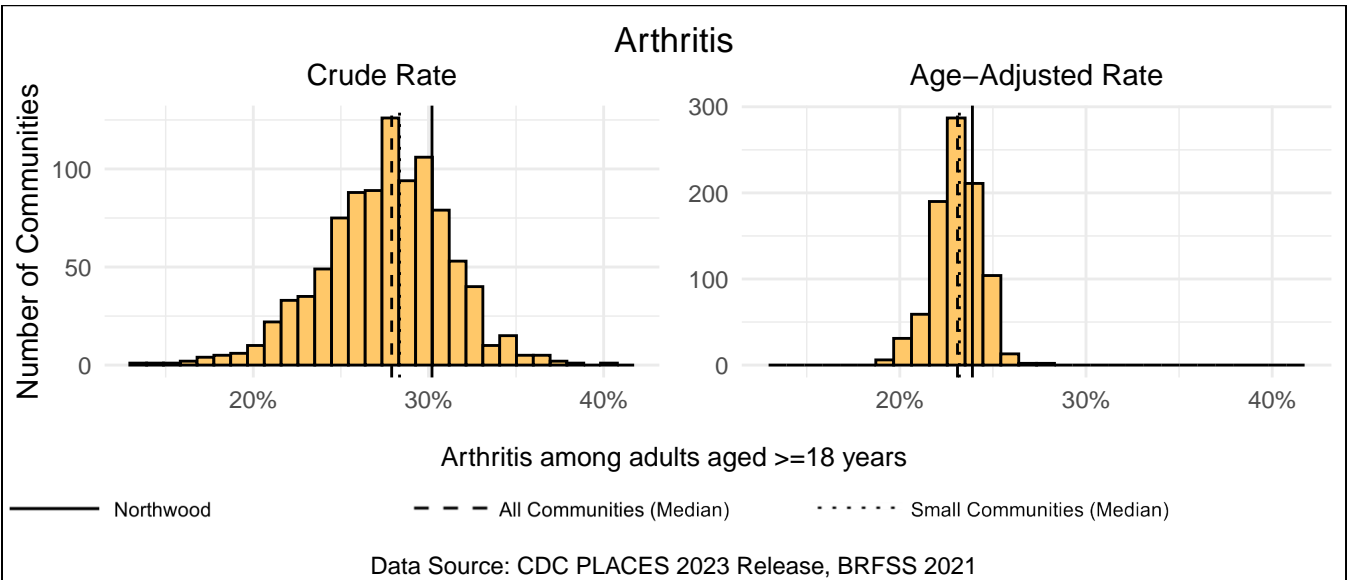

Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Northwood has a crude rate of 30.2% for arthritis among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 732nd out of 958 Iowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 23.9%, which ranks 652nd out of 905 Iowa communities (101st out of 138 small communities).

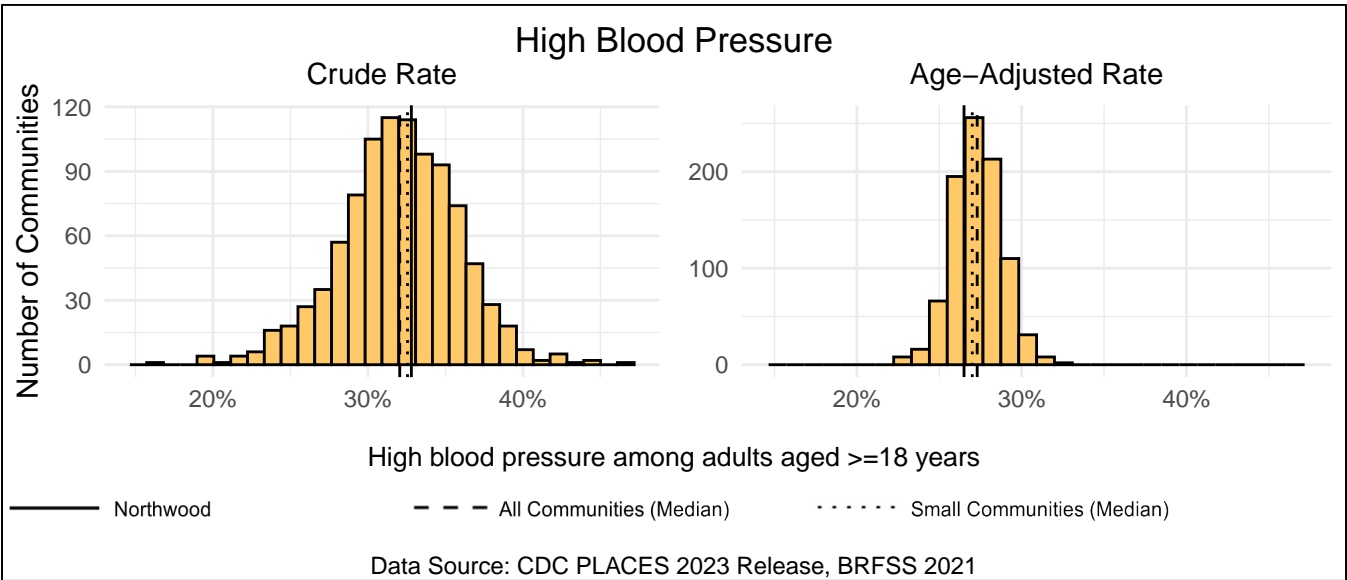

High Blood Pressure

Northwood has a crude rate of 32.8% for high blood pressure among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 552nd out of 958 Iowa communities (72nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 26.5%, which ranks 262nd out of 905 Iowa communities (42nd out of 138 small communities).

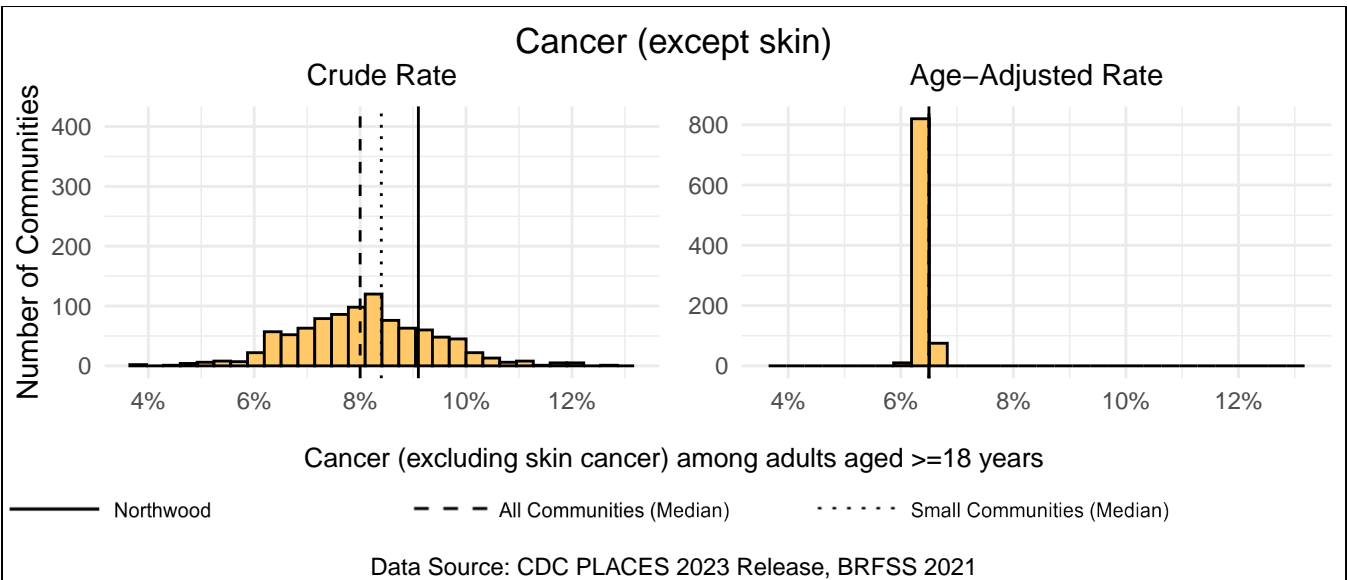

Cancer (except skin)

Northwood has a crude rate of 9.1% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 745th out of 958 Iowa communities (91st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 Iowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).

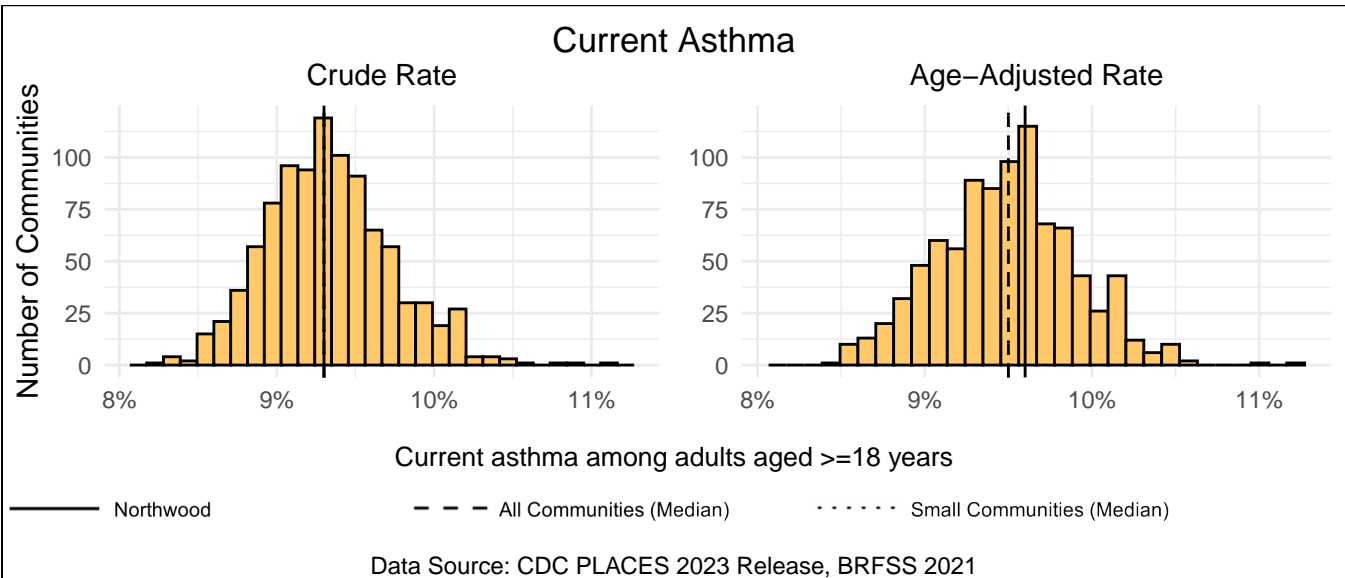

Current Asthma

Northwood has a crude rate of 9.3% for current asthma among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 405th out of 958 Iowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 9.6%, which ranks 513th out of 905 Iowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities).

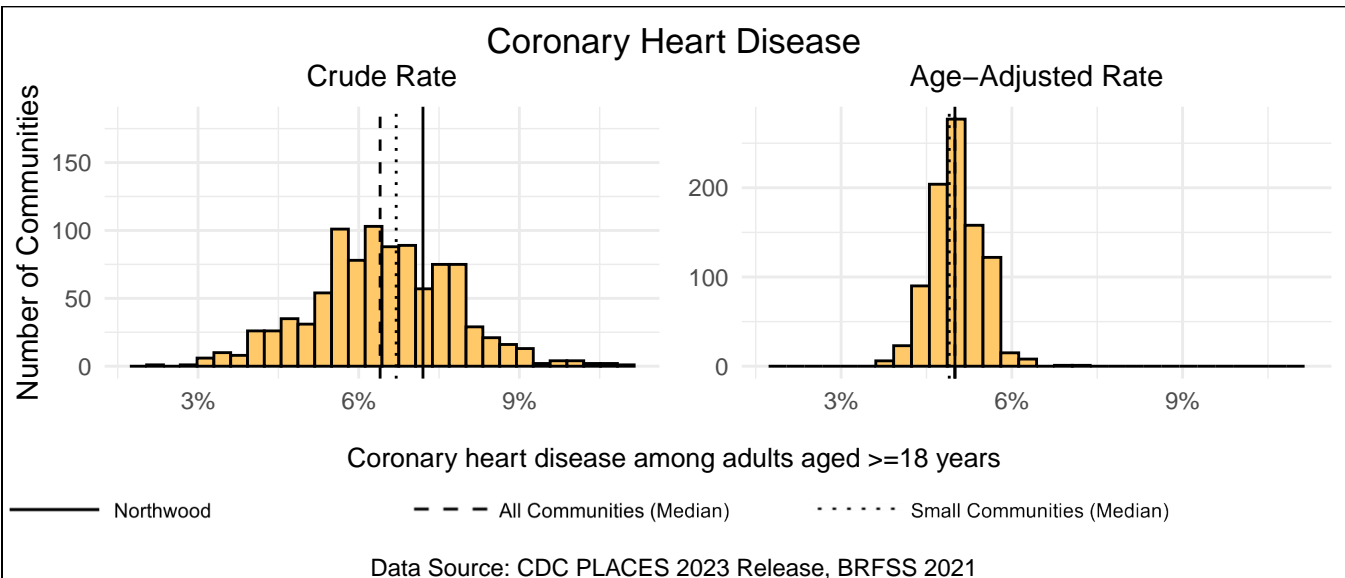

Northwood has a crude rate of 7.2% for coronary heart disease among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 678th out of 958 Iowa communities (88th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 5.0%, which ranks 419th out of 905 Iowa communities (85th out of 138 small communities).

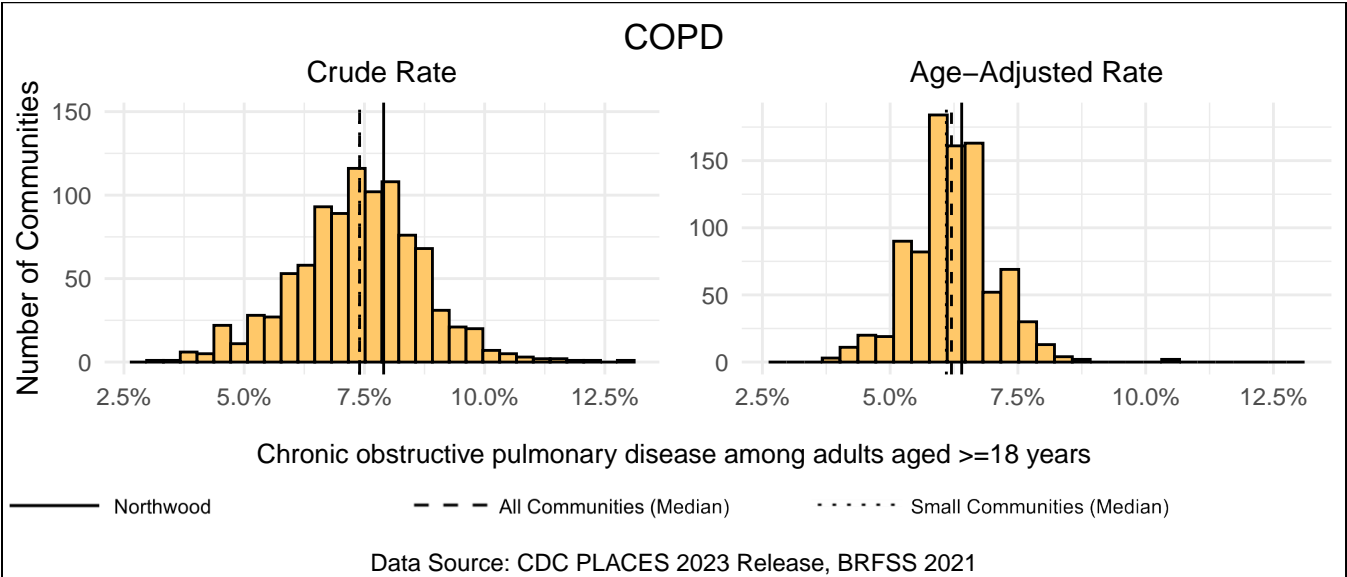

Northwood has a crude rate of 7.9% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 613th out of 958 Iowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 6.4%, which ranks 513th out of 905 Iowa communities (82nd out of 138 small communities).

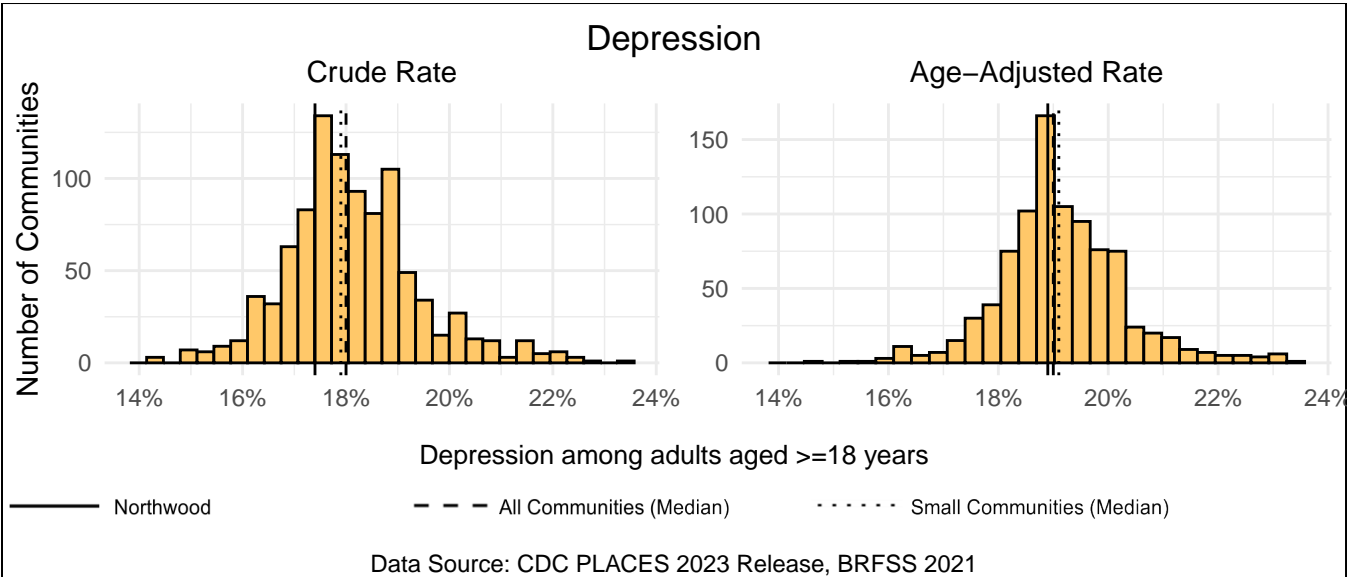

Northwood has a crude rate of 17.4% for depression among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 252nd out of 958 Iowa communities (42nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 18.9%, which ranks 368th out of 905 Iowa communities (56th out of 138 small communities).

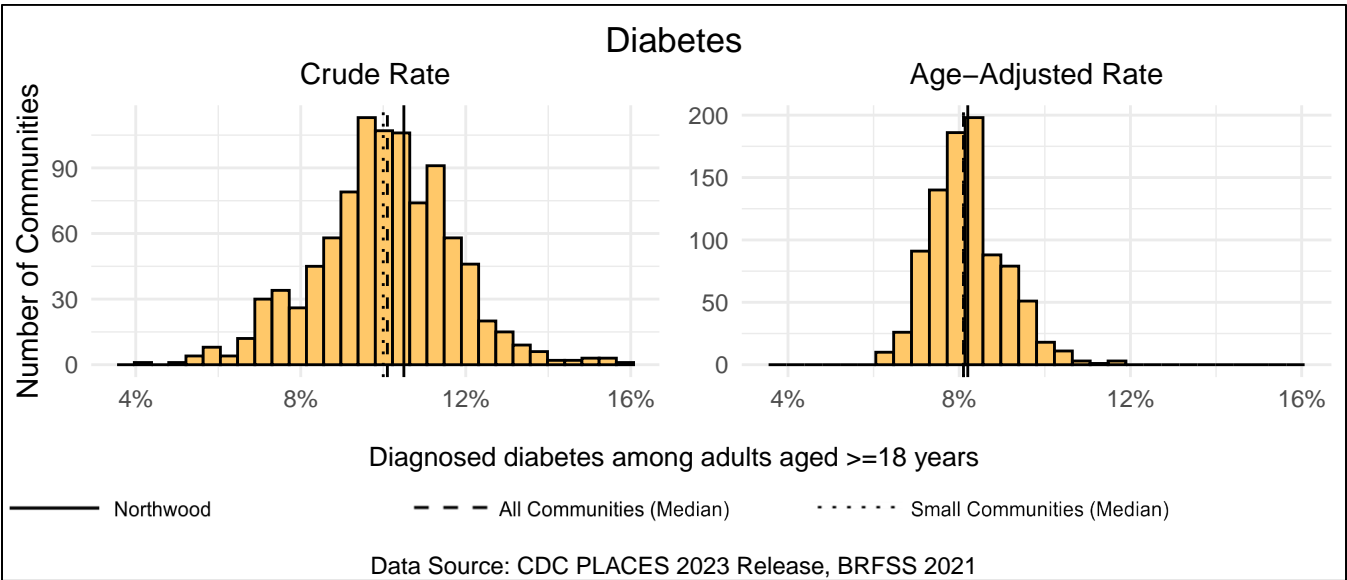

Northwood has a crude rate of 10.5% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 575th out of 958 Iowa communities (88th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 8.2%, which ranks 454th out of 905 Iowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities).

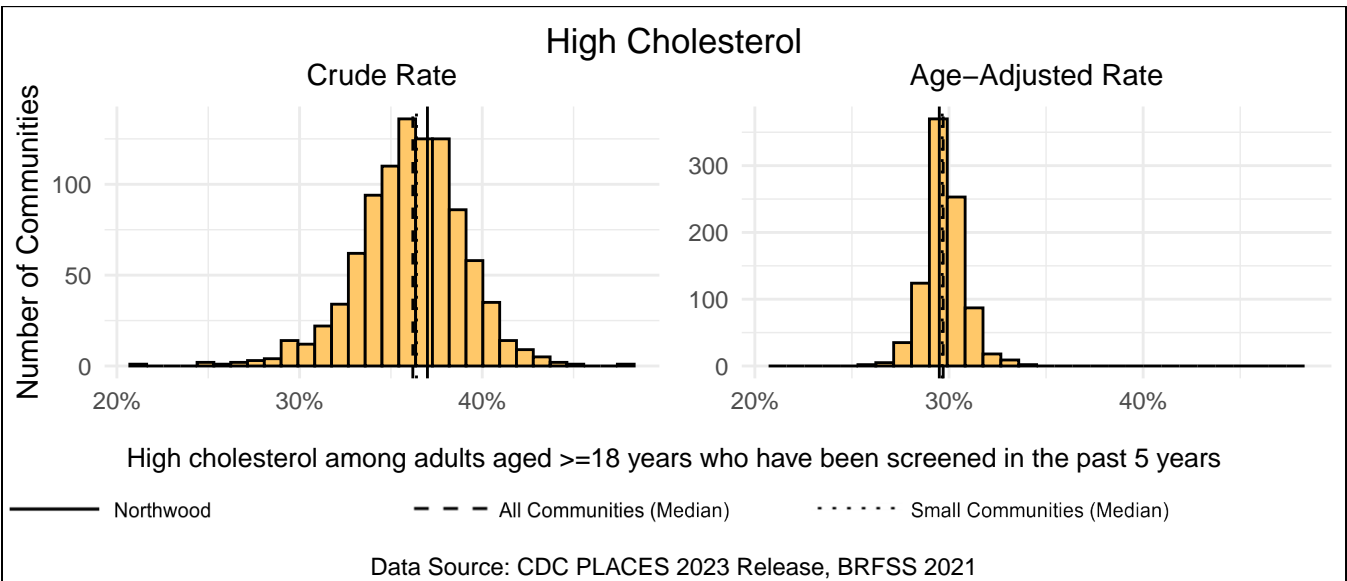

Northwood has a crude rate of 37.0% for high cholesterol among adults aged ≥ 18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 579th out of 958 Iowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 29.5%, which ranks 336th out of 905 Iowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).

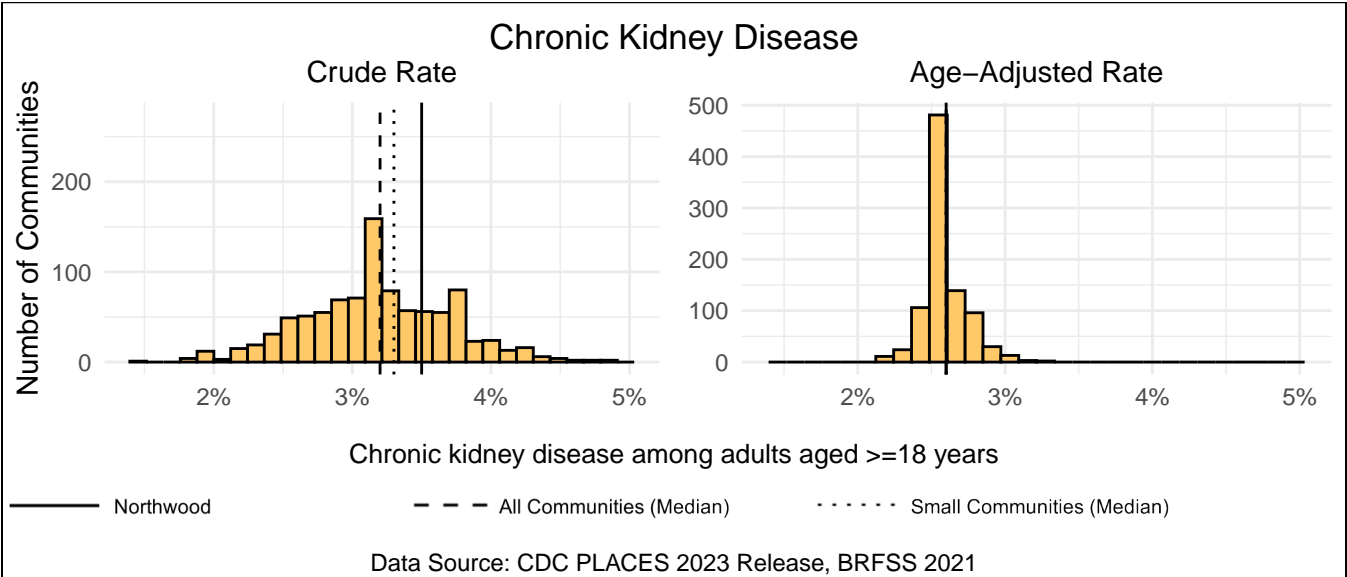

The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 2.6%, which ranks 349th out of 905 Iowa communities (65th out of 138 small communities).

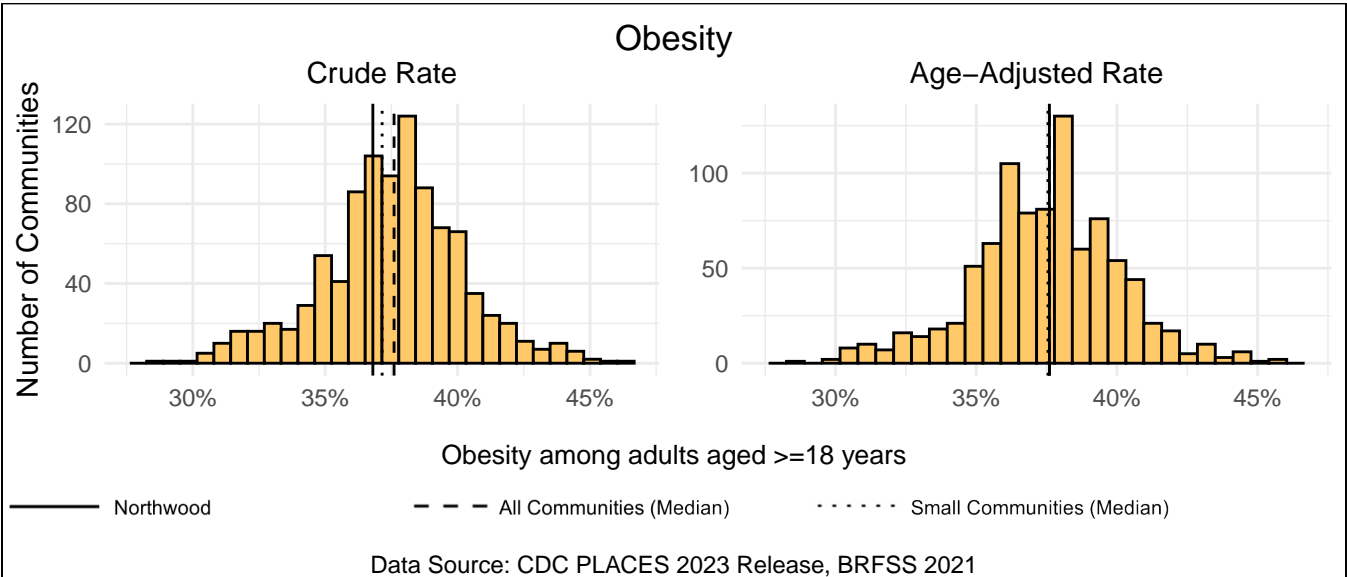

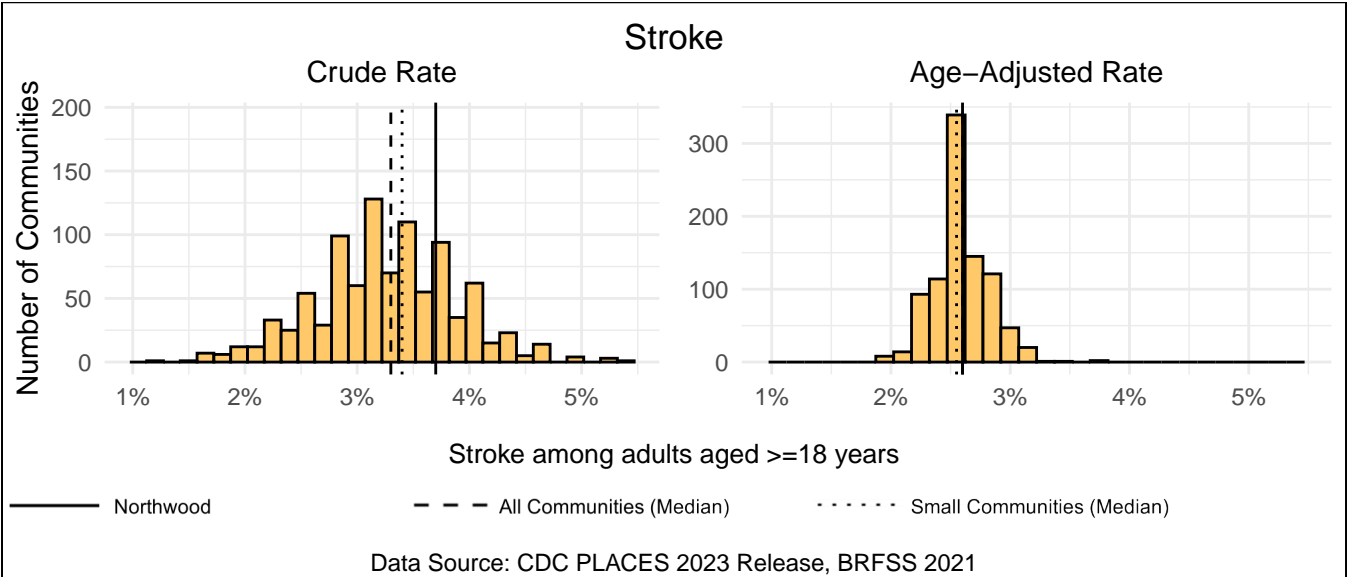

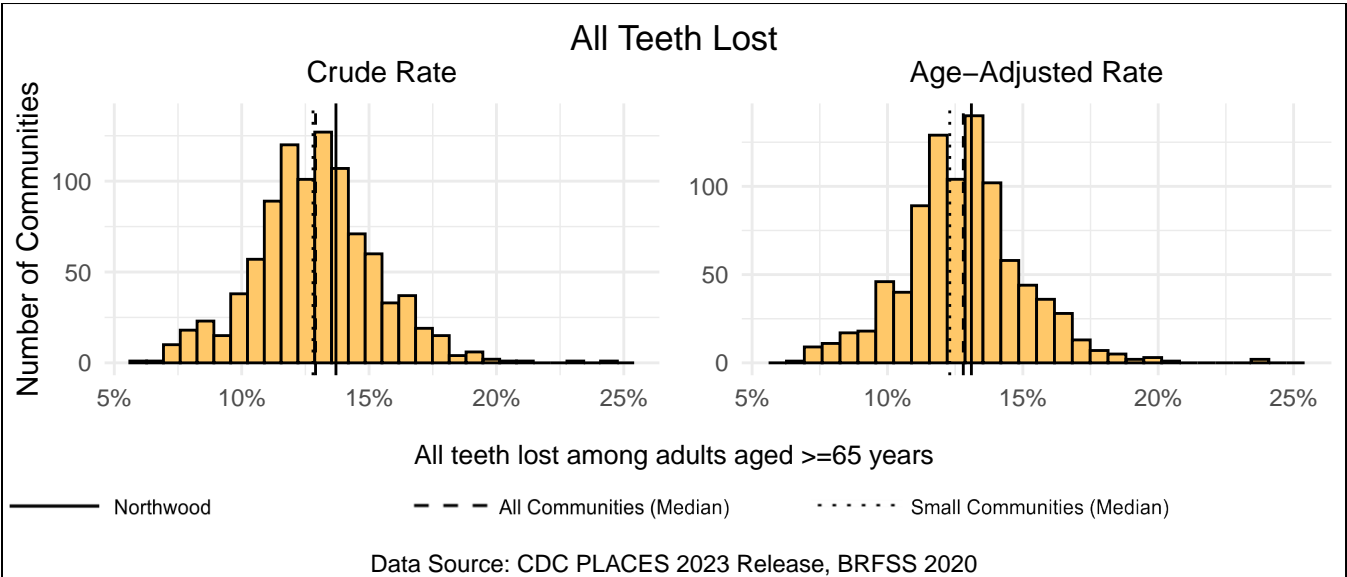

Northwood has a crude rate of 7.6% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 570th out of 958 Iowa communities (92nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 8.1%, which ranks 573rd out of 905 Iowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities).

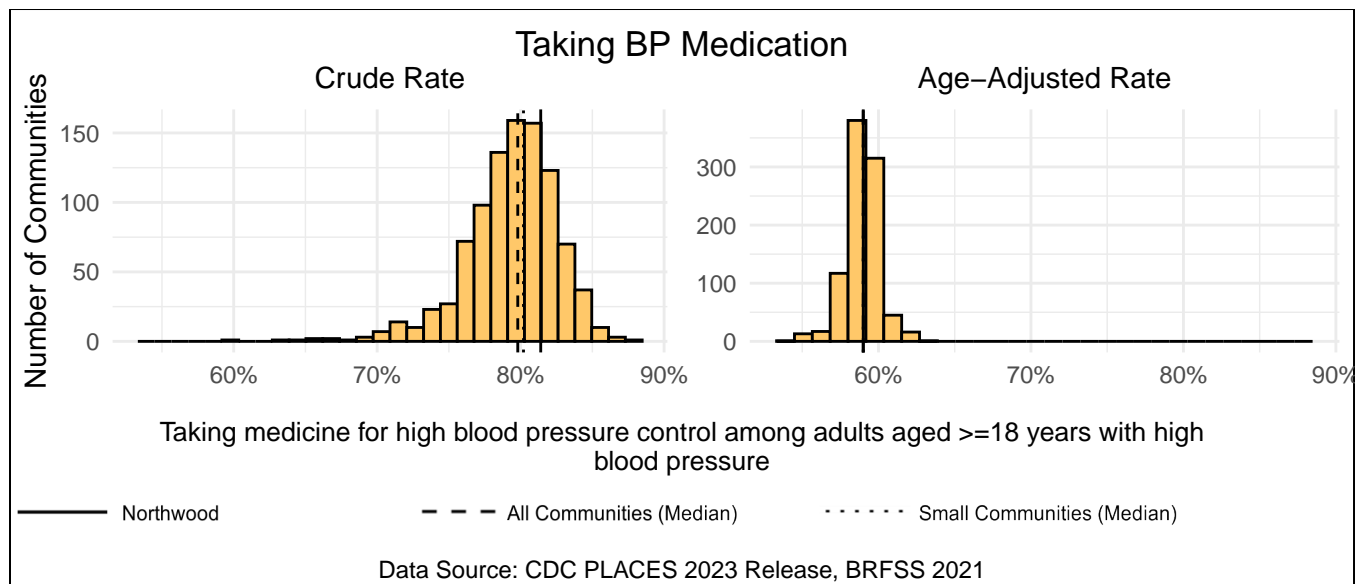

Northwood has a crude rate of 81.4% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged ≥ 18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 245th out of 958 Iowa communities (53rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 59.0%, which ranks 415th out of 905 Iowa communities (67th out of 138 small communities).

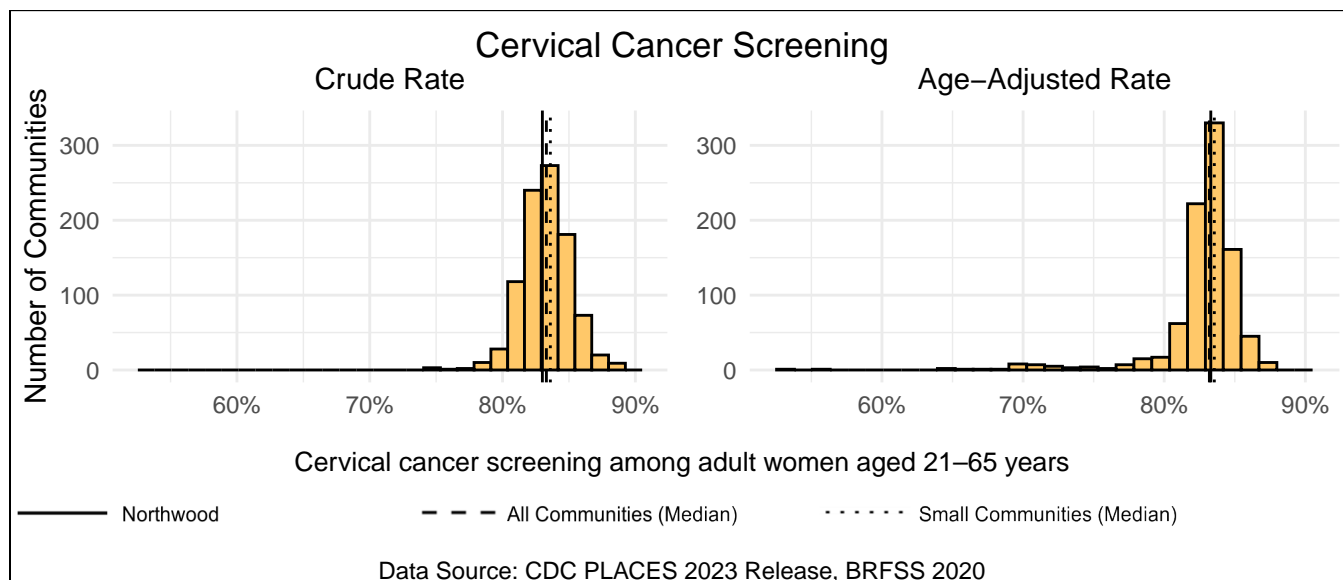

The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 83.3%, which ranks 402nd out of 905 Iowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities).

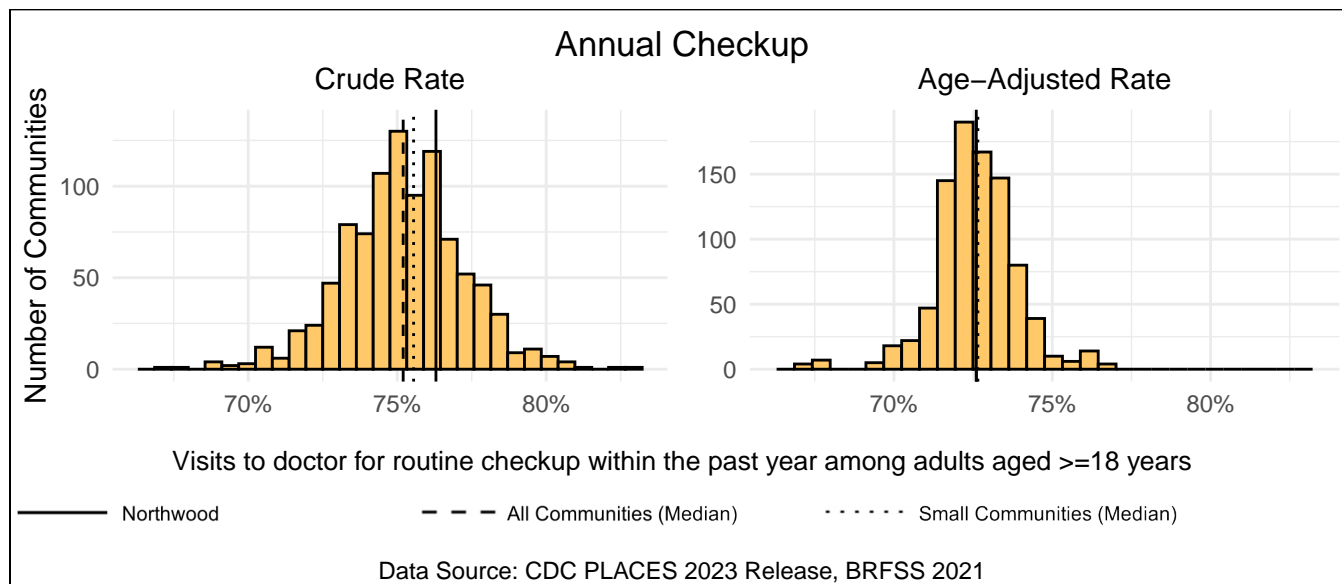

The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 72.6%, which ranks 435th out of 905 Iowa communities (70th out of 138 small communities).

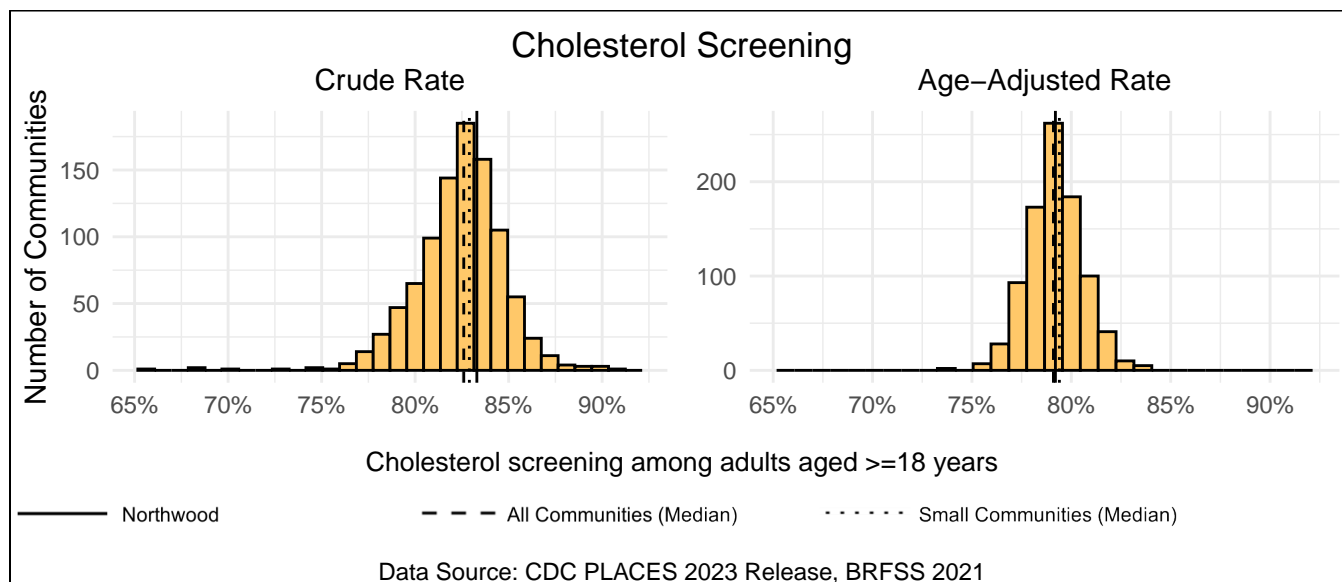

Northwood has a crude rate of 83.3% for cholesterol screening among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 332nd out of 958 Iowa communities (56th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 79.2%, which ranks 408th out of 905 Iowa communities (74th out of 138 small communities).

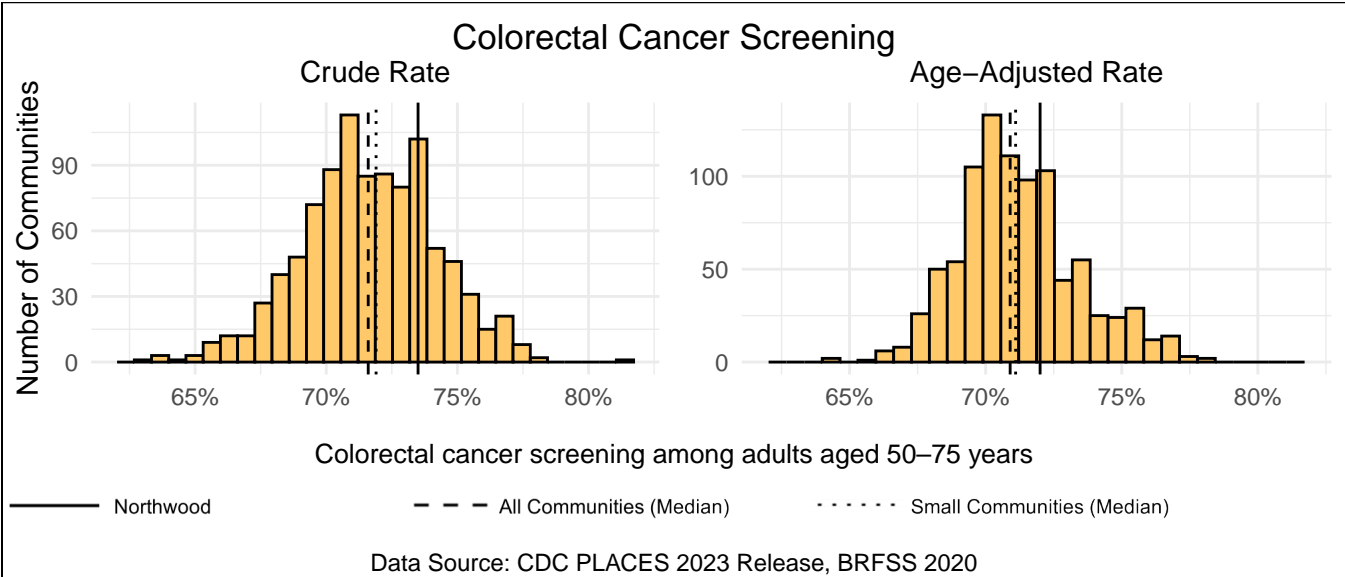

Northwood has a crude rate of 73.5% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 217th out of 958 Iowa communities (37th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 72.0%, which ranks 285th out of 905 Iowa communities (49th out of 138 small communities).

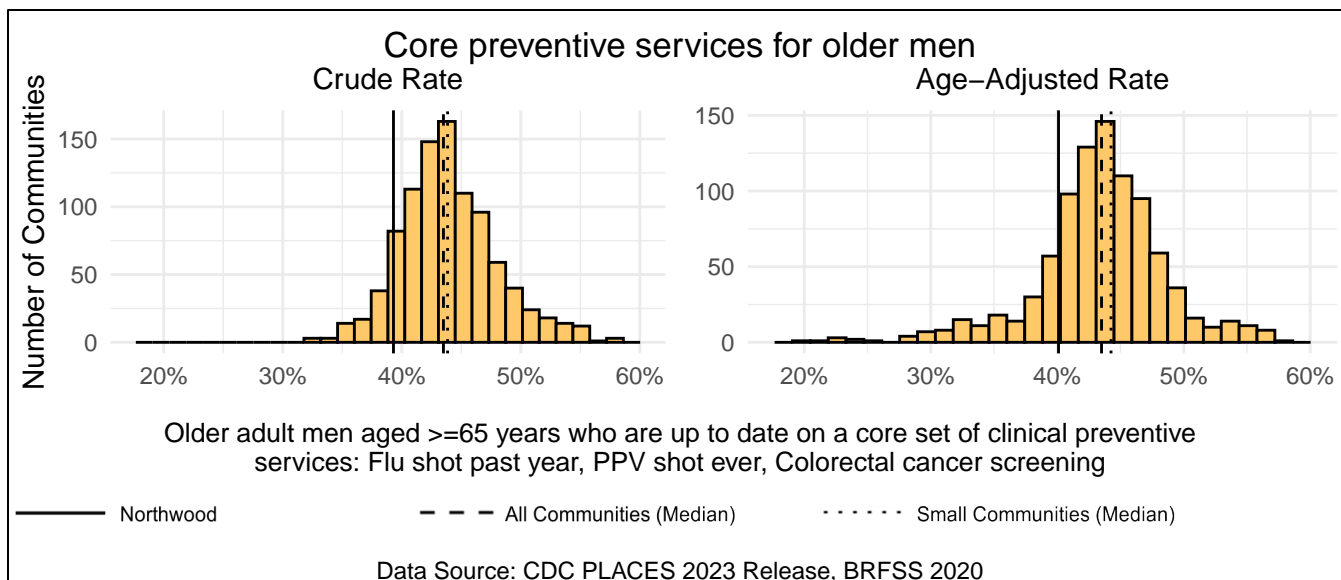

Core preventive services for older men

Northwood has a crude rate of 39.3% for older adult men aged ≥ 65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 866th out of 958 Iowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 40.1%, which ranks 744th out of 905 Iowa communities (125th out of 138 small communities).

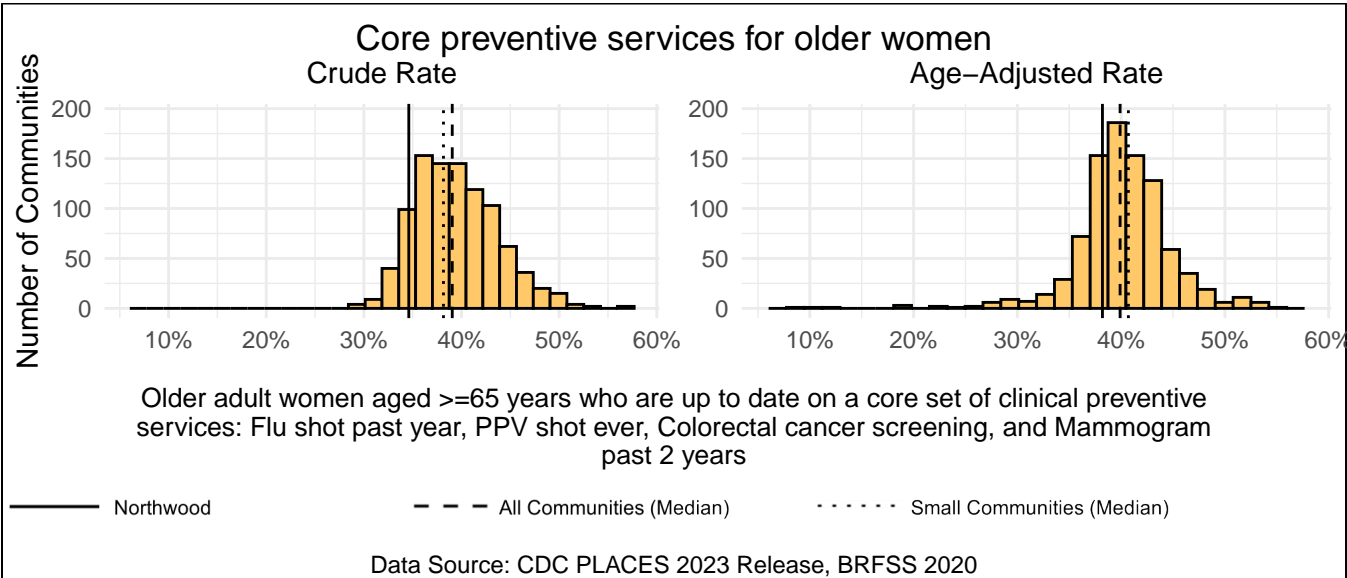

Core preventive services for older women

Northwood has a crude rate of 34.6% for older adult women aged ≥ 65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 855th out of 958 Iowa communities (121st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 38.2%, which ranks 650th out of 905 Iowa communities (113th out of 138 small communities).

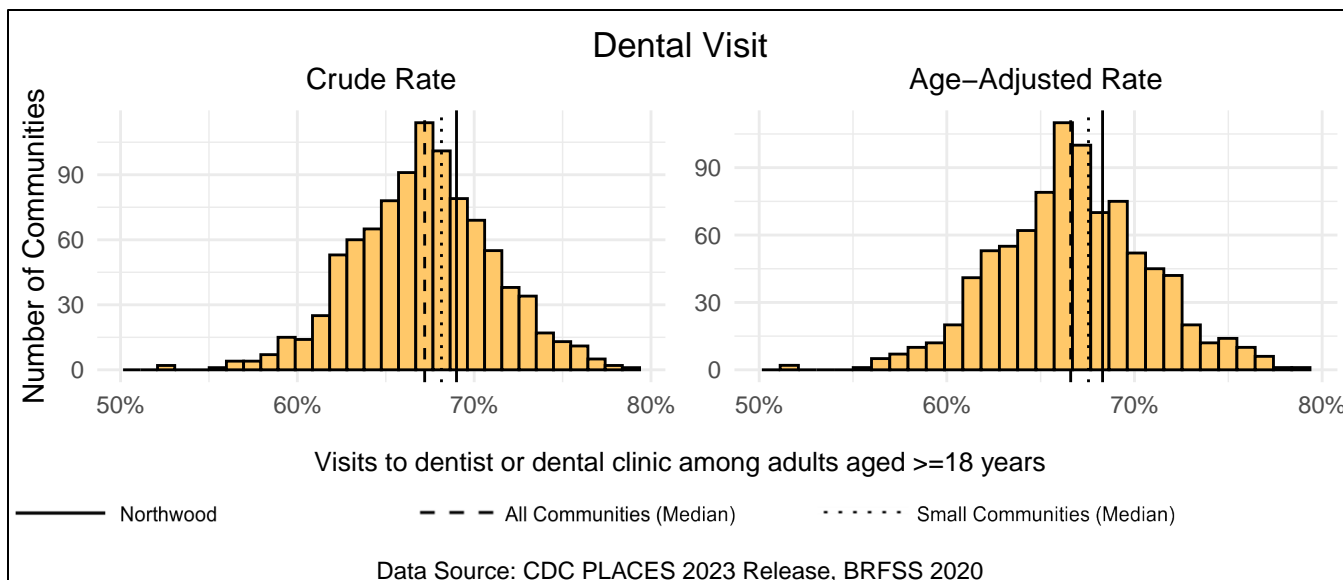

Northwood has a crude rate of 69.0% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 300th out of 958 Iowa communities (54th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 68.3%, which ranks 301st out of 905 Iowa communities (59th out of 138 small communities).

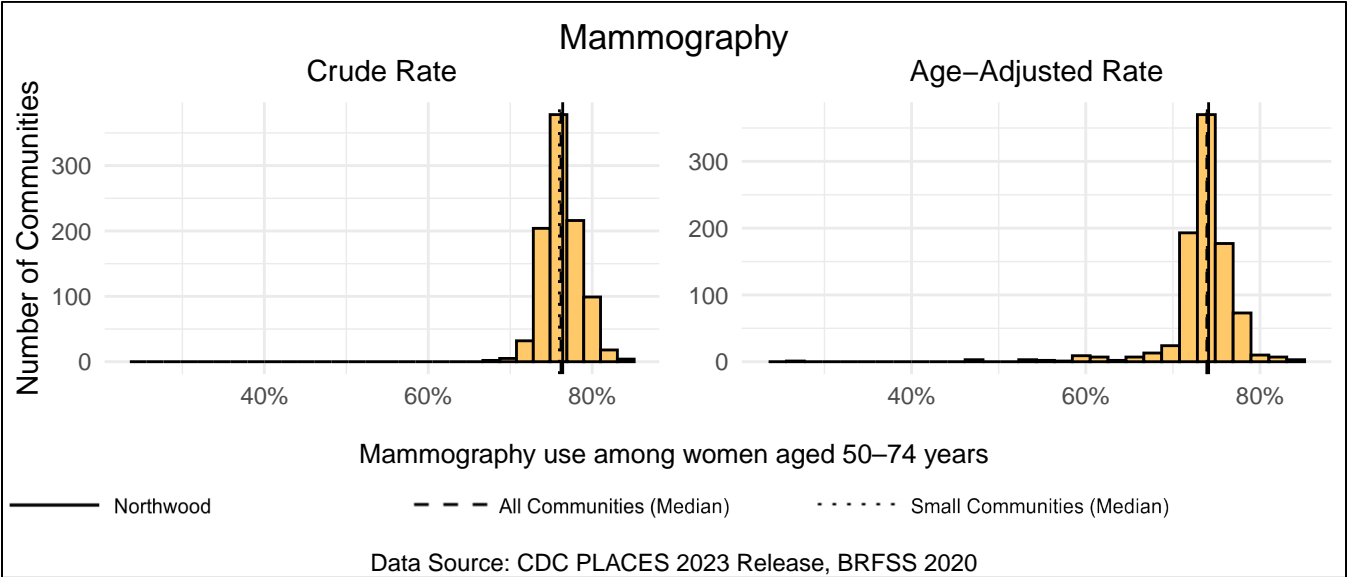

Northwood has a crude rate of 76.4% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 432nd out of 958 Iowa communities (57th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 74.1%, which ranks 400th out of 905 Iowa communities (66th out of 138 small communities).

Disability

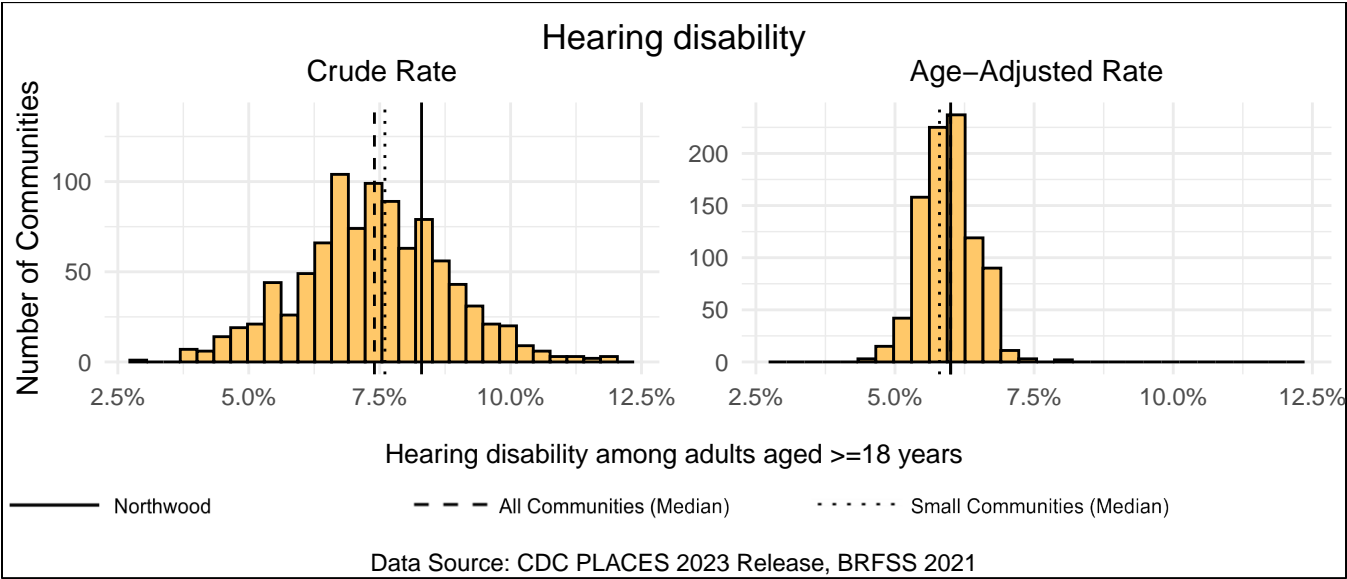

Northwood has a crude rate of 8.3% for hearing disability among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 702nd out of 958 Iowa communities (88th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Northwood is 6.0%, which ranks 444th out of 905 Iowa communities (85th out of 138 small communities).

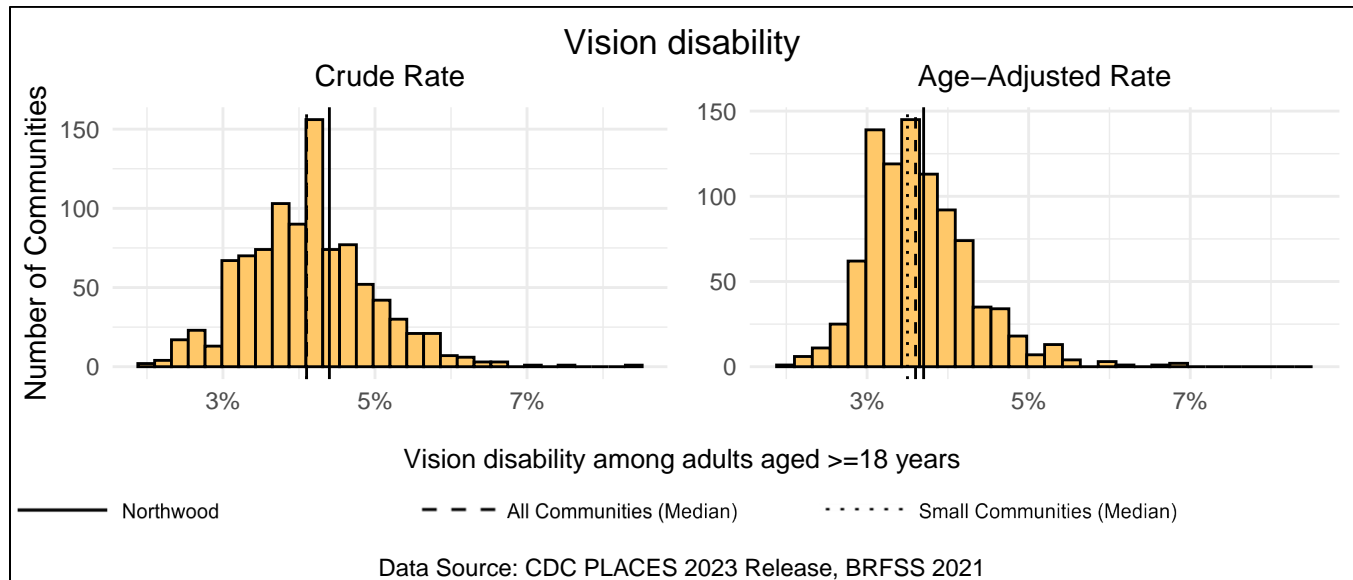

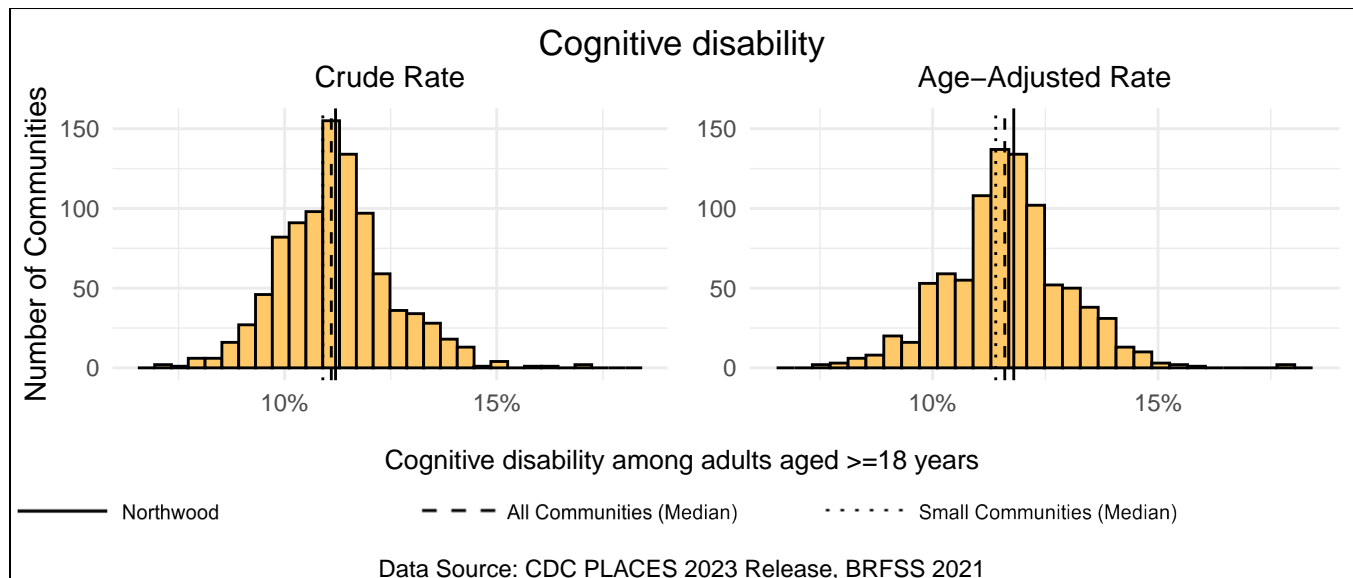

Cognitive disability

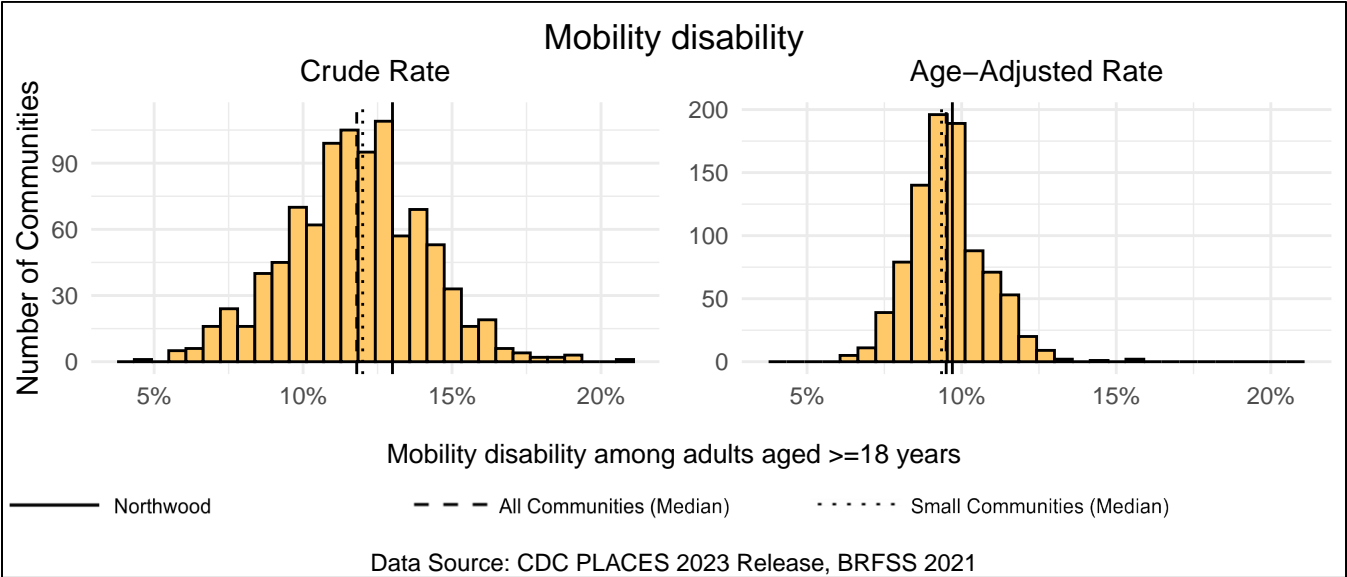

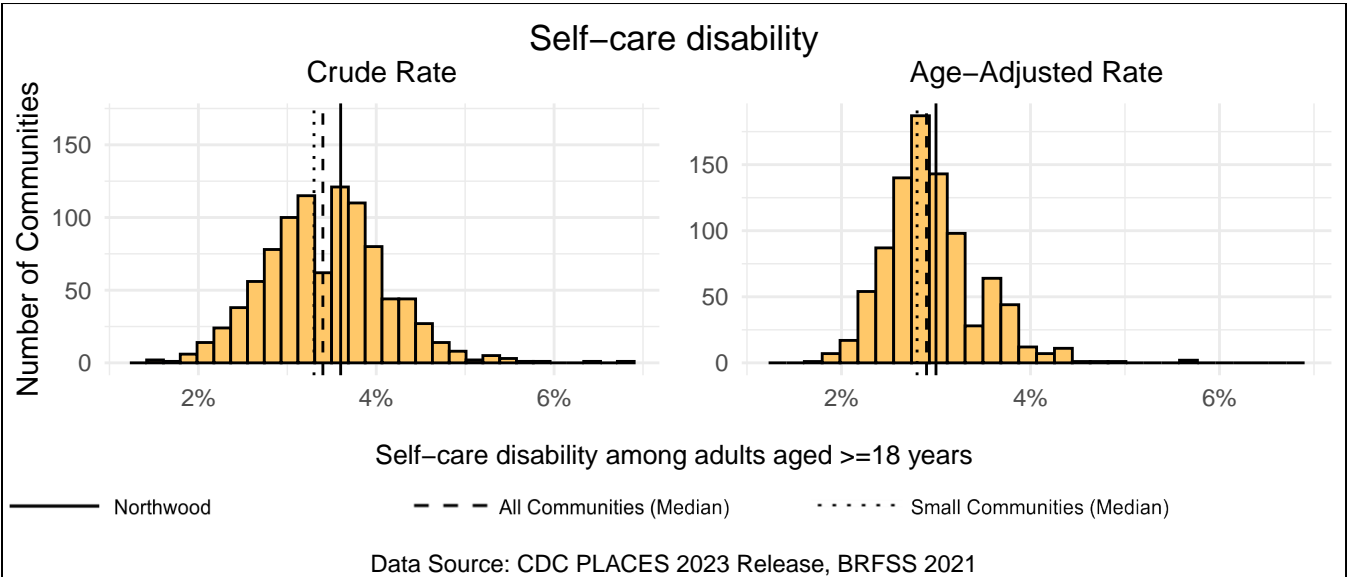

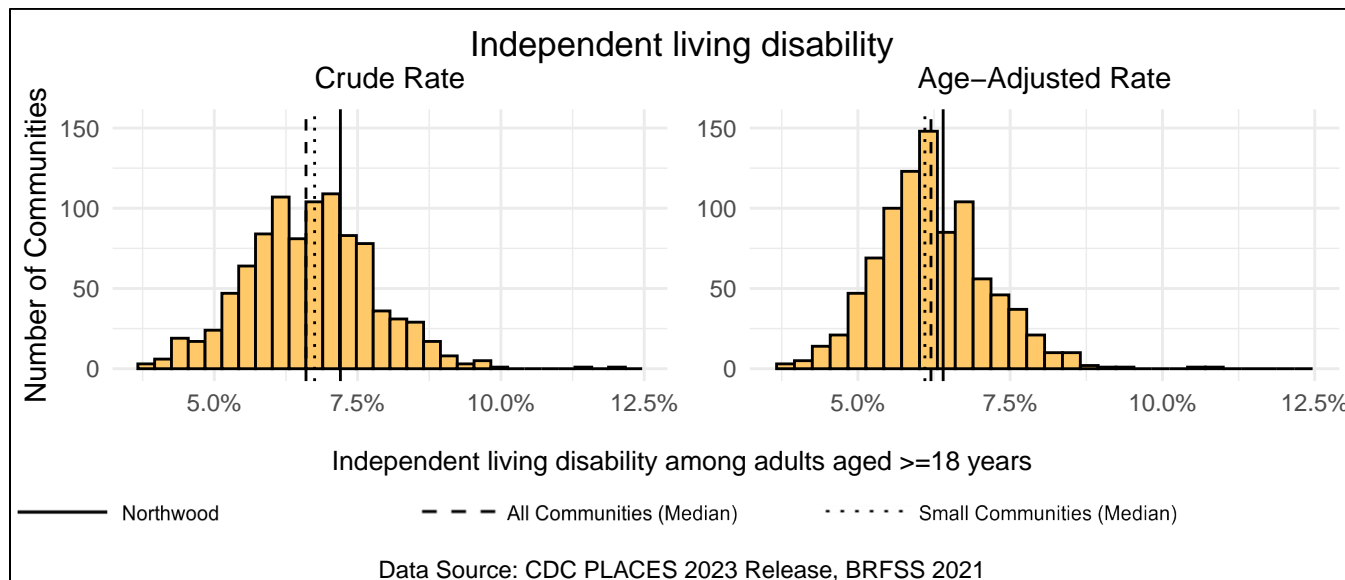

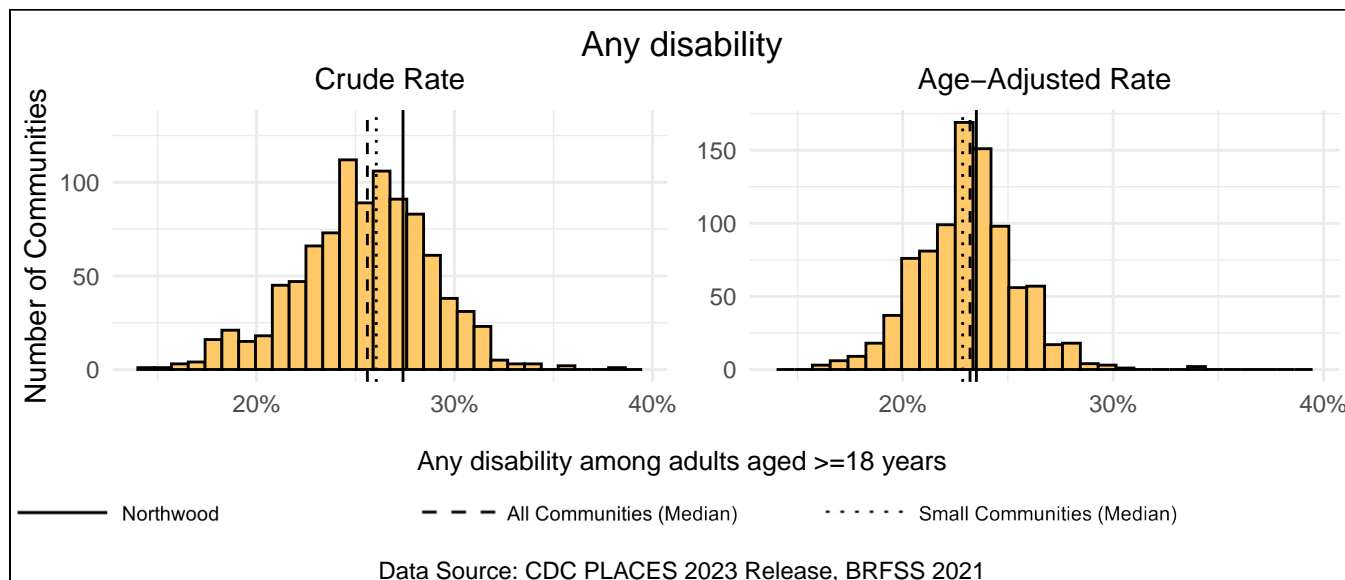

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
