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Health in Pella: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Pella,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Pella ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Pella's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Pella. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the lowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Pella that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Pella, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Pella compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 10,556, Pella's similarly sized communities are defined as mid-large communities. In lowa, mid-large communities have an average population of 20,750, and there are 31 communities that are considered mid-large communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Pella has a crude rate of 10.9% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 72nd out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 10.8%, which ranks 103rd out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Poor Physical Health

Pella has a crude rate of 8.5% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 52nd out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 8.5%, which ranks 83rd out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Poor Mental Health

Pella has a crude rate of 14.7% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 625th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 14.4%, which ranks 103rd out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 31 mid-large communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Pella has a crude rate of 21.7% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 808th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 22.4%, which ranks 585th out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Current Smoking

Pella has a crude rate of 12.5% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 23rd out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 14.6%, which ranks 76th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Physical Inactivity

Pella has a crude rate of 21.5% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 92nd out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 21.5%, which ranks 134th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Pella has a crude rate of 29.2% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 240th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 30.7%, which ranks 354th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 31 mid-large communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Pella has a crude rate of 21.4% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 46th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 21.0%, which ranks 48th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 31 mid-large communities).



High Blood Pressure

Pella has a crude rate of 26.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 83rd out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 26.2%, which ranks 209th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Pella has a crude rate of 7.0% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 177th out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 6.4%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (4th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Pella has a crude rate of 9.2% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 311th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 9.1%, which ranks 125th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 31 mid-large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 4.5%, which ranks 78th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 31 mid-large communities).







The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 30.6%, which ranks 731st out of 905 lowa communities (20th out of 31 mid-large communities).









Pella has a crude rate of 6.2% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 120th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 6.4%, which ranks 94th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 31 mid-large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 58.4%, which ranks 660th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 74.3%, which ranks 55th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 31 mid-large communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 73.4%, which ranks 136th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Pella has a crude rate of 46.0% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 256th out of 958 lowa communities (15th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 46.4%, which ranks 217th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Pella has a crude rate of 41.7% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 271st out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 44.2%, which ranks 128th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Pella has a crude rate of 76.0% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 12th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 75.1%, which ranks 23rd out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 31 mid-large communities).





Pella has a crude rate of 6.0% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 139th out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 5.3%, which ranks 61st out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 31 mid-large communities).





Independent living disability

Pella has a crude rate of 5.6% for independent living disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 141st out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Pella is 5.3%, which ranks 111th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 31 mid-large communities).



This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
