

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## Health in Sheffield: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Sheffield,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Sheffield ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Sheffield's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Sheffield. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

## **How to Use this Report**


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Sheffield that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Sheffield, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Sheffield compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,209, Sheffield's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

#### Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

#### **Health Status**


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. #### **Poor General Health**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 15.3% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 660th out of 958 lowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 13.2%, which ranks 552nd out of 905 lowa communities (92nd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Poor Physical Health**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 11.5% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 690th out of 958 lowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 10.1%, which ranks 604th out of 905 lowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Poor Mental Health**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 14.1% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 390th out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 16.1%, which ranks 658th out of 905 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities).

## **Health Risk Behaviors**


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. #### **Binge Drinking**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 17.7% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 176th out of 958 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 21.6%, which ranks 329th out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Current Smoking**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 16.5% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 406th out of 958 lowa communities (84th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 18.1%, which ranks 553rd out of 905 lowa communities (92nd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Physical Inactivity**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 28.1% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 726th out of 958 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 25.3%, which ranks 612th out of 905 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).



## Sleep <7 hours

Sheffield has a crude rate of 28.9% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 196th out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 30.4%, which ranks 265th out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 138 small communities).

## **Health Outcomes**


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. #### **Arthritis**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 31.5% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 842nd out of 958 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 24.4%, which ranks 768th out of 905 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **High Blood Pressure**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 34.6% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 721st out of 958 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 27.4%, which ranks 469th out of 905 lowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities).



#### Cancer (except skin)

Sheffield has a crude rate of 9.3% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 790th out of 958 lowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



#### **Current Asthma**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 9.3% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 405th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 9.6%, which ranks 513th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Coronary Heart Disease**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 7.6% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 769th out of 958 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 5.1%, which ranks 511th out of 905 lowa communities (95th out of 138 small communities).



Sheffield has a crude rate of 8.3% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 721st out of 958 lowa communities (107th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 6.6%, which ranks 620th out of 905 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities).



Sheffield has a crude rate of 17.5% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 284th out of 958 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 19.3%, which ranks 527th out of 905 lowa communities (81st out of 138 small communities).



#### **Diabetes**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 11.2% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 736th out of 958 lowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 8.5%, which ranks 617th out of 905 lowa communities (108th out of 138 small communities).



#### **High Cholesterol**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 36.6% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 527th out of 958 lowa communities (72nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 28.6%, which ranks 83rd out of 905 lowa communities (18th out of 138 small communities).



Sheffield has a crude rate of 3.7% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 787th out of 958 lowa communities (103rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 2.7%, which ranks 623rd out of 905 lowa communities (106th out of 138 small communities).



Sheffield has a crude rate of 37.2% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 402nd out of 958 lowa communities (70th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 38.0%, which ranks 509th out of 905 lowa communities (78th out of 138 small communities).





Sheffield has a crude rate of 14.2% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 708th out of 958 lowa communities (105th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 13.5%, which ranks 579th out of 905 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).

## **Prevention**



#### **Lack of Health Insurance**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 7.4% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 489th out of 958 lowa communities (80th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 7.9%, which ranks 498th out of 905 lowa communities (89th out of 138 small communities).



## **Taking BP Medication**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 82.0% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 163rd out of 958 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 59.2%, which ranks 330th out of 905 lowa communities (55th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Cervical Cancer Screening**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 82.9% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 557th out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 83.1%, which ranks 477th out of 905 lowa communities (93rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Annual Checkup**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 75.2% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 473rd out of 958 lowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 70.9%, which ranks 847th out of 905 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities).



## **Cholesterol Screening**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 83.1% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 365th out of 958 lowa communities (61st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 78.3%, which ranks 668th out of 905 lowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Colorectal Cancer Screening**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 71.3% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 520th out of 958 lowa communities (84th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 70.6%, which ranks 510th out of 905 lowa communities (84th out of 138 small communities).



#### Core preventive services for older men

Sheffield has a crude rate of 41.2% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 720th out of 958 lowa communities (109th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 41.8%, which ranks 615th out of 905 lowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities).



#### Core preventive services for older women

Sheffield has a crude rate of 34.5% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 865th out of 958 lowa communities (124th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 37.9%, which ranks 683rd out of 905 lowa communities (117th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Dental Visit**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 66.7% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 529th out of 958 lowa communities (89th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 65.8%, which ranks 547th out of 905 lowa communities (91st out of 138 small communities).



## **Mammography**

Sheffield has a crude rate of 76.5% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 410th out of 958 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 74.9%, which ranks 261st out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).

## **Disability**



Sheffield has a crude rate of 8.8% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 802nd out of 958 lowa communities (106th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 6.1%, which ranks 544th out of 905 lowa communities (97th out of 138 small communities).





Sheffield has a crude rate of 11.5% for cognitive disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 601st out of 958 lowa communities (93rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 12.2%, which ranks 631st out of 905 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).



Sheffield has a crude rate of 13.9% for mobility disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 788th out of 958 lowa communities (106th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sheffield is 10.1%, which ranks 632nd out of 905 lowa communities (104th out of 138 small communities).







## **Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data**

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
