Health in Osage: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Osage,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Osage ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Osage's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Osage. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Osage that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Osage, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Osage compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 3,590, Osage's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In lowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Osage has a crude rate of 14.8% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 576th out of 958 lowa communities (57th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 12.6%, which ranks 410th out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Physical Health

Osage has a crude rate of 11.2% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 600th out of 958 lowa communities (61st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 9.8%, which ranks 468th out of 905 lowa communities (44th out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Mental Health

Osage has a crude rate of 13.5% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 202nd out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 15.7%, which ranks 516th out of 905 lowa communities (59th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Osage has a crude rate of 17.6% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 162nd out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 21.9%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (58th out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Smoking

Osage has a crude rate of 15.0% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 175th out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 17.0%, which ranks 327th out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Physical Inactivity

Osage has a crude rate of 26.3% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 499th out of 958 lowa communities (50th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 23.4%, which ranks 323rd out of 905 lowa communities (38th out of 102 midsized communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Osage has a crude rate of 27.5% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 59th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 29.3%, which ranks 132nd out of 905 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Osage has a crude rate of 32.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 880th out of 958 lowa communities (100th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 24.5%, which ranks 785th out of 905 lowa communities (83rd out of 102 midsized communities).



High Blood Pressure

Osage has a crude rate of 34.5% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 709th out of 958 lowa communities (81st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 26.7%, which ranks 304th out of 905 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Osage has a crude rate of 9.9% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 872nd out of 958 lowa communities (102nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Asthma

Osage has a crude rate of 9.2% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 311th out of 958 lowa communities (27th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 9.6%, which ranks 513th out of 905 lowa communities (48th out of 102 midsized communities).



Coronary Heart Disease

Osage has a crude rate of 7.8% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 811th out of 958 lowa communities (89th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 4.9%, which ranks 324th out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 7.9% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 613th out of 958 lowa communities (64th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 6.2%, which ranks 410th out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 17.3% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 220th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 19.4%, which ranks 562nd out of 905 lowa communities (58th out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 11.1% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 703rd out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 8.3%, which ranks 508th out of 905 lowa communities (47th out of 102 midsized communities).



High Cholesterol

Osage has a crude rate of 38.5% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 782nd out of 958 lowa communities (96th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 30.1%, which ranks 565th out of 905 lowa communities (63rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 3.8% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 832nd out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 2.6%, which ranks 349th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 7.0% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 338th out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 7.5%, which ranks 355th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 82.9% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 101st out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 59.6%, which ranks 179th out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 83.5% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 422nd out of 958 lowa communities (40th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 83.7%, which ranks 294th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 77.6% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 106th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 73.1%, which ranks 259th out of 905 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 84.5% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 151st out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 79.8%, which ranks 271st out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 73.5% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 217th out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 72.3%, which ranks 237th out of 905 lowa communities (38th out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 43.0% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 541st out of 958 lowa communities (48th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 43.3%, which ranks 469th out of 905 lowa communities (50th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Osage has a crude rate of 36.2% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 736th out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 39.3%, which ranks 534th out of 905 lowa communities (61st out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 68.2% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 361st out of 958 lowa communities (42nd out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 67.2%, which ranks 390th out of 905 lowa communities (44th out of 102 midsized communities).



Osage has a crude rate of 75.6% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 585th out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 73.9%, which ranks 434th out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 102 midsized communities).

Disability



Osage has a crude rate of 9.1% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 851st out of 958 lowa communities (95th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Osage is 5.9%, which ranks 360th out of 905 lowa communities (44th out of 102 midsized communities).





Cognitive disability



Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
