### Health in Storm Lake: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Storm Lake,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Storm Lake ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Storm Lake's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Storm Lake. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

#### Strengths

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

#### How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Storm Lake that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Storm Lake, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Storm Lake compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 11,194, Storm Lake's similarly sized communities are defined as mid-large communities. In Iowa, mid-large communities have an average population of 20,750, and there are 31 communities that are considered mid-large communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

#### Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

### **Health Status**


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. #### **Poor General Health**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 18.3% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 927th out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 18.7%, which ranks 899th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Poor Physical Health**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 11.0% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 539th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 11.4%, which ranks 866th out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Poor Mental Health**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 15.5% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 825th out of 958 lowa communities (18th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 14.9%, which ranks 210th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 31 mid-large communities).

### **Health Risk Behaviors**


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. #### **Binge Drinking**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 17.7% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 176th out of 958 lowa communities (1st out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 17.6%, which ranks 1st out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Current Smoking**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 16.6% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 430th out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 18.3%, which ranks 602nd out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Physical Inactivity**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 31.3% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 920th out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 32.0%, which ranks 899th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### Sleep <7 hours

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 30.7% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 561st out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 31 midlarge communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 31.8%, which ranks 613th out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 31 mid-large communities).

### **Health Outcomes**



Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. #### Arthritis

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 19.4% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 19th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 20.1%, which ranks 16th out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **High Blood Pressure**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 26.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 63rd out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 27.0%, which ranks 368th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### Cancer (except skin)

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 6.0% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 38th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 5.9%, which ranks 1st out of 905 lowa communities (1st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Current Asthma**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 9.8% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 838th out of 958 lowa communities (24th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 9.7%, which ranks 628th out of 905 lowa communities (20th out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Coronary Heart Disease**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 5.8% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 268th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 5.7%, which ranks 836th out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 31 mid-large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 6.9%, which ranks 734th out of 905 lowa communities (23rd out of 31 mid-large communities).





Storm Lake has a crude rate of 10.1% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 470th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 10.7%, which ranks 899th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **High Cholesterol**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 36.3% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 482nd out of 958 lowa communities (27th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 34.1%, which ranks 904th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 midlarge communities).



Storm Lake has a crude rate of 3.0% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 310th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 3.0%, which ranks 888th out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Storm Lake has a crude rate of 33.6% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 73rd out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 35.8%, which ranks 201st out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 31 midlarge communities).





The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 18.1%, which ranks 891st out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### Lack of Health Insurance

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 16.1% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 954th out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 16.8%, which ranks 903rd out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Taking BP Medication**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 76.3% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 824th out of 958 lowa communities (19th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 60.4%, which ranks 59th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Cervical Cancer Screening**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 77.6% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 953rd out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 79.6%, which ranks 843rd out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### **Annual Checkup**

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 71.3% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 930th out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 71.5%, which ranks 770th out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 31 mid-large communities).



The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 76.6%, which ranks 879th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities).



Storm Lake has a crude rate of 65.6% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 946th out of 958 lowa communities (31st out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 67.0%, which ranks 890th out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### Core preventive services for older men

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 39.7% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 838th out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 40.1%, which ranks 744th out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 31 mid-large communities).



#### Core preventive services for older women

Storm Lake has a crude rate of 35.1% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 814th out of 958 lowa communities (26th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 38.1%, which ranks 658th out of 905 lowa communities (24th out of 31 mid-large communities).



Storm Lake has a crude rate of 59.3% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 936th out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 31 mid-large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Storm Lake is 58.5%, which ranks 886th out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 31 mid-large communities).







The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
