

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### Health in Sumner: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Sumner,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Sumner ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Sumner's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Sumner. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

#### How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Sumner that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Sumner, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Sumner compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 2,145, Sumner's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

#### Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

### **Health Status**


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. #### **Poor General Health**

Sumner has a crude rate of 13.1% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 272nd out of 958 lowa communities (42nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 11.1%, which ranks 141st out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Poor Physical Health**

Sumner has a crude rate of 10.3% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 323rd out of 958 lowa communities (54th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 8.9%, which ranks 160th out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Poor Mental Health**

Sumner has a crude rate of 12.6% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 39th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 14.6%, which ranks 140th out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 138 small communities).

### **Health Risk Behaviors**


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. #### **Binge Drinking**

Sumner has a crude rate of 18.3% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 269th out of 958 lowa communities (44th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 22.8%, which ranks 686th out of 905 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Current Smoking**

Sumner has a crude rate of 14.4% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 103rd out of 958 lowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 15.9%, which ranks 180th out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Physical Inactivity**

Sumner has a crude rate of 24.4% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 279th out of 958 lowa communities (44th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 21.7%, which ranks 150th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 138 small communities).



#### Sleep <7 hours

Sumner has a crude rate of 27.5% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 59th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 29.0%, which ranks 105th out of 905 lowa communities (18th out of 138 small communities).

### **Health Outcomes**


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. #### Arthritis

Sumner has a crude rate of 30.3% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 748th out of 958 lowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 22.8%, which ranks 347th out of 905 lowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities).



#### **High Blood Pressure**

Sumner has a crude rate of 33.7% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 639th out of 958 lowa communities (90th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 26.0%, which ranks 165th out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities).



#### Cancer (except skin)

Sumner has a crude rate of 9.6% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 841st out of 958 lowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



#### **Current Asthma**

Sumner has a crude rate of 8.8% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 44th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 9.1%, which ranks 125th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Coronary Heart Disease**

Sumner has a crude rate of 6.9% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 608th out of 958 lowa communities (80th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 4.5%, which ranks 78th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities).



#### COPD

Sumner has a crude rate of 7.1% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 363rd out of 958 lowa communities (56th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 5.5%, which ranks 144th out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



Sumner has a crude rate of 16.5% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 74th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 18.2%, which ranks 138th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities).



#### Diabetes

Sumner has a crude rate of 9.9% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 416th out of 958 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 7.3%, which ranks 103rd out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities).



#### **High Cholesterol**

Sumner has a crude rate of 36.2% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 465th out of 958 lowa communities (61st out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Sumner is 28.0%, which ranks 33rd out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Chronic Kidney Disease**

Sumner has a crude rate of 3.5% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 676th out of 958 lowa communities (84th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 2.4%, which ranks 36th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities).



Sumner has a crude rate of 34.6% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 111th out of 958 lowa communities (20th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 35.3%, which ranks 149th out of 905 lowa communities (25th out of 138 small communities).





Sumner has a crude rate of 11.2% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 202nd out of 958 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 10.8%, which ranks 135th out of 905 lowa communities (27th out of 138 small communities).

### Prevention



#### Lack of Health Insurance

Sumner has a crude rate of 6.5% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 178th out of 958 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 6.8%, which ranks 143rd out of 905 lowa communities (30th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Taking BP Medication**

Sumner has a crude rate of 81.6% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 216th out of 958 lowa communities (44th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 57.7%, which ranks 801st out of 905 lowa communities (119th out of 138 small communities).



Sumner has a crude rate of 84.6% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 196th out of 958 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 84.4%, which ranks 168th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Annual Checkup**

Sumner has a crude rate of 76.4% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 234th out of 958 lowa communities (45th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 71.8%, which ranks 686th out of 905 lowa communities (114th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Cholesterol Screening**

Sumner has a crude rate of 85.0% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 92nd out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 80.1%, which ranks 212th out of 905 lowa communities (44th out of 138 small communities).



#### **Colorectal Cancer Screening**

Sumner has a crude rate of 77.2% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 10th out of 958 lowa communities (1st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 75.6%, which ranks 40th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities).



#### Core preventive services for older men

Sumner has a crude rate of 45.7% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 282nd out of 958 lowa communities (43rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 46.1%, which ranks 238th out of 905 lowa communities (44th out of 138 small communities).



#### Core preventive services for older women

Sumner has a crude rate of 41.3% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 296th out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 43.9%, which ranks 138th out of 905 lowa communities (32nd out of 138 small communities).



#### **Dental Visit**

Sumner has a crude rate of 72.5% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 84th out of 958 lowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 71.7%, which ranks 96th out of 905 lowa communities (20th out of 138 small communities).



Sumner has a crude rate of 79.1% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 101st out of 958 Iowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 78.0%, which ranks 45th out of 905 Iowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities).

### Disability



#### Hearing disability

Sumner has a crude rate of 8.0% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 645th out of 958 lowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 5.4%, which ranks 79th out of 905 lowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities).





Sumner has a crude rate of 9.8% for cognitive disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 105th out of 958 lowa communities (16th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 10.5%, which ranks 156th out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 138 small communities).







Sumner has a crude rate of 6.2% for independent living disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 299th out of 958 lowa communities (43rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Sumner is 5.5%, which ranks 160th out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities).



The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
