

Health in Spencer: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Spencer,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Spencer ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Spencer's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Spencer. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Spencer that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Spencer, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Spencer compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 11,351, Spencer's similarly sized communities are defined as mid-large communities. In Iowa, mid-large communities have an average population of 20,750, and there are 31 communities that are considered mid-large communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Spencer has a crude rate of 14.7% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 552nd out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 13.2%, which ranks 552nd out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Poor Physical Health

Spencer has a crude rate of 11.2% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 600th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 10.1%, which ranks 604th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Poor Mental Health

Spencer has a crude rate of 14.3% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 464th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 15.5%, which ranks 405th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Spencer has a crude rate of 18.4% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 283rd out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 20.9%, which ranks 136th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Current Smoking

Spencer has a crude rate of 16.7% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 447th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 17.9%, which ranks 513th out of 905 lowa communities (20th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Physical Inactivity

Spencer has a crude rate of 28.1% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 726th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 26.1%, which ranks 702nd out of 905 lowa communities (22nd out of 31 mid-large communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Spencer has a crude rate of 31.0% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 630th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 32.1%, which ranks 679th out of 905 lowa communities (22nd out of 31 mid-large communities).

Health Outcomes



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Spencer has a crude rate of 27.7% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 454th out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 23.0%, which ranks 401st out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities).



High Blood Pressure

Spencer has a crude rate of 32.8% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 552nd out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 27.7%, which ranks 542nd out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Spencer has a crude rate of 8.4% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 578th out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Current Asthma

Spencer has a crude rate of 9.3% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 405th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 9.5%, which ranks 415th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Coronary Heart Disease

Spencer has a crude rate of 6.8% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 569th out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 5.1%, which ranks 511th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 6.4%, which ranks 513th out of 905 lowa communities (18th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Spencer has a crude rate of 17.8% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 386th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 19.0%, which ranks 420th out of 905 lowa communities (12th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Diabetes

Spencer has a crude rate of 10.2% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 495th out of 958 lowa communities (22nd out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 8.3%, which ranks 508th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Spencer has a crude rate of 36.7% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 539th out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 31 mid-large communities). The ageadjusted rate for Spencer is 30.2%, which ranks 599th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Spencer has a crude rate of 3.4% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 619th out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 2.6%, which ranks 349th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Spencer has a crude rate of 36.8% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 337th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 37.5%, which ranks 438th out of 905 lowa communities (22nd out of 31 mid-large communities).







Lack of Health Insurance

Spencer has a crude rate of 7.7% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 598th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 7.9%, which ranks 498th out of 905 lowa communities (18th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Taking BP Medication

Spencer has a crude rate of 80.6% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 344th out of 958 lowa communities (1st out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 59.8%, which ranks 126th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 31 midlarge communities).



Spencer has a crude rate of 83.1% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 511th out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 83.4%, which ranks 372nd out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Annual Checkup

Spencer has a crude rate of 74.1% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 685th out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 71.2%, which ranks 823rd out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities).



Spencer has a crude rate of 82.2% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 550th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 79.1%, which ranks 435th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Spencer has a crude rate of 70.0% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 720th out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 69.5%, which ranks 716th out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 31 mid-large communities).



Spencer has a crude rate of 43.8% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 439th out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 44.1%, which ranks 380th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 midlarge communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Spencer has a crude rate of 33.4% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 909th out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 36.3%, which ranks 798th out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Dental Visit

Spencer has a crude rate of 65.6% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 642nd out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 65.0%, which ranks 613th out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Spencer has a crude rate of 75.0% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 684th out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Spencer is 72.1%, which ranks 728th out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 31 mid-large communities).









This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
