

Health in Saylorville: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Saylorville,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Saylorville ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Saylorville's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Saylorville. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Saylorville that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Saylorville, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Saylorville compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,837, Saylorville's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In lowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Saylorville has a crude rate of 11.8% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 127th out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 10.5%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Physical Health

Saylorville has a crude rate of 9.3% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 126th out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 8.2%, which ranks 44th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 102 midsized communities).



Poor Mental Health

Saylorville has a crude rate of 13.2% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 119th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 14.4%, which ranks 103rd out of 905 lowa communities (20th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Saylorville has a crude rate of 20.0% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 561st out of 958 lowa communities (65th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 22.5%, which ranks 609th out of 905 lowa communities (72nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Smoking

Saylorville has a crude rate of 14.9% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 160th out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 14.6%, which ranks 76th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 102 midsized communities).



Physical Inactivity

Saylorville has a crude rate of 22.4% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 140th out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 21.0%, which ranks 104th out of 905 lowa communities (22nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Saylorville has a crude rate of 27.4% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 56th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 27.5%, which ranks 33rd out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 102 midsized communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Saylorville has a crude rate of 27.5% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 433rd out of 958 lowa communities (48th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 22.5%, which ranks 261st out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 102 midsized communities).



High Blood Pressure

Saylorville has a crude rate of 32.0% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 469th out of 958 lowa communities (52nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 26.8%, which ranks 319th out of 905 lowa communities (37th out of 102 midsized communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Saylorville has a crude rate of 7.9% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 418th out of 958 lowa communities (42nd out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 102 midsized communities).



Current Asthma

Saylorville has a crude rate of 8.8% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 44th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 8.9%, which ranks 45th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 102 midsized communities).



Coronary Heart Disease

Saylorville has a crude rate of 5.7% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 248th out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 4.6%, which ranks 120th out of 905 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 6.2% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 155th out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 5.1%, which ranks 54th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 18.9% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 730th out of 958 lowa communities (69th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 19.9%, which ranks 702nd out of 905 lowa communities (76th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 8.9% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 203rd out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 7.1%, which ranks 57th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 102 midsized communities).



High Cholesterol

Saylorville has a crude rate of 38.4% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 770th out of 958 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 31.3%, which ranks 859th out of 905 lowa communities (98th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 2.8% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 186th out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 2.4%, which ranks 36th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 35.8% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 201st out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 34.2%, which ranks 80th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 102 midsized communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 9.9%, which ranks 72nd out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 102 midsized communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Saylorville has a crude rate of 5.9% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 69th out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 6.5%, which ranks 107th out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 76.6% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 802nd out of 958 lowa communities (80th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 55.3%, which ranks 894th out of 905 lowa communities (98th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 85.4% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 103rd out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 84.7%, which ranks 126th out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 75.8% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 353rd out of 958 lowa communities (35th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 72.9%, which ranks 333rd out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 84.9% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 102nd out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 80.3%, which ranks 179th out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 74.0% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 164th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 74.5%, which ranks 79th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Saylorville has a crude rate of 53.4% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 27th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 53.9%, which ranks 25th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 102 midsized communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Saylorville has a crude rate of 45.8% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 74th out of 958 lowa communities (15th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 45.1%, which ranks 98th out of 905 lowa communities (20th out of 102 midsized communities).



Dental Visit

Saylorville has a crude rate of 73.0% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 68th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 72.3%, which ranks 71st out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 102 midsized communities).



Saylorville has a crude rate of 78.7% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 143rd out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 76.9%, which ranks 94th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 102 midsized communities).

Disability



Saylorville has a crude rate of 6.0% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 139th out of 958 lowa communities (22nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 5.3%, which ranks 61st out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 102 midsized communities).



Vision disability

Saylorville has a crude rate of 3.2% for vision disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 105th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Saylorville is 2.9%, which ranks 70th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 102 midsized communities).



Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
