

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# Health in Shenandoah: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Shenandoah,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Shenandoah ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Shenandoah's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Shenandoah. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

## **How to Use this Report**


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Shenan-doah that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Shenandoah, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Shenandoah compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 4,930, Shenandoah's similarly sized communities are defined as midsized communities. In Iowa, midsized communities have an average population of 4,787, and there are 102 communities that are considered midsized communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

#### Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

### **Health Status**


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. #### **Poor General Health**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 17.0% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 858th out of 958 lowa communities (82nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 14.9%, which ranks 791st out of 905 lowa communities (78th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Poor Physical Health**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 12.4% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 867th out of 958 lowa communities (86th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 10.9%, which ranks 795th out of 905 lowa communities (80th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Poor Mental Health**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 14.6% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 587th out of 958 lowa communities (55th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 16.5%, which ranks 765th out of 905 lowa communities (80th out of 102 midsized communities).

# **Health Risk Behaviors**


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. #### **Binge Drinking**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 17.2% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 110th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 20.7%, which ranks 108th out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Current Smoking**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 17.8% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 656th out of 958 lowa communities (78th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 19.4%, which ranks 750th out of 905 lowa communities (79th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Physical Inactivity**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 28.7% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 781st out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 26.1%, which ranks 702nd out of 905 lowa communities (68th out of 102 midsized communities).



## Sleep <7 hours

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 32.3% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 856th out of 958 lowa communities (90th out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 33.9%, which ranks 884th out of 905 lowa communities (96th out of 102 midsized communities).

# **Health Outcomes**


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. #### **Arthritis**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 31.9% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 865th out of 958 lowa communities (99th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 24.9%, which ranks 842nd out of 905 lowa communities (90th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **High Blood Pressure**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 36.9% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 878th out of 958 lowa communities (100th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 29.7%, which ranks 842nd out of 905 lowa communities (85th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### Cancer (except skin)

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 9.2% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 771st out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 6.4%, which ranks 74th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Current Asthma**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 9.7% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 781st out of 958 lowa communities (76th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 10.1%, which ranks 831st out of 905 lowa communities (86th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Coronary Heart Disease**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 7.8% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 811th out of 958 lowa communities (89th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 5.3%, which ranks 674th out of 905 lowa communities (71st out of 102 midsized communities).



#### COPD

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 8.9% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 847th out of 958 lowa communities (86th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 7.1%, which ranks 765th out of 905 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Depression**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 18.3% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 568th out of 958 lowa communities (53rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 20.0%, which ranks 733rd out of 905 lowa communities (79th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Diabetes**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 11.8% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 840th out of 958 lowa communities (87th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 9.1%, which ranks 760th out of 905 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **High Cholesterol**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 39.9% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 877th out of 958 lowa communities (102nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 31.6%, which ranks 872nd out of 905 lowa communities (101st out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Chronic Kidney Disease**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 3.8% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 832nd out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 2.8%, which ranks 762nd out of 905 lowa communities (74th out of 102 midsized communities).



Shenandoah has a crude rate of 41.4% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 894th out of 958 lowa communities (93rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 42.3%, which ranks 879th out of 905 lowa communities (94th out of 102 midsized communities).



Shenandoah has a crude rate of 4.0% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 832nd out of 958 lowa communities (88th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 2.8%, which ranks 714th out of 905 lowa communities (71st out of 102 midsized communities).



Shenandoah has a crude rate of 15.1% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 797th out of 958 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 14.7%, which ranks 748th out of 905 lowa communities (75th out of 102 midsized communities).

## **Prevention**



#### **Lack of Health Insurance**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 8.5% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 795th out of 958 lowa communities (66th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 9.1%, which ranks 772nd out of 905 lowa communities (70th out of 102 midsized communities).



## **Taking BP Medication**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 81.4% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 245th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 59.3%, which ranks 298th out of 905 lowa communities (42nd out of 102 midsized communities).



# **Cervical Cancer Screening**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 82.3% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 691st out of 958 lowa communities (61st out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 82.8%, which ranks 579th out of 905 lowa communities (65th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Annual Checkup**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 77.5% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 111th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 102 midsized communities). The ageadjusted rate for Shenandoah is 73.7%, which ranks 127th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 102 midsized communities).



# **Cholesterol Screening**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 82.7% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 451st out of 958 lowa communities (33rd out of 102 mid-sized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 78.1%, which ranks 709th out of 905 lowa communities (72nd out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Colorectal Cancer Screening**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 69.7% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 746th out of 958 lowa communities (78th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 68.0%, which ranks 859th out of 905 lowa communities (90th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### Core preventive services for older men

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 45.7% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 282nd out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 46.3%, which ranks 228th out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### Core preventive services for older women

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 36.4% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 717th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 39.4%, which ranks 521st out of 905 lowa communities (59th out of 102 midsized communities).



#### **Dental Visit**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 60.6% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 914th out of 958 lowa communities (88th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 59.6%, which ranks 871st out of 905 lowa communities (90th out of 102 midsized communities).



## **Mammography**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 75.6% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 585th out of 958 lowa communities (67th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 72.6%, which ranks 669th out of 905 lowa communities (80th out of 102 midsized communities).

# **Disability**


This section includes measures of physical and cognitive disabilities. Respondents were asked to report on six disabilities: hearing, vision, cognition, mobility, self-care, and independent living. ### **Hearing disability**

Shenandoah has a crude rate of 8.9% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 818th out of 958 lowa communities (92nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 6.3%, which ranks 681st out of 905 lowa communities (72nd out of 102 midsized communities).



Shenandoah has a crude rate of 5.2% for vision disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 865th out of 958 lowa communities (79th out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 4.4%, which ranks 788th out of 905 lowa communities (77th out of 102 midsized communities).



Shenandoah has a crude rate of 12.4% for cognitive disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 804th out of 958 lowa communities (72nd out of 102 midsized communities). The age-adjusted rate for Shenandoah is 13.1%, which ranks 788th out of 905 lowa communities (77th out of 102 midsized communities).



# **Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data**

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
