

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# Health in Red Oak: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Red Oak,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Red Oak ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Red Oak's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Red Oak. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

# **How to Use this Report**


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Red Oak that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Red Oak, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Red Oak compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 5,563, Red Oak's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In lowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

#### Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

## **Health Status**


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. #### **Poor General Health**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 17.7% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 900th out of 958 lowa communities (89th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 15.7%, which ranks 843rd out of 905 lowa communities (83rd out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Poor Physical Health**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 12.7% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 893rd out of 958 lowa communities (92nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 11.3%, which ranks 848th out of 905 lowa communities (89th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Poor Mental Health**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 15.4% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 809th out of 958 lowa communities (78th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 17.0%, which ranks 850th out of 905 lowa communities (90th out of 102 midsized communities).

# **Health Risk Behaviors**


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. ## **Binge Drinking**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 17.9% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 203rd out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 20.9%, which ranks 136th out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Current Smoking**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 20.2% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 911th out of 958 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 21.3%, which ranks 874th out of 905 lowa communities (95th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Physical Inactivity**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 30.9% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 906th out of 958 lowa communities (92nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 28.6%, which ranks 850th out of 905 lowa communities (86th out of 102 midsized communities).



# Sleep <7 hours

Red Oak has a crude rate of 30.7% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 561st out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 31.8%, which ranks 613th out of 905 lowa communities (68th out of 102 midsized communities).

## **Health Outcomes**


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. #### **Arthritis**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 29.7% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 679th out of 958 lowa communities (79th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 23.9%, which ranks 652nd out of 905 lowa communities (69th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **High Blood Pressure**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 35.4% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 782nd out of 958 lowa communities (92nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 29.3%, which ranks 808th out of 905 lowa communities (83rd out of 102 midsized communities).



#### Cancer (except skin)

Red Oak has a crude rate of 8.8% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 682nd out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Current Asthma**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 9.9% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 868th out of 958 lowa communities (85th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 10.2%, which ranks 856th out of 905 lowa communities (91st out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Coronary Heart Disease**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 7.8% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 811th out of 958 lowa communities (89th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 5.7%, which ranks 836th out of 905 lowa communities (87th out of 102 midsized communities).



Red Oak has a crude rate of 9.3% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 896th out of 958 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 7.7%, which ranks 865th out of 905 lowa communities (90th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Depression**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 19.1% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 778th out of 958 lowa communities (78th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 20.5%, which ranks 815th out of 905 lowa communities (89th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Diabetes**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 12.1% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 878th out of 958 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 9.6%, which ranks 848th out of 905 lowa communities (84th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **High Cholesterol**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 38.0% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 720th out of 958 lowa communities (88th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 30.5%, which ranks 701st out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Chronic Kidney Disease**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 3.7% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 787th out of 958 lowa communities (83rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 2.9%, which ranks 858th out of 905 lowa communities (85th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### Obesity

Red Oak has a crude rate of 37.8% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 496th out of 958 lowa communities (53rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 38.1%, which ranks 530th out of 905 lowa communities (51st out of 102 midsized communities).



Red Oak has a crude rate of 4.0% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 832nd out of 958 lowa communities (88th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 3.0%, which ranks 835th out of 905 lowa communities (85th out of 102 midsized communities).



Red Oak has a crude rate of 17.2% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 920th out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 16.6%, which ranks 863rd out of 905 lowa communities (90th out of 102 midsized communities).

# **Prevention**



#### **Lack of Health Insurance**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 9.4% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 885th out of 958 lowa communities (83rd out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 9.9%, which ranks 837th out of 905 lowa communities (86th out of 102 midsized communities).



# **Taking BP Medication**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 81.3% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 260th out of 958 lowa communities (22nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 60.2%, which ranks 69th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Cervical Cancer Screening**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 81.3% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 832nd out of 958 lowa communities (76th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 81.2%, which ranks 805th out of 905 lowa communities (91st out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Annual Checkup**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 75.6% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 395th out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 72.2%, which ranks 559th out of 905 lowa communities (68th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Cholesterol Screening**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 81.0% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 730th out of 958 lowa communities (64th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 76.7%, which ranks 875th out of 905 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Colorectal Cancer Screening**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 69.2% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 803rd out of 958 lowa communities (86th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 68.2%, which ranks 846th out of 905 lowa communities (88th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### Core preventive services for older men

Red Oak has a crude rate of 40.9% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 738th out of 958 lowa communities (70th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 41.1%, which ranks 682nd out of 905 lowa communities (72nd out of 102 midsized communities).



#### Core preventive services for older women

Red Oak has a crude rate of 34.0% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 886th out of 958 lowa communities (93rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 36.2%, which ranks 804th out of 905 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Dental Visit**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 61.4% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 901st out of 958 lowa communities (84th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 60.6%, which ranks 853rd out of 905 lowa communities (84th out of 102 midsized communities).



# **Mammography**

Red Oak has a crude rate of 77.1% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 311th out of 958 lowa communities (38th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 73.7%, which ranks 481st out of 905 lowa communities (56th out of 102 midsized communities).

# **Disability**



Red Oak has a crude rate of 8.8% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 802nd out of 958 lowa communities (85th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Red Oak is 6.6%, which ranks 800th out of 905 lowa communities (85th out of 102 midsized communities).



This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
