

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Health in Urbana: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Urbana,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Urbana ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Urbana's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Urbana. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Urbana that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Urbana, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Urbana compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,565, Urbana's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In lowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Urbana has a crude rate of 11.0% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 74th out of 958 lowa communities (18th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 11.6%, which ranks 191st out of 905 lowa communities (38th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Urbana has a crude rate of 8.8% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 76th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 9.1%, which ranks 210th out of 905 lowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Urbana has a crude rate of 15.6% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 840th out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 15.1%, which ranks 270th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Urbana has a crude rate of 23.8% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 931st out of 958 lowa communities (130th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 22.2%, which ranks 520th out of 905 lowa communities (73rd out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Urbana has a crude rate of 17.7% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 640th out of 958 lowa communities (115th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 16.4%, which ranks 230th out of 905 lowa communities (44th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Urbana has a crude rate of 21.4% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 85th out of 958 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 22.0%, which ranks 179th out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Urbana has a crude rate of 32.8% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 905th out of 958 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 31.7%, which ranks 580th out of 905 lowa communities (96th out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Urbana has a crude rate of 20.0% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 23rd out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Urbana is 22.3%, which ranks 210th out of 905 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Urbana has a crude rate of 25.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 45th out of 958 lowa communities (13th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 27.6%, which ranks 517th out of 905 lowa communities (87th out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Urbana has a crude rate of 5.5% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 19th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Urbana has a crude rate of 9.5% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 625th out of 958 lowa communities (100th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 9.4%, which ranks 330th out of 905 lowa communities (48th out of 138 small communities).



Coronary Heart Disease

Urbana has a crude rate of 3.9% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 23rd out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 4.8%, which ranks 257th out of 905 lowa communities (53rd out of 138 small communities).



Urbana has a crude rate of 5.3% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 61st out of 958 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 5.8%, which ranks 226th out of 905 lowa communities (40th out of 138 small communities).



Urbana has a crude rate of 18.8% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 708th out of 958 lowa communities (110th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 18.3%, which ranks 164th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities).



Urbana has a crude rate of 6.8% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 28th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 7.8%, which ranks 268th out of 905 lowa communities (50th out of 138 small communities).



High Cholesterol

Urbana has a crude rate of 29.5% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 20th out of 958 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Urbana is 29.5%, which ranks 336th out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



Urbana has a crude rate of 2.2% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 21st out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 2.5%, which ranks 142nd out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



Urbana has a crude rate of 39.0% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 690th out of 958 lowa communities (116th out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Urbana is 37.9%, which ranks 490th out of 905 lowa communities (75th out of 138 small communities).





Urbana has a crude rate of 11.3% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 215th out of 958 lowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 11.6%, which ranks 232nd out of 905 lowa communities (43rd out of 138 small communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Urbana has a crude rate of 7.2% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 415th out of 958 lowa communities (68th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 6.9%, which ranks 168th out of 905 lowa communities (36th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Urbana has a crude rate of 70.1% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 946th out of 958 lowa communities (136th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 57.8%, which ranks 790th out of 905 lowa communities (118th out of 138 small communities).



Urbana has a crude rate of 85.2% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 124th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 84.0%, which ranks 232nd out of 905 lowa communities (47th out of 138 small communities).



Urbana has a crude rate of 72.6% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 871st out of 958 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 74.2%, which ranks 66th out of 905 lowa communities (15th out of 138 small communities).



Cholesterol Screening

Urbana has a crude rate of 79.1% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 885th out of 958 lowa communities (135th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 79.9%, which ranks 258th out of 905 lowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Urbana has a crude rate of 71.5% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 486th out of 958 lowa communities (79th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 72.0%, which ranks 285th out of 905 lowa communities (49th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Urbana has a crude rate of 44.6% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 359th out of 958 lowa communities (58th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 44.9%, which ranks 326th out of 905 lowa communities (61st out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Urbana has a crude rate of 43.4% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 166th out of 958 lowa communities (23rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 44.3%, which ranks 122nd out of 905 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities).



Dental Visit

Urbana has a crude rate of 68.2% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 361st out of 958 lowa communities (69th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 69.1%, which ranks 239th out of 905 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities).



Urbana has a crude rate of 77.5% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 263rd out of 958 Iowa communities (33rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 74.7%, which ranks 285th out of 905 Iowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Hearing disability

Urbana has a crude rate of 4.9% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 42nd out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 5.8%, which ranks 287th out of 905 lowa communities (63rd out of 138 small communities).









Urbana has a crude rate of 2.4% for self-care disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 48th out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Urbana is 2.6%, which ranks 167th out of 905 lowa communities (32nd out of 138 small communities).





This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
