

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Health in Van Meter: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Van Meter,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Van Meter ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Van Meter's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all lowa communities and communities of similar size to Van Meter. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Van Meter that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Van Meter, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Van Meter compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 1,468, Van Meter's similarly sized communities are defined as small communities. In Iowa, small communities have an average population of 1,553, and there are 138 communities that are considered small communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Ames, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the community. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Ames has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most communities in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized communities, indicating that when accounting for Ames's unique age distribution, Ames's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Van Meter has a crude rate of 9.8% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 34th out of 958 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 9.6%, which ranks 31st out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Physical Health

Van Meter has a crude rate of 8.3% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 42nd out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 8.0%, which ranks 36th out of 905 lowa communities (7th out of 138 small communities).



Poor Mental Health

Van Meter has a crude rate of 13.4% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 164th out of 958 lowa communities (25th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 13.5%, which ranks 22nd out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Van Meter has a crude rate of 24.5% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 946th out of 958 lowa communities (134th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 24.5%, which ranks 901st out of 905 lowa communities (138th out of 138 small communities).



Current Smoking

Van Meter has a crude rate of 13.6% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 63rd out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 12.7%, which ranks 25th out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities).



Physical Inactivity

Van Meter has a crude rate of 18.8% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 33rd out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 18.6%, which ranks 27th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities).



Sleep <7 hours

Van Meter has a crude rate of 25.9% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 12th out of 958 lowa communities (3rd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 25.3%, which ranks 4th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 138 small communities).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Van Meter has a crude rate of 24.2% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 156th out of 958 lowa communities (28th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 23.6%, which ranks 574th out of 905 lowa communities (94th out of 138 small communities).



High Blood Pressure

Van Meter has a crude rate of 24.9% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 38th out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 24.6%, which ranks 27th out of 905 lowa communities (8th out of 138 small communities).



Cancer (except skin)

Van Meter has a crude rate of 6.2% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 51st out of 958 lowa communities (12th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 6.5%, which ranks 418th out of 905 lowa communities (41st out of 138 small communities).



Current Asthma

Van Meter has a crude rate of 9.2% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 311th out of 958 lowa communities (46th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 9.1%, which ranks 125th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 3.9% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 23rd out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 4.1%, which ranks 12th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 4.8% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 36th out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 4.7%, which ranks 24th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 18.3% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 568th out of 958 lowa communities (91st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 18.2%, which ranks 138th out of 905 lowa communities (14th out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 6.9% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 31st out of 958 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 6.7%, which ranks 18th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 32.2% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 81st out of 958 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities). The ageadjusted rate for Van Meter is 29.5%, which ranks 336th out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 2.2% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 21st out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 2.3%, which ranks 12th out of 905 lowa communities (3rd out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 37.1% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 379th out of 958 lowa communities (64th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 35.6%, which ranks 183rd out of 905 lowa communities (31st out of 138 small communities).





Van Meter has a crude rate of 8.6% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 42nd out of 958 lowa communities (10th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 8.9%, which ranks 37th out of 905 lowa communities (9th out of 138 small communities).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Van Meter has a crude rate of 5.3% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 20th out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 5.5%, which ranks 21st out of 905 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities).



Taking BP Medication

Van Meter has a crude rate of 73.4% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 915th out of 958 lowa communities (127th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 56.9%, which ranks 871st out of 905 lowa communities (133rd out of 138 small communities).



Cervical Cancer Screening

Van Meter has a crude rate of 86.1% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 54th out of 958 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 85.4%, which ranks 56th out of 905 lowa communities (11th out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 73.1% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 824th out of 958 lowa communities (122nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 72.9%, which ranks 333rd out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 83.4% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 317th out of 958 lowa communities (51st out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 82.1%, which ranks 22nd out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Van Meter has a crude rate of 73.7% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 193rd out of 958 lowa communities (32nd out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 74.9%, which ranks 68th out of 905 lowa communities (17th out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older men

Van Meter has a crude rate of 44.8% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 345th out of 958 lowa communities (56th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 47.3%, which ranks 156th out of 905 lowa communities (21st out of 138 small communities).



Core preventive services for older women

Van Meter has a crude rate of 41.3% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 296th out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 42.2%, which ranks 258th out of 905 lowa communities (52nd out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 75.2% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 21st out of 958 lowa communities (4th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 75.3%, which ranks 19th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).



Van Meter has a crude rate of 77.1% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 311th out of 958 lowa communities (39th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 75.3%, which ranks 214th out of 905 lowa communities (34th out of 138 small communities).

Disability



Van Meter has a crude rate of 4.6% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 24th out of 958 lowa communities (6th out of 138 small communities). The age-adjusted rate for Van Meter is 5.0%, which ranks 19th out of 905 lowa communities (5th out of 138 small communities).











This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
