

Health in Sioux City: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Sioux City,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Sioux City ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Sioux City's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Sioux City. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Sioux City that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Sioux City, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Sioux City compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 85,469, Sioux City's similarly sized communities are defined as large communities. In lowa, large communities have an average population of 91,321, and there are 11 communities that are considered large communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Sioux City has a crude rate of 17.0% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 858th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 16.9%, which ranks 882nd out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).



Poor Physical Health

Sioux City has a crude rate of 11.4% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 656th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 11.3%, which ranks 848th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).



Poor Mental Health

Sioux City has a crude rate of 16.1% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 886th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 16.0%, which ranks 631st out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Sioux City has a crude rate of 20.7% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 687th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 20.9%, which ranks 136th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).



Current Smoking

Sioux City has a crude rate of 19.4% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 860th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 20.1%, which ranks 808th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).



Physical Inactivity

Sioux City has a crude rate of 29.6% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 847th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 29.6%, which ranks 884th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Sioux City has a crude rate of 33.0% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 920th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 33.5%, which ranks 864th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Sioux City has a crude rate of 23.4% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 113th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 23.0%, which ranks 401st out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).



High Blood Pressure

Sioux City has a crude rate of 29.4% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 211th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 29.2%, which ranks 798th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Sioux City has a crude rate of 6.3% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 66th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 6.2%, which ranks 11th out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 11 large communities).



Current Asthma

Sioux City has a crude rate of 10.6% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 955th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 10.5%, which ranks 892nd out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).



Sioux City has a crude rate of 5.5% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 199th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 5.3%, which ranks 674th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 7.2%, which ranks 786th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).





Sioux City has a crude rate of 10.3% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 523rd out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 10.1%, which ranks 879th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 32.9%, which ranks 897th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).









Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Sioux City has a crude rate of 11.8% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 939th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 12.1%, which ranks 885th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).



Taking BP Medication

Sioux City has a crude rate of 78.9% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 570th out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 63.6%, which ranks 1st out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 11 large communities).



Sioux City has a crude rate of 80.7% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 889th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 81.8%, which ranks 744th out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).



Sioux City has a crude rate of 76.7% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 202nd out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 76.4%, which ranks 5th out of 905 lowa communities (2nd out of 11 large communities).



Sioux City has a crude rate of 79.0% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 896th out of 958 lowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 79.4%, which ranks 364th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).



Sioux City has a crude rate of 69.0% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 821st out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 69.3%, which ranks 742nd out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Sioux City has a crude rate of 44.7% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 352nd out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 45.3%, which ranks 287th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Sioux City has a crude rate of 40.7% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 343rd out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 42.4%, which ranks 249th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).



Sioux City has a crude rate of 65.0% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 692nd out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 64.7%, which ranks 638th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities).



Sioux City has a crude rate of 76.2% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 467th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 72.8%, which ranks 641st out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).

Disability



Sioux City has a crude rate of 6.4% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 207th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sioux City is 6.2%, which ranks 621st out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).



Vision disability

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
