Health in University Heights: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of University Heights,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how University Heights ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify University Heights's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to University Heights. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in University Heights that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of University Heights, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how University Heights compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,353, University Heights's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, lowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

University Heights has a crude rate of 10.2% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 45th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 11.0%, which ranks 126th out of 905 lowa communities (24th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

University Heights has a crude rate of 7.8% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 25th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 8.6%, which ranks 103rd out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

University Heights has a crude rate of 15.7% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 856th out of 958 lowa communities (132nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 14.5%, which ranks 121st out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. University Heights has a crude rate of 22.9% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 888th out of 958 lowa communities (123rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 21.2%, which ranks 202nd out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



University Heights has a crude rate of 11.9% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 12th out of 958 lowa communities (2nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 12.9%, which ranks 28th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities).



University Heights has a crude rate of 18.9% for no leisuretime physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 34th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 20.0%, which ranks 60th out of 905 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 28.4%, which ranks 63rd out of 905 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes



University Heights has a crude rate of 19.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 17th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 22.4%, which ranks 230th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities).





University Heights has a crude rate of 5.6% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 22nd out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 6.6%, which ranks 831st out of 905 lowa communities (126th out of 138 small communities).







University Heights has a crude rate of 6.1% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 103rd out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 5.8%, which ranks 41st out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities).



University Heights has a crude rate of 43.3% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 508th out of 958 lowa communities (77th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 42.5%, which ranks 549th out of 905 lowa communities (102nd out of 138 small communities).



University Heights has a crude rate of 45.1% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 95th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 45.3%, which ranks 91st out of 905 lowa communities (19th out of 138 small communities).



The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 68.8%, which ranks 260th out of 905 lowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities).





The age-adjusted rate for University Heights is 5.6%, which ranks 163rd out of 905 lowa communities (29th out of 138 small communities).







This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
