Health in Waterloo: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Waterloo,

We are pleased to share the Iowa Community Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University’s Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa. The following pages include the health snapshot for your community. The snapshot can be used to see how Waterloo ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities. This comparison allows us to identify Waterloo’s strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your community ranks compared to all Iowa communities and communities of similar size to Waterloo. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your community and presents what the rate would be if your community had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between communities and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between communities with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your community! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your community’s strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report

The purpose of the Iowa Community Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Waterloo that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Waterloo, a review of risky behaviors in the community, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Waterloo compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized communities.

With a population of 67,256, Waterloo’s similarly sized communities are defined as large communities. In Iowa, large communities have an average population of 91,321, and there are 11 communities that are considered large communities. To see all of the communities in this population group, please see Appendix 3 of this report.

Using Ames, IA as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your community’s crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all Iowa communities and similarly-sized communities. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across communities. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific community compared to communities across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the community rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all Iowa communities and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized communities.



Health Status

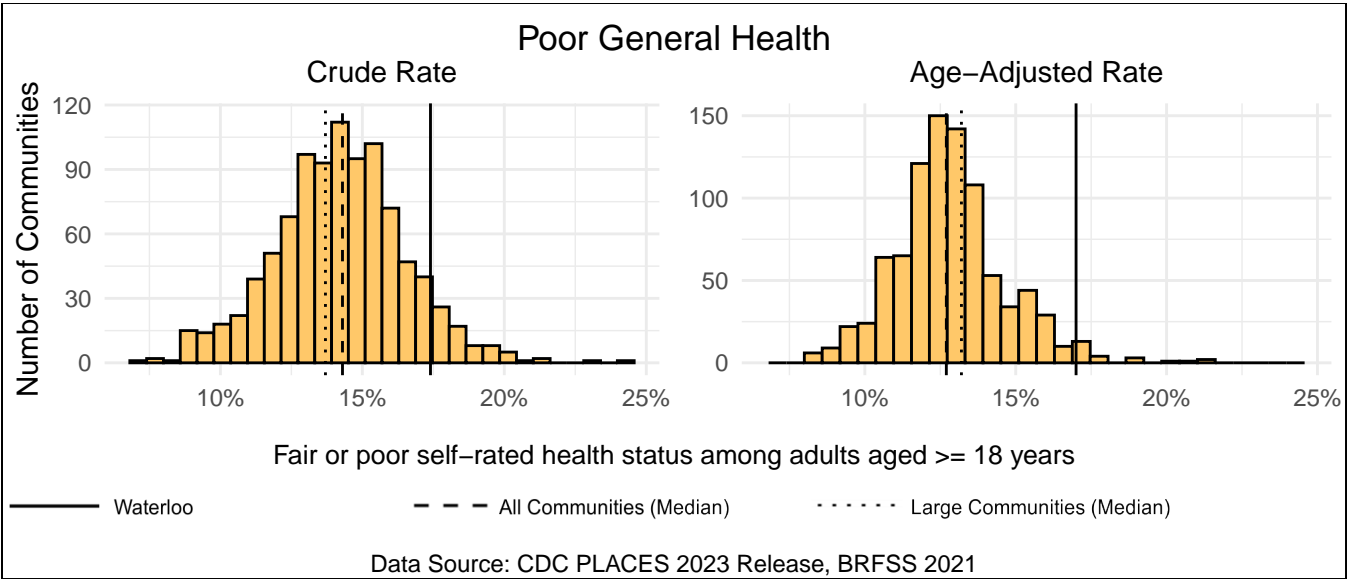
This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country’s population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of “excellent,” “very good,” “good,” “fair,” or “poor,” from which the respondents who answer “fair” or “poor” are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Waterloo has a crude rate of 17.4% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 880th out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 17.0%, which ranks 883rd out of 905 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).

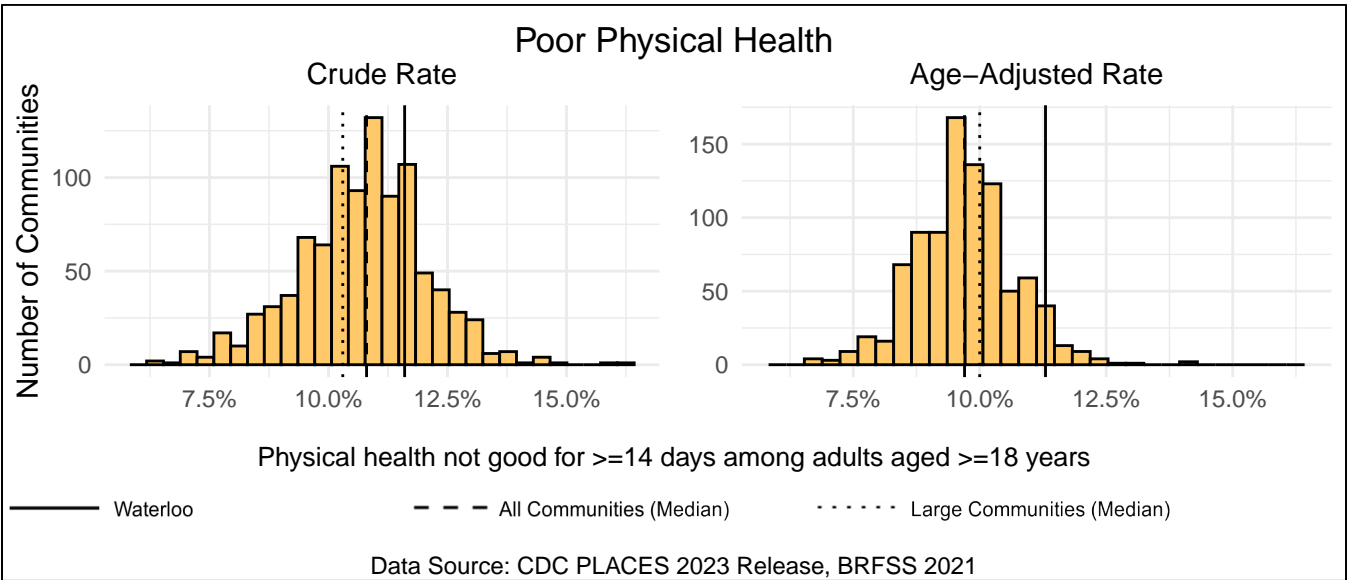

Poor Physical Health

Waterloo has a crude rate of 11.6% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 719th out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 11.3%, which ranks 848th out of 905 Iowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).

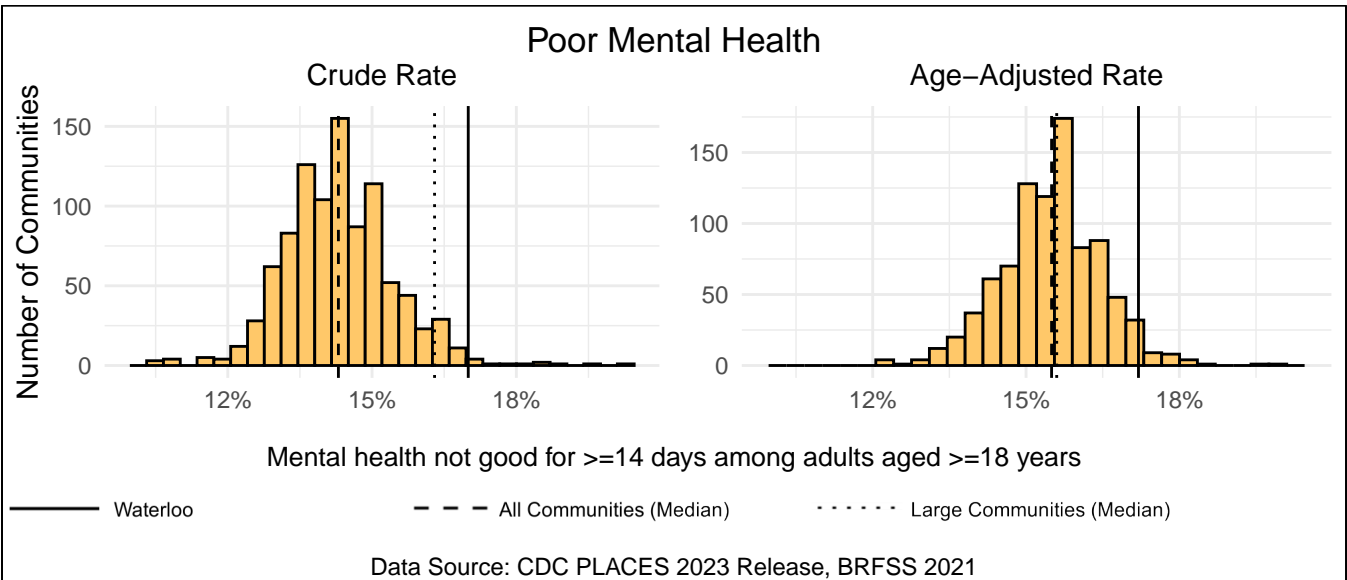

Poor Mental Health

Waterloo has a crude rate of 17.0% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 947th out of 958 Iowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 17.2%, which ranks 865th out of 905 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).

Health Risk Behaviors

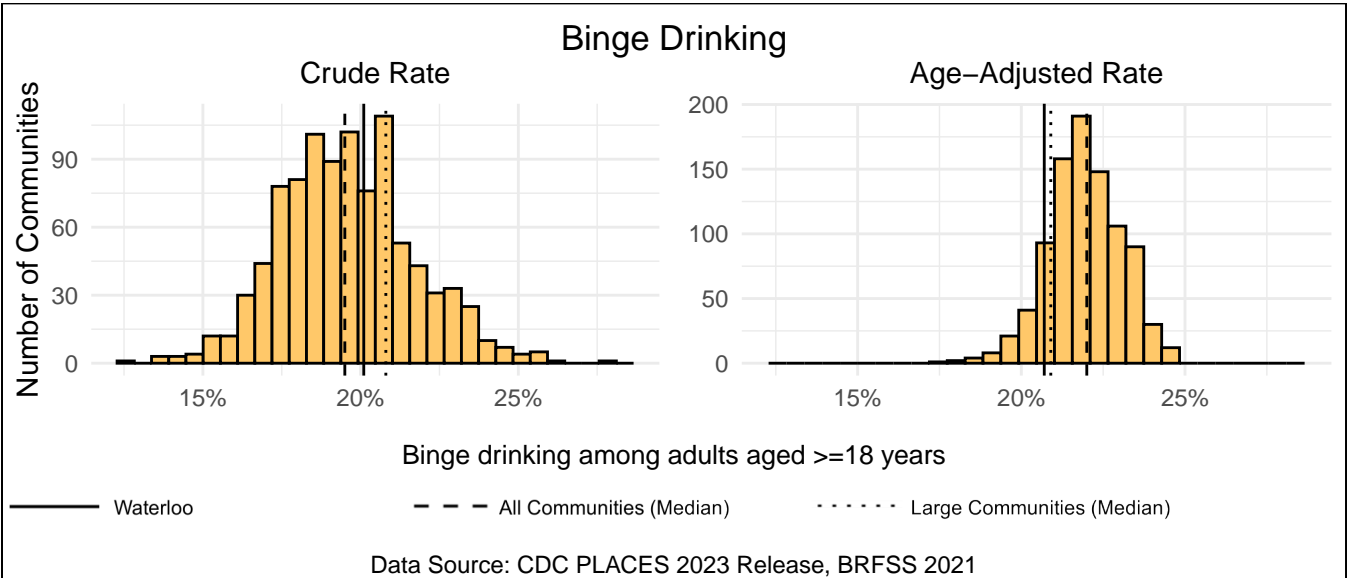
Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Waterloo has a crude rate of 20.1% for binge drinking among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 572nd out of 958 Iowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 20.7%, which ranks 108th out of 905 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).

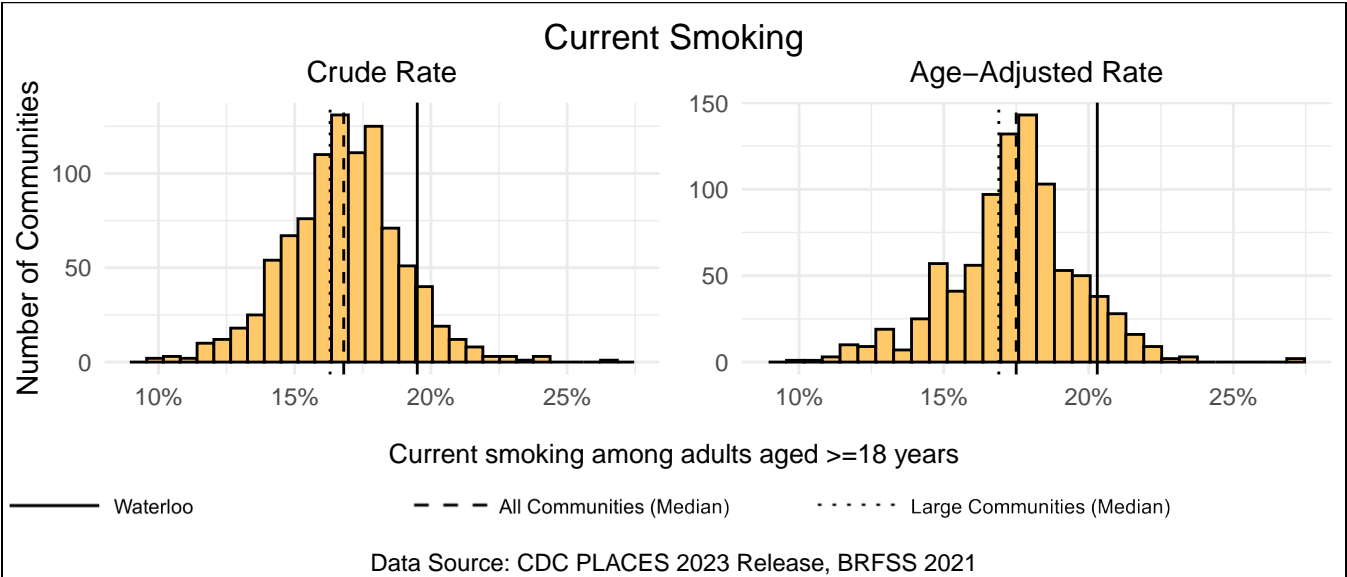

Current Smoking

Waterloo has a crude rate of 19.5% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 869th out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 20.3%, which ranks 822nd out of 905 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).

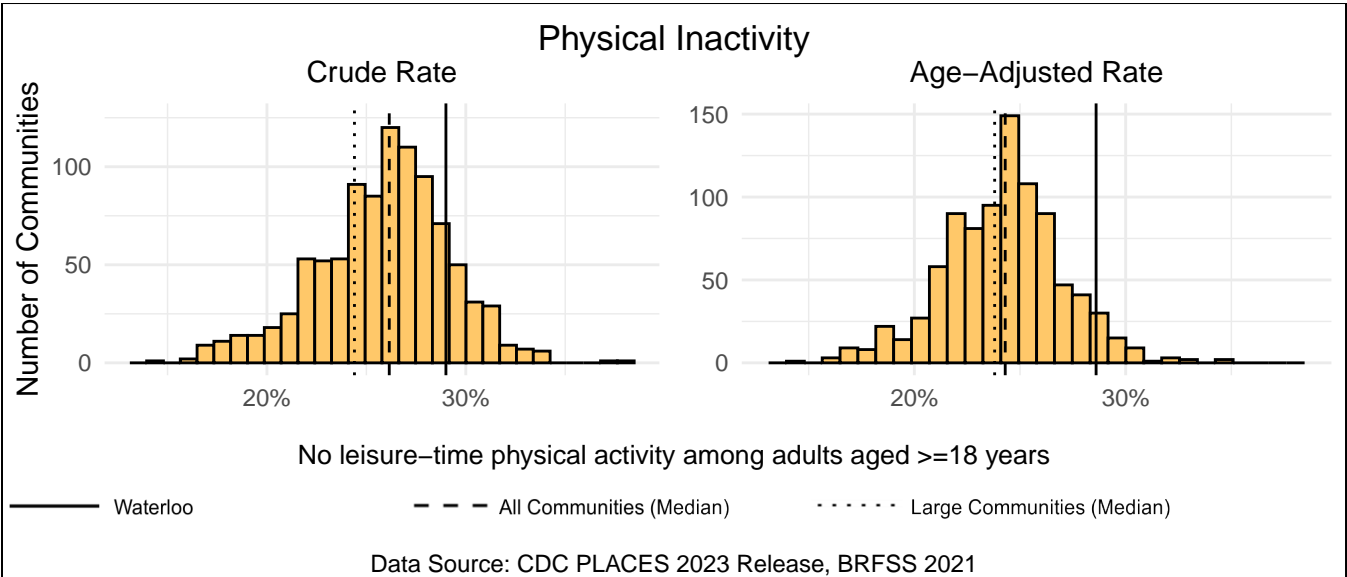

Physical Inactivity

Waterloo has a crude rate of 29.0% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 807th out of 958 Iowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 28.6%, which ranks 850th out of 905 Iowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).

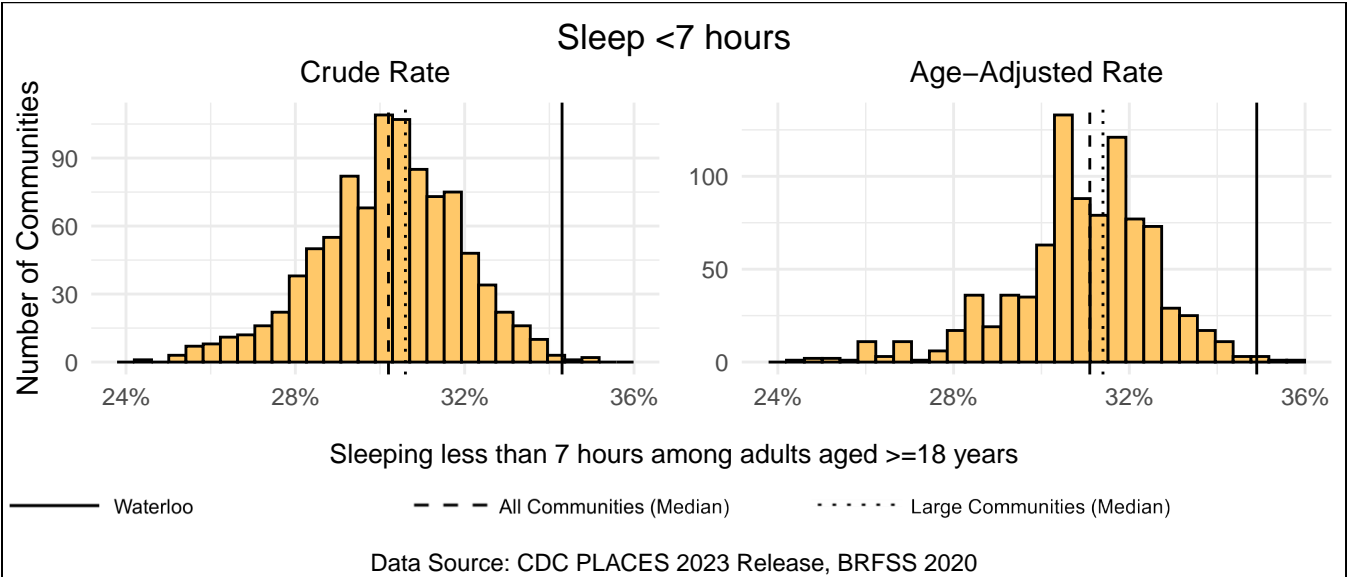

Sleep <7 hours

Waterloo has a crude rate of 34.3% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 954th out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 34.9%, which ranks 902nd out of 905 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).

Health Outcomes

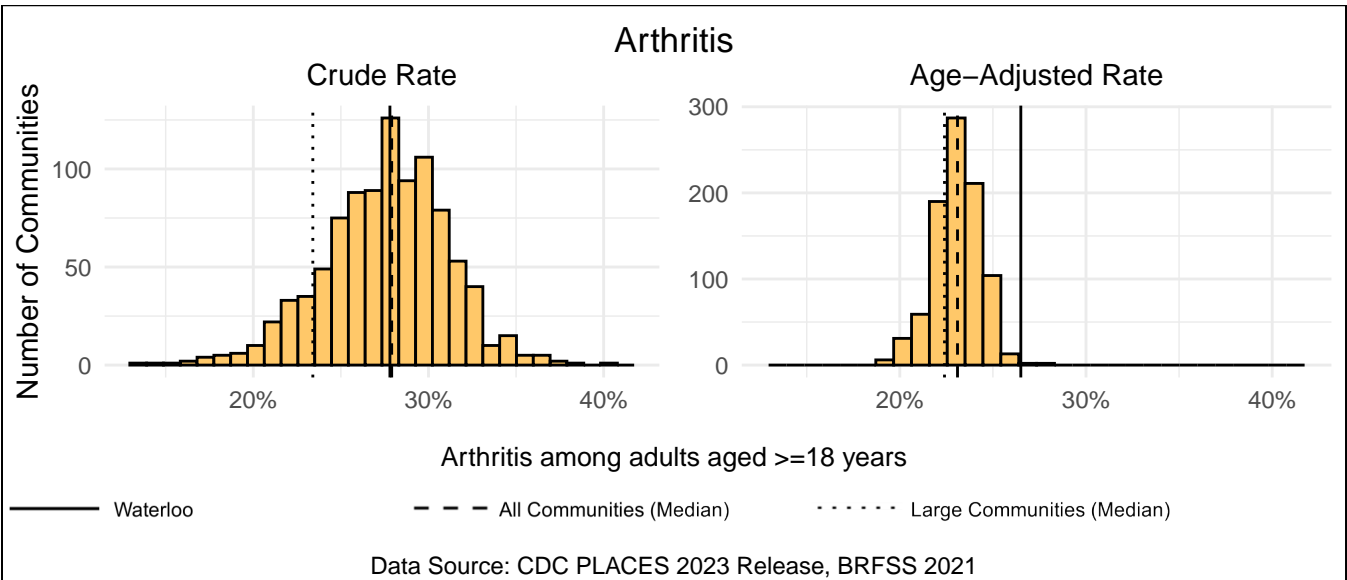
This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Waterloo has a crude rate of 27.8% for arthritis among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 465th out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 26.5%, which ranks 902nd out of 905 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).

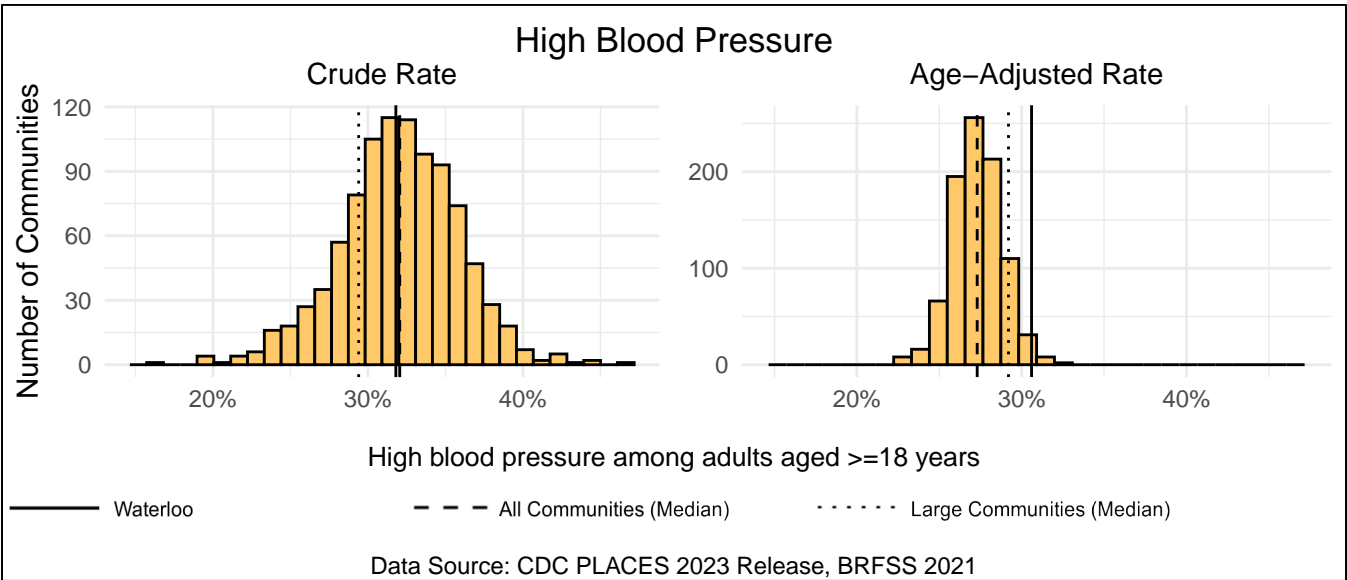

High Blood Pressure

Waterloo has a crude rate of 31.8% for high blood pressure among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 440th out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 30.6%, which ranks 890th out of 905 Iowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).

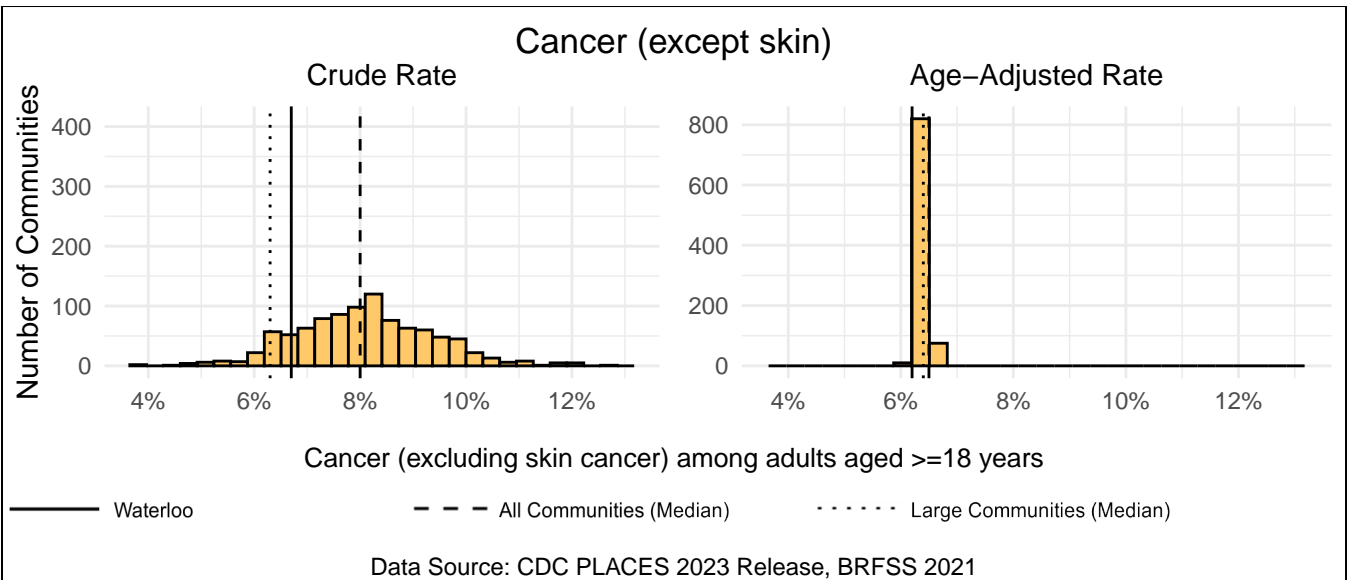

Cancer (except skin)

Waterloo has a crude rate of 6.7% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 126th out of 958 Iowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 6.2%, which ranks 11th out of 905 Iowa communities (1st out of 11 large communities).

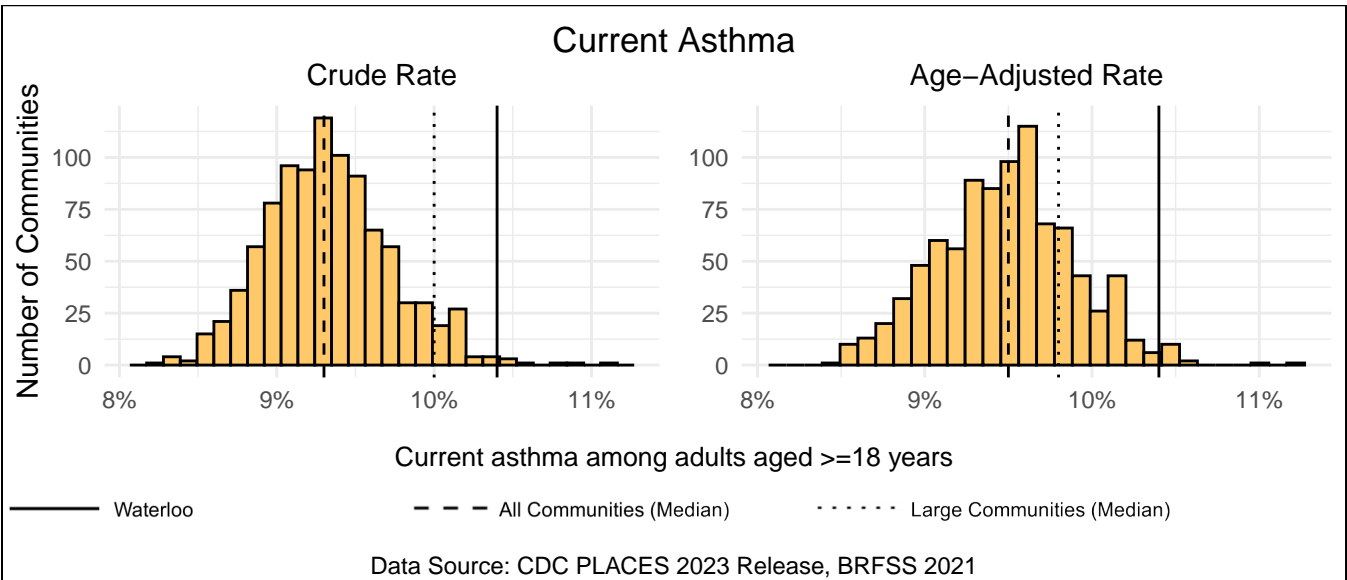

Current Asthma

Waterloo has a crude rate of 10.4% for current asthma among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 948th out of 958 Iowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 10.4%, which ranks 886th out of 905 Iowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).

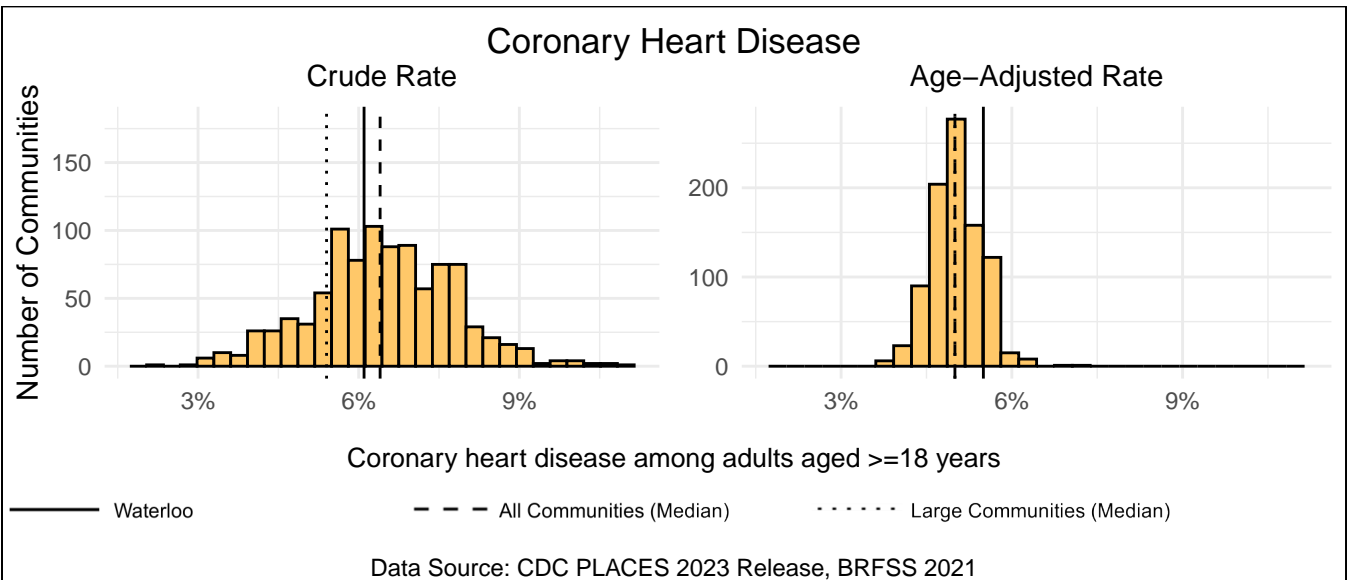

Waterloo has a crude rate of 6.1% for coronary heart disease among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 353rd out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 5.5%, which ranks 759th out of 905 Iowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities).

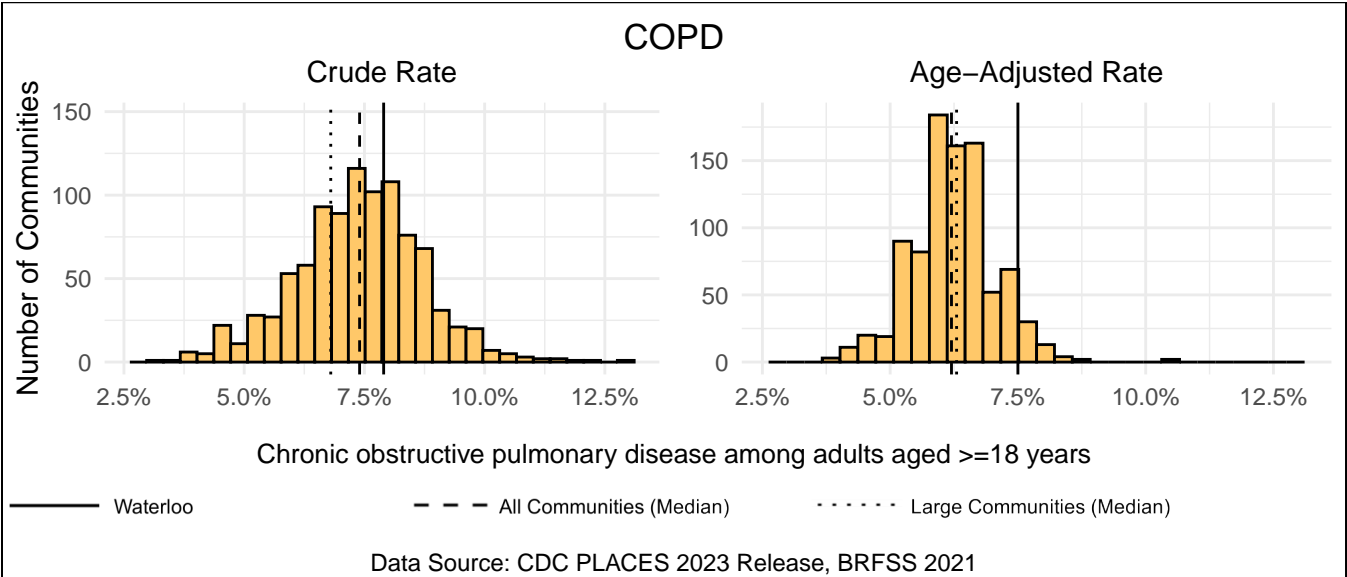

The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 7.5%, which ranks 842nd out of 905 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).

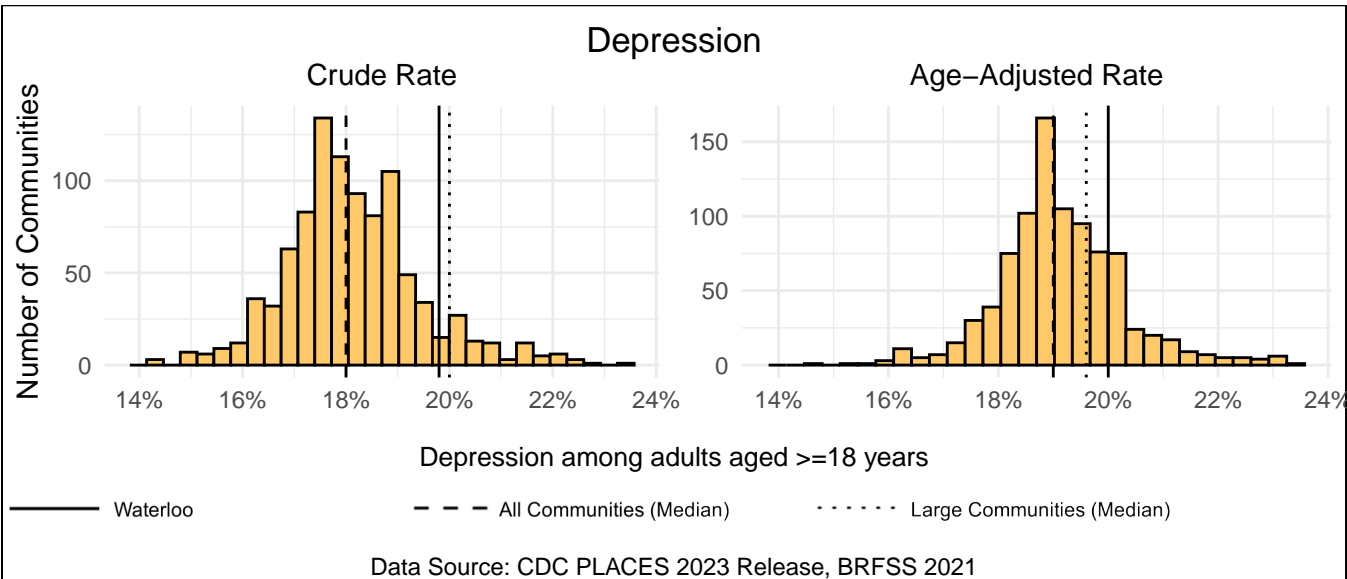

Waterloo has a crude rate of 19.8% for depression among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 870th out of 958 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 20.0%, which ranks 733rd out of 905 Iowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).

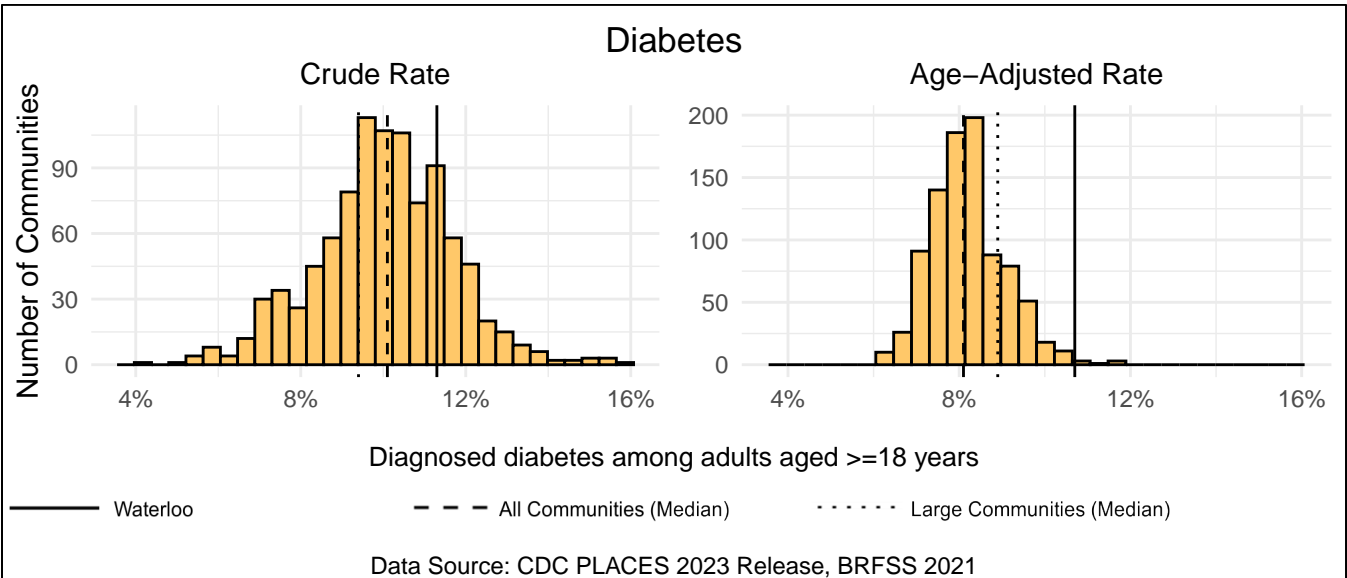

Waterloo has a crude rate of 11.3% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 753rd out of 958 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 10.7%, which ranks 899th out of 905 Iowa communities (11th out of 11 large communities).

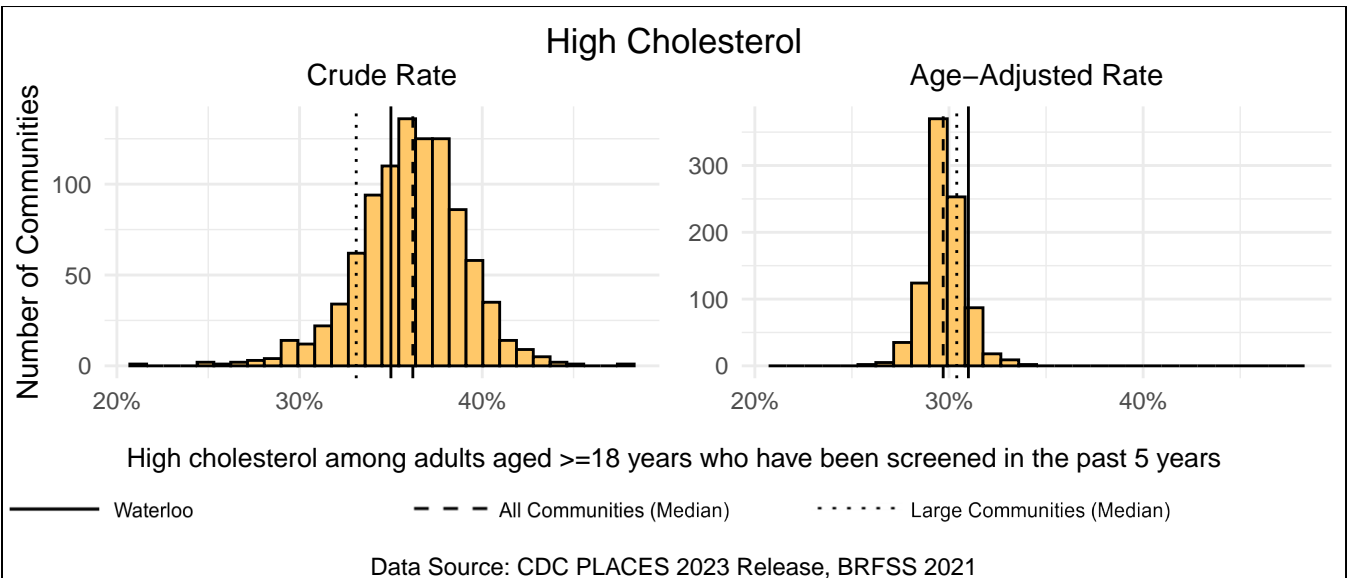

The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 31.0%, which ranks 818th out of 905 Iowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).

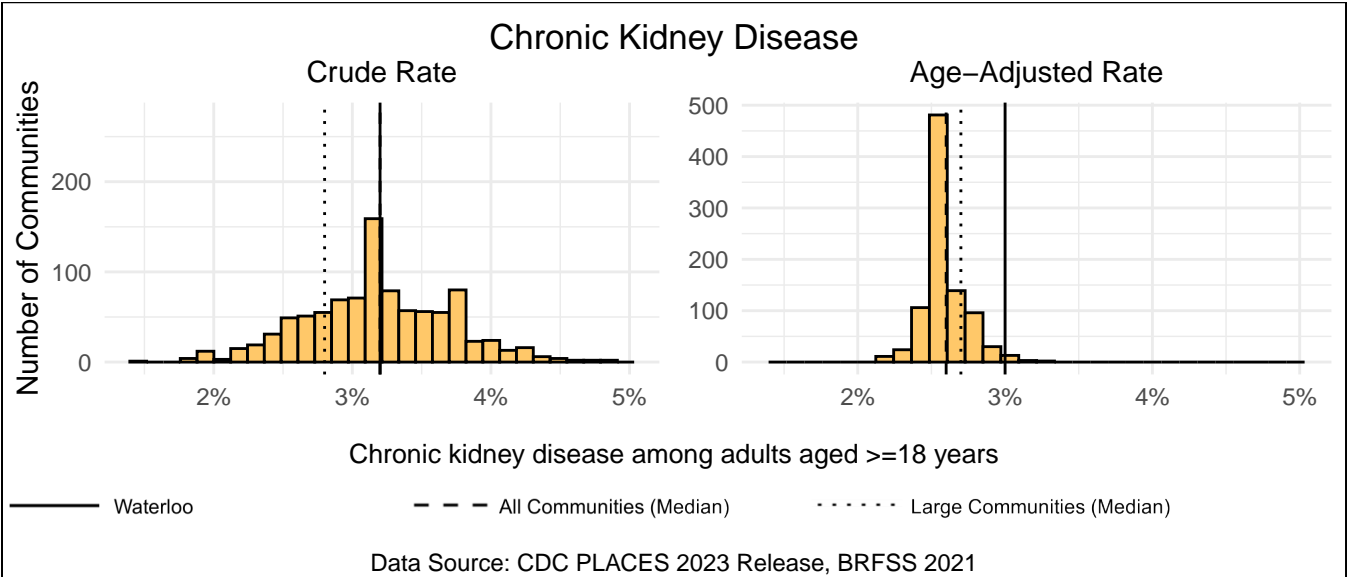

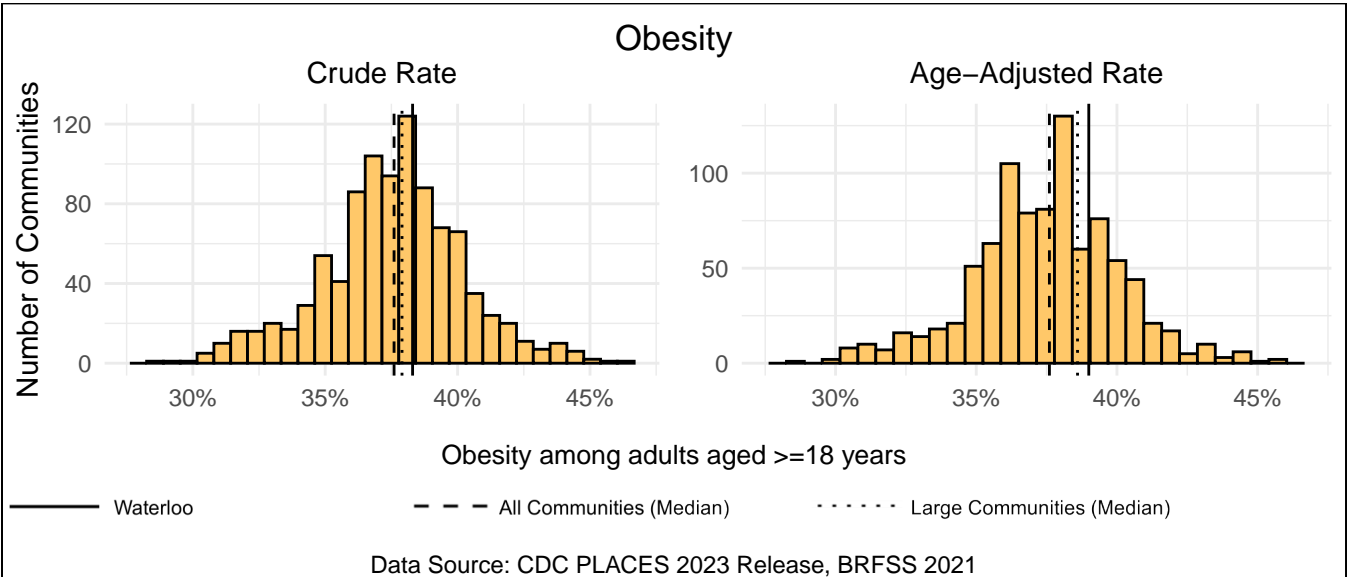

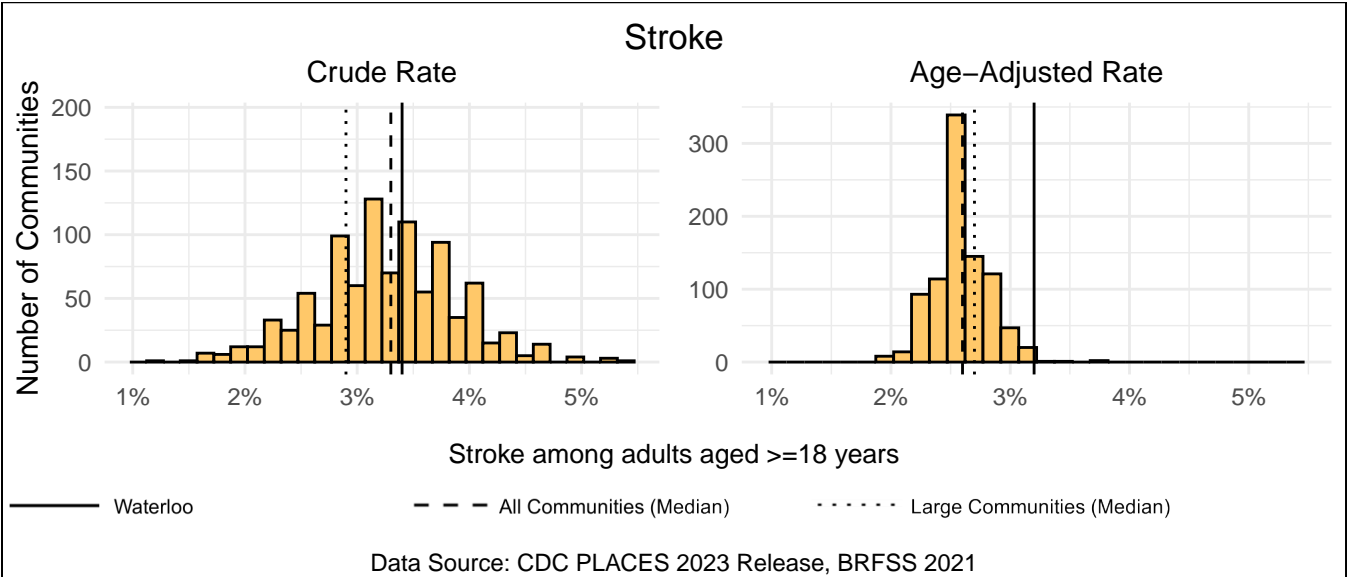

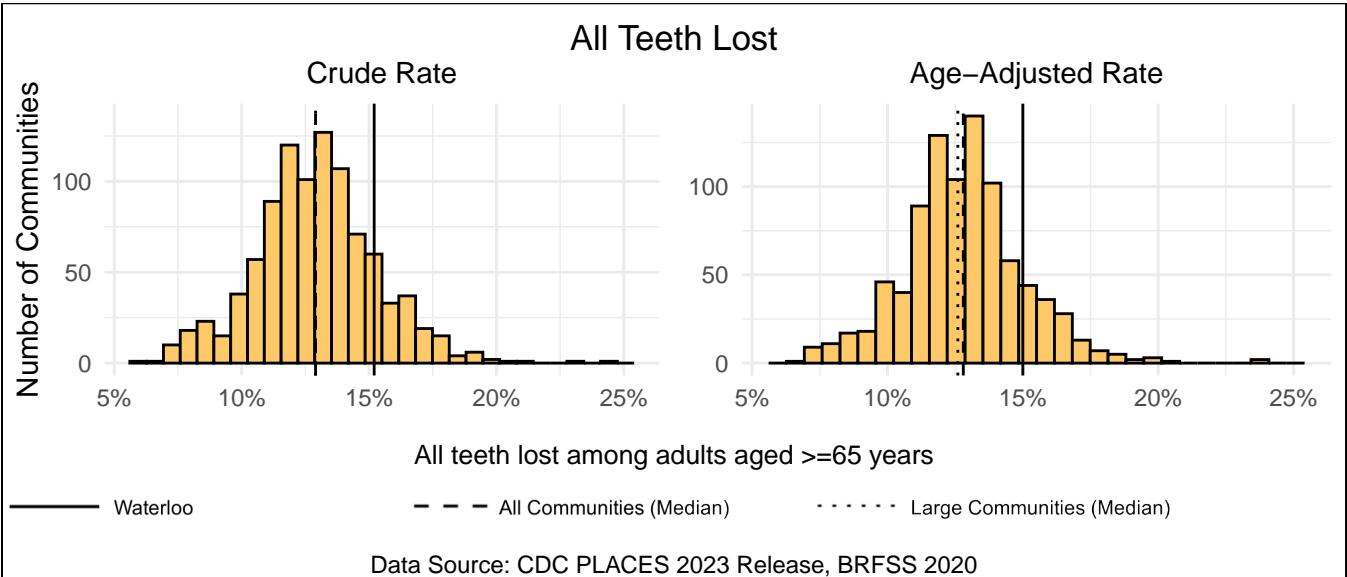

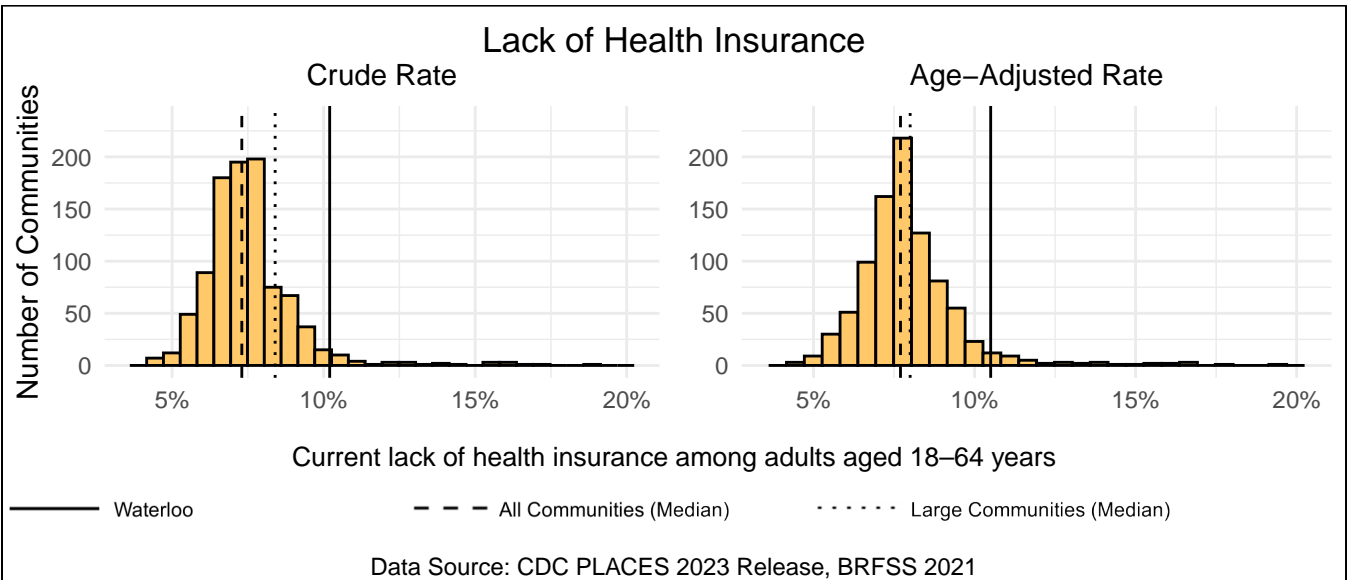

Waterloo has a crude rate of 10.2% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 922nd out of 958 Iowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 10.5%, which ranks 865th out of 905 Iowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).

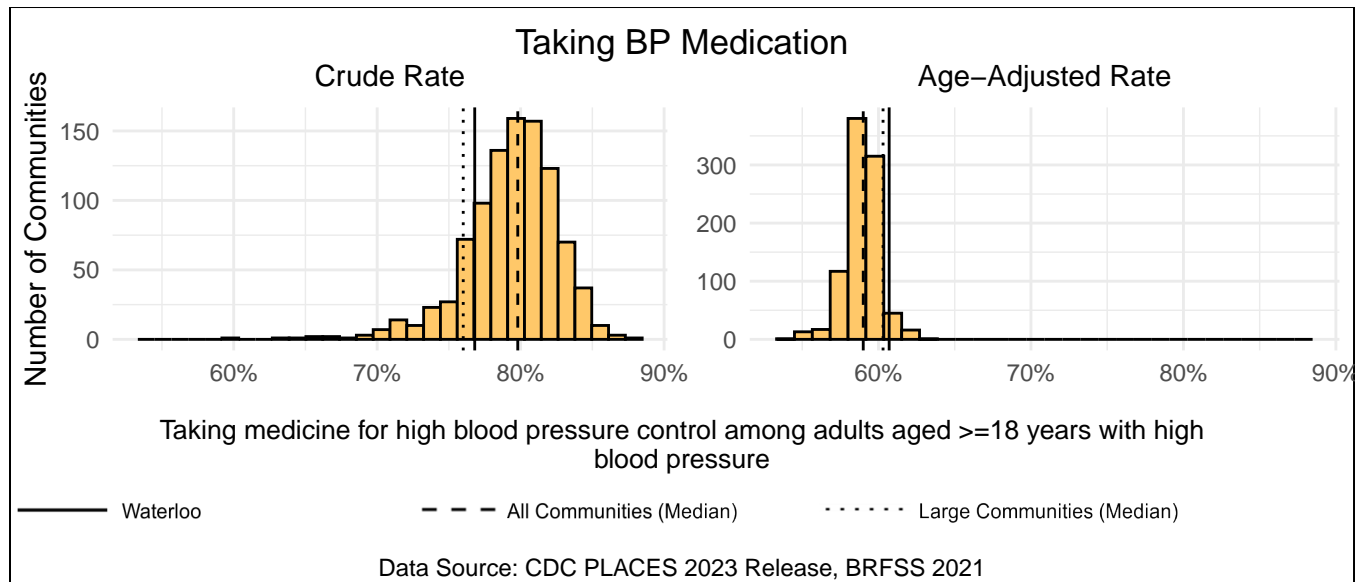

Taking BP Medication

Waterloo has a crude rate of 76.8% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged ≥ 18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 788th out of 958 Iowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 60.7%, which ranks 48th out of 905 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).

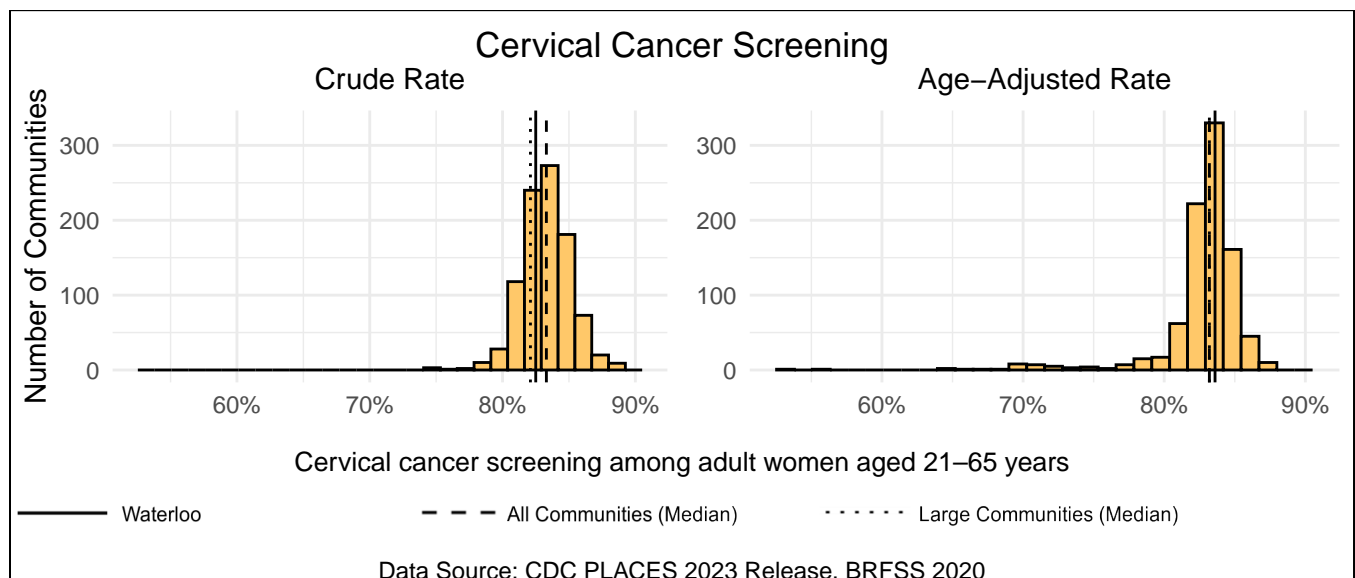

Cervical Cancer Screening

Waterloo has a crude rate of 82.5% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 656th out of 958 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 83.6%, which ranks 328th out of 905 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).

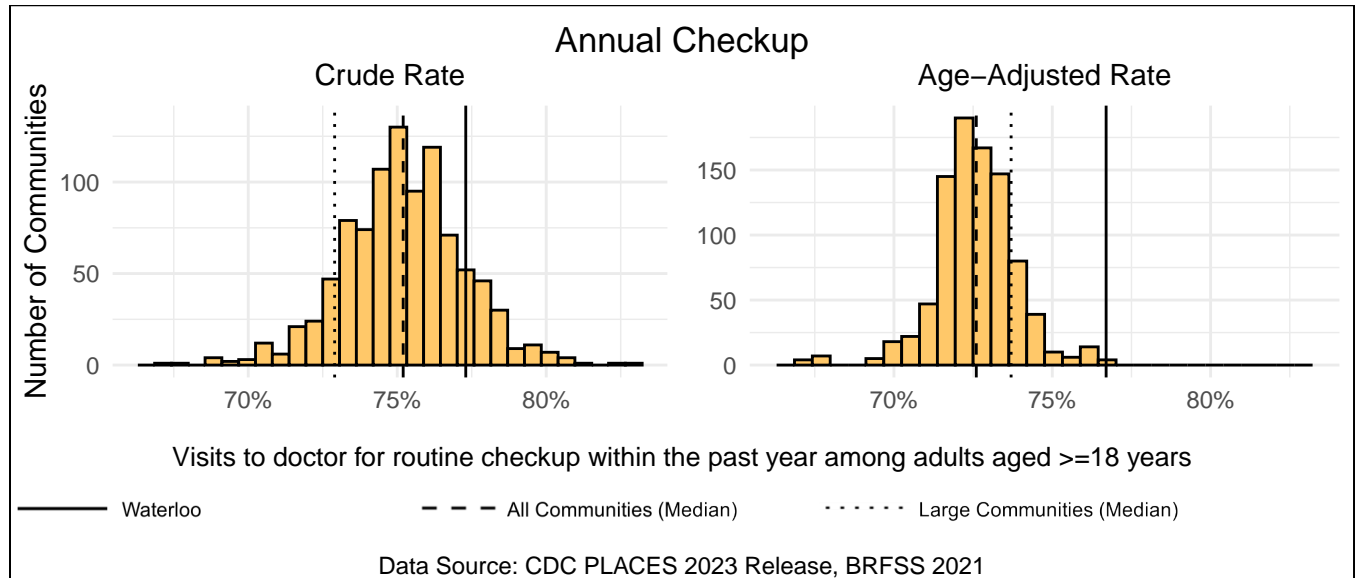

Waterloo has a crude rate of 77.3% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 129th out of 958 Iowa communities (1st out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 76.7%, which ranks 2nd out of 905 Iowa communities (1st out of 11 large communities).

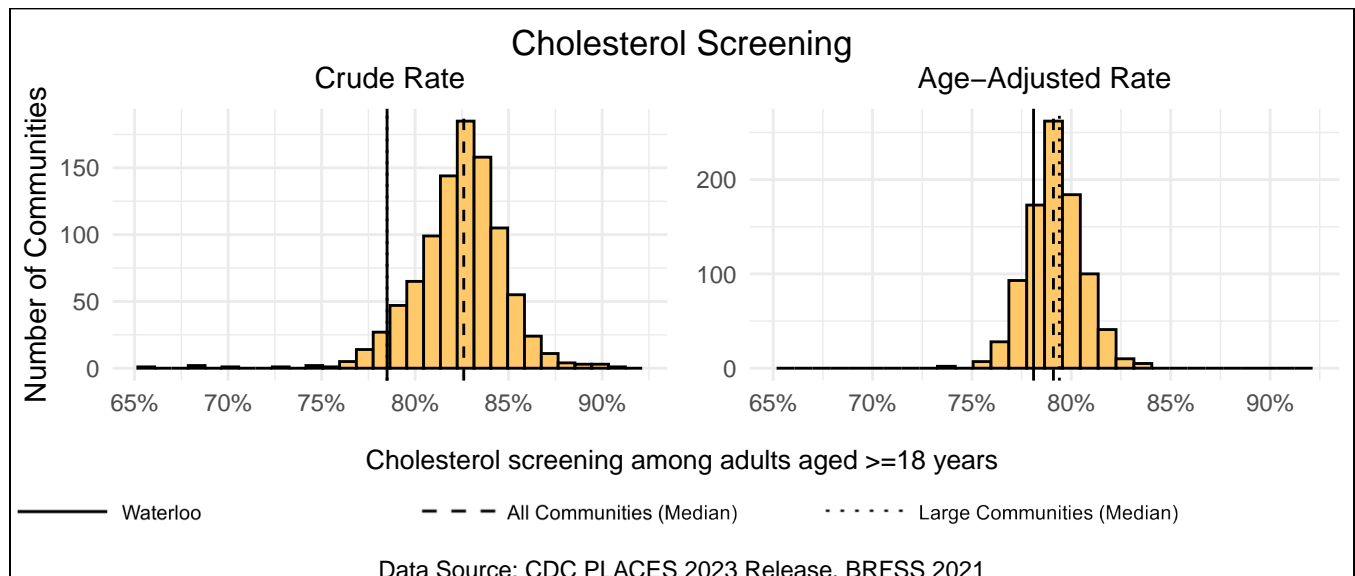

Waterloo has a crude rate of 78.5% for cholesterol screening among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 909th out of 958 Iowa communities (6th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 78.1%, which ranks 709th out of 905 Iowa communities (9th out of 11 large communities).

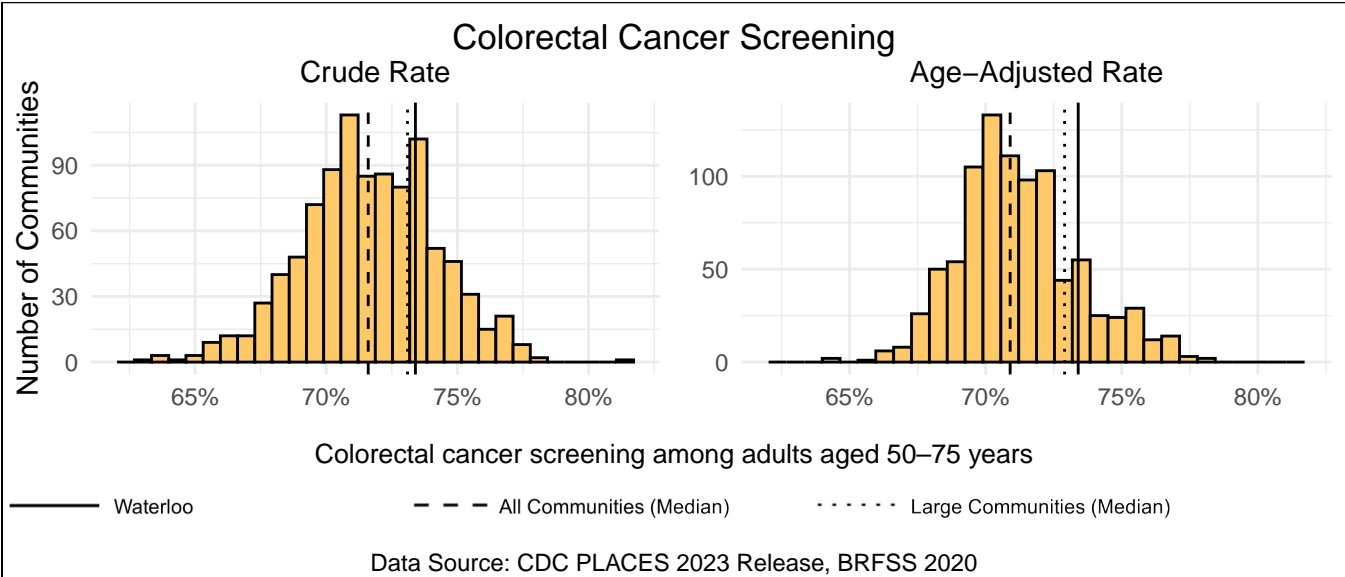

Colorectal Cancer Screening

Waterloo has a crude rate of 73.4% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 234th out of 958 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 73.4%, which ranks 136th out of 905 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).

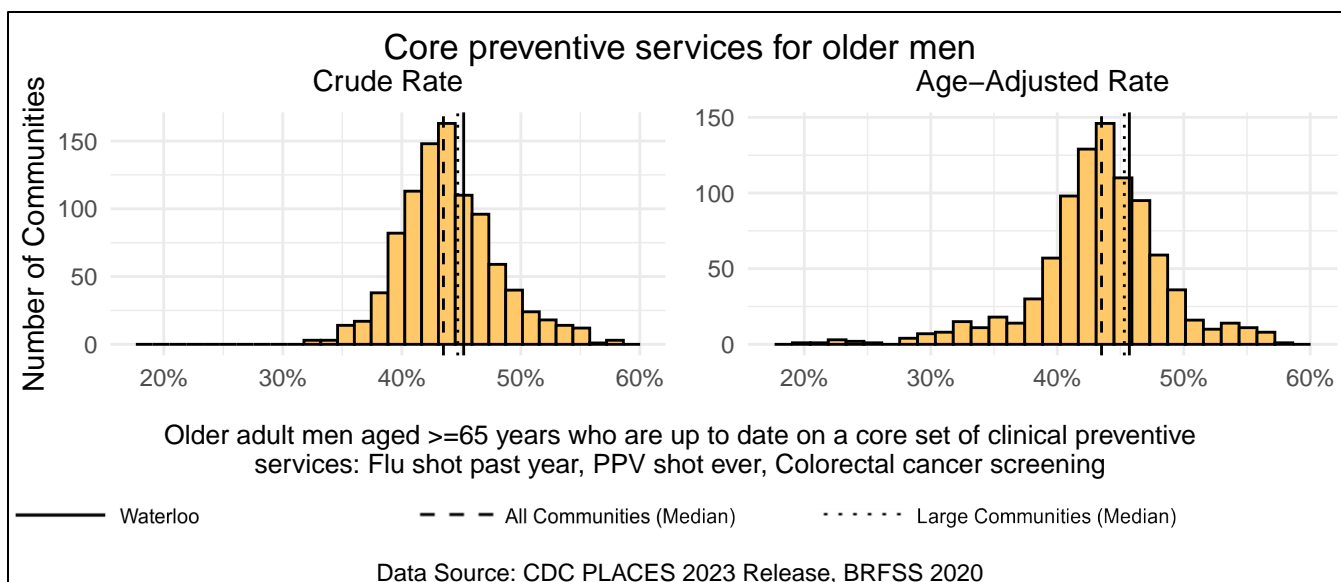

Core preventive services for older men

Waterloo has a crude rate of 45.2% for older adult men aged ≥ 65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 311th out of 958 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 45.7%, which ranks 266th out of 905 Iowa communities (5th out of 11 large communities).

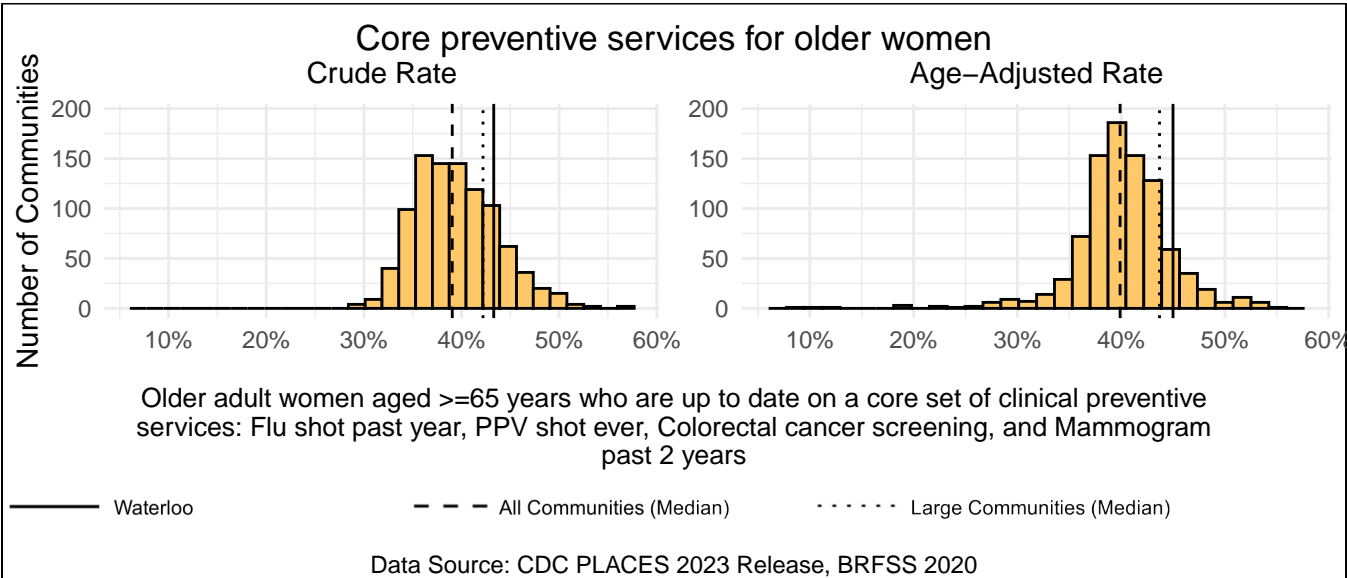

Core preventive services for older women

Waterloo has a crude rate of 43.3% for older adult women aged ≥ 65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 169th out of 958 Iowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 45.0%, which ranks 101st out of 905 Iowa communities (4th out of 11 large communities).

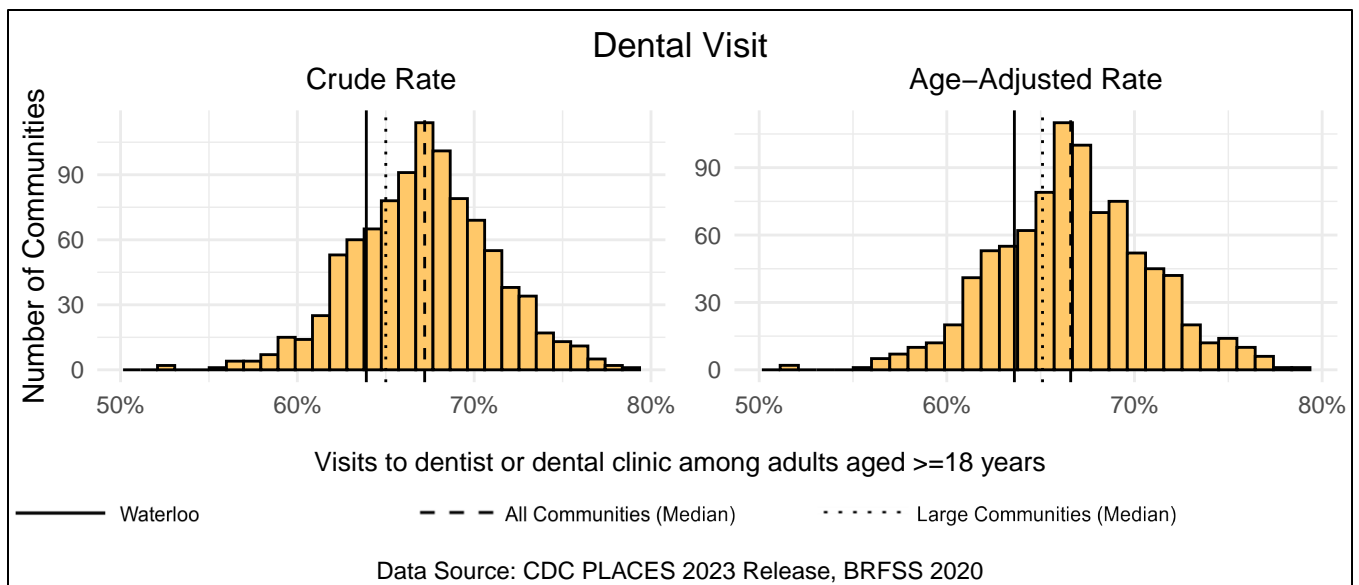

Dental Visit

Waterloo has a crude rate of 63.9% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 764th out of 958 Iowa communities (7th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 63.6%, which ranks 705th out of 905 Iowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).

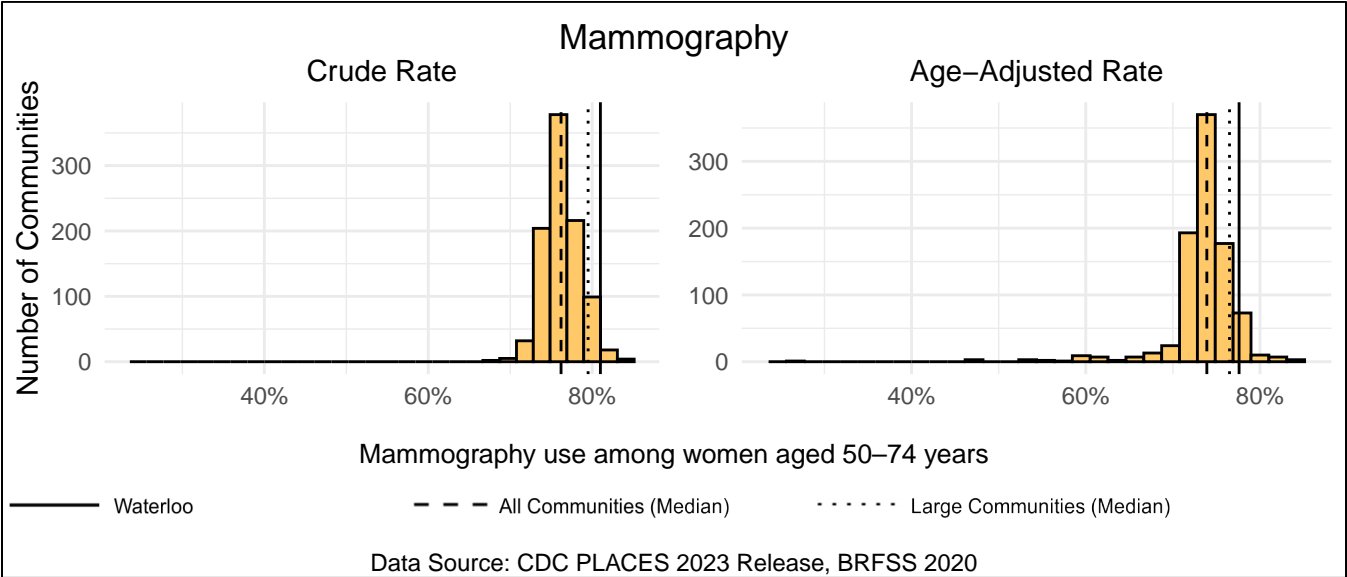

Waterloo has a crude rate of 81.0% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 23rd out of 958 Iowa communities (2nd out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 77.6%, which ranks 66th out of 905 Iowa communities (3rd out of 11 large communities).

Disability

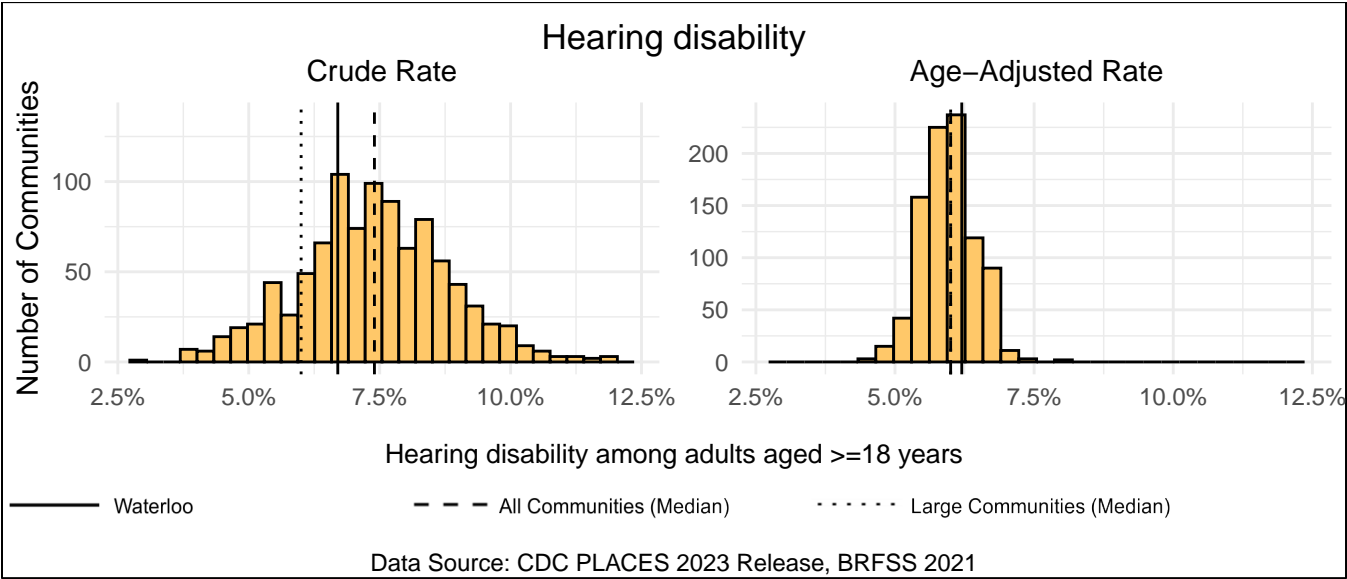

Waterloo has a crude rate of 6.7% for hearing disability among adults aged ≥ 18 years, which ranks 282nd out of 958 Iowa communities (10th out of 11 large communities). The age-adjusted rate for Waterloo is 6.2%, which ranks 621st out of 905 Iowa communities (8th out of 11 large communities).

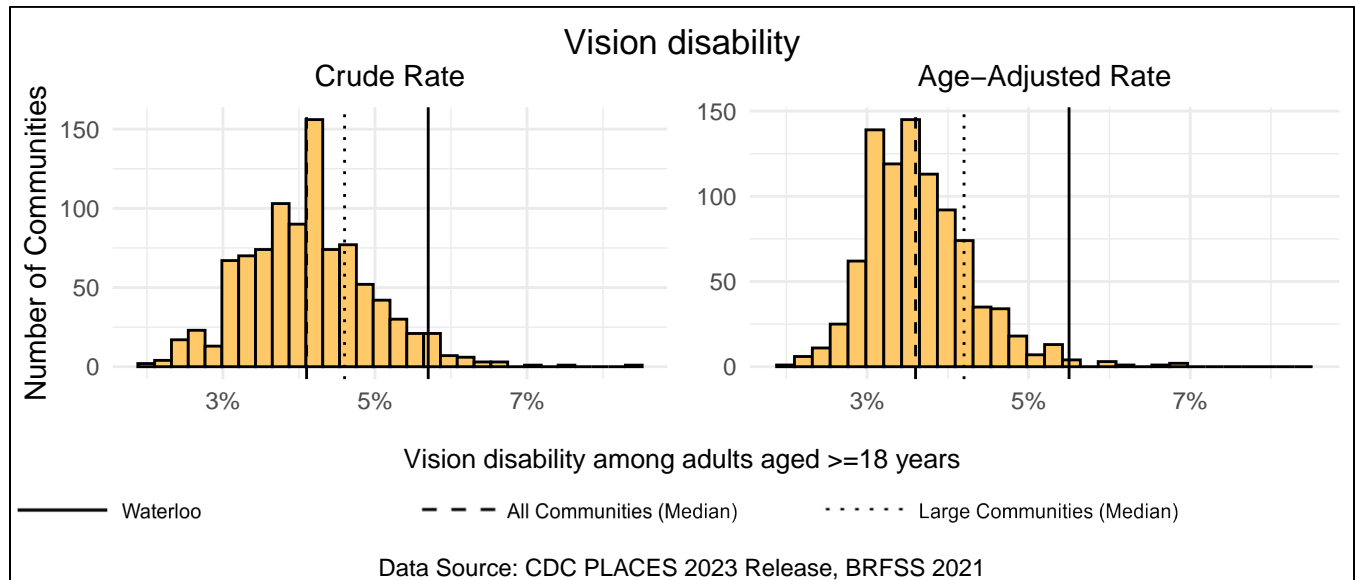

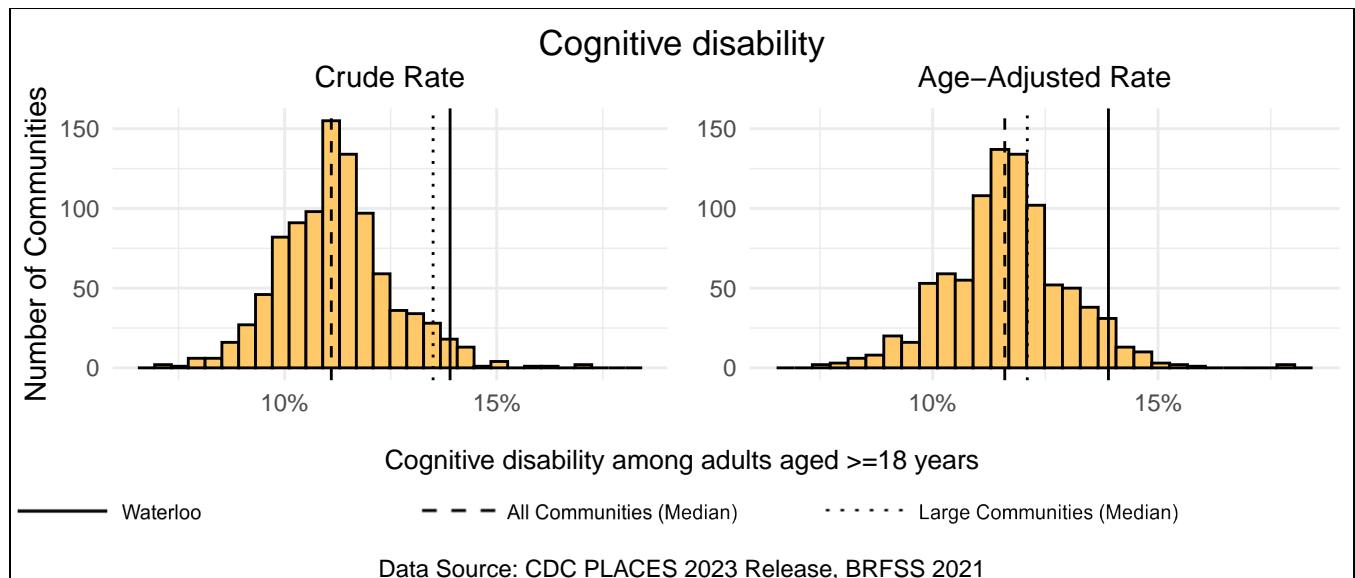

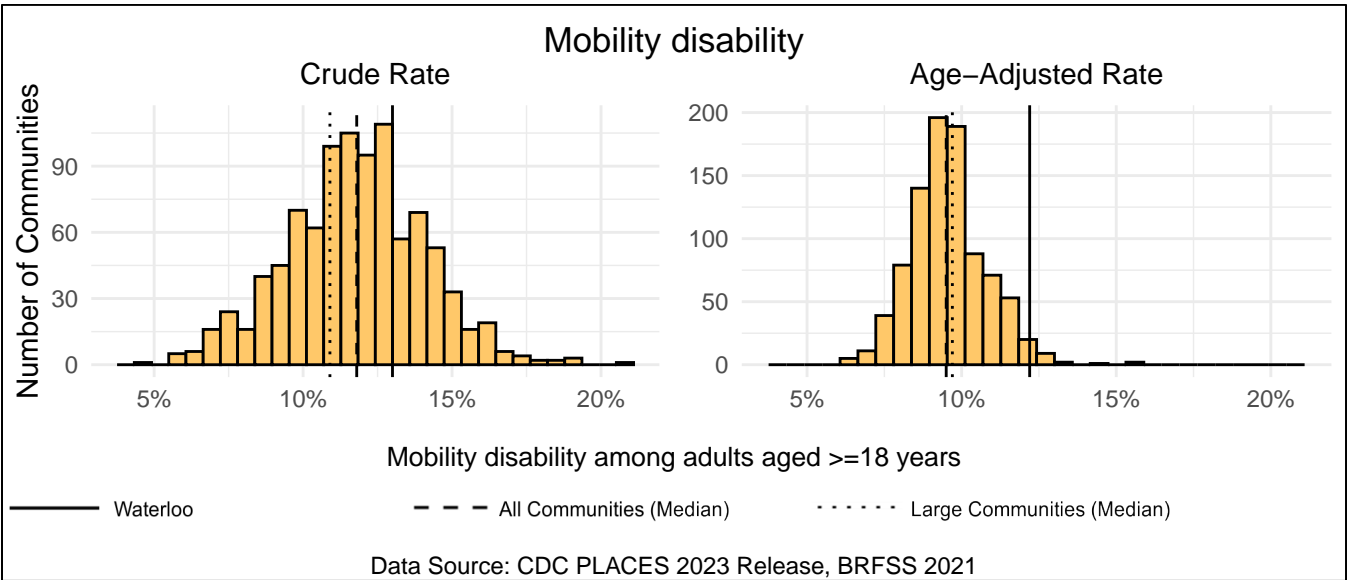

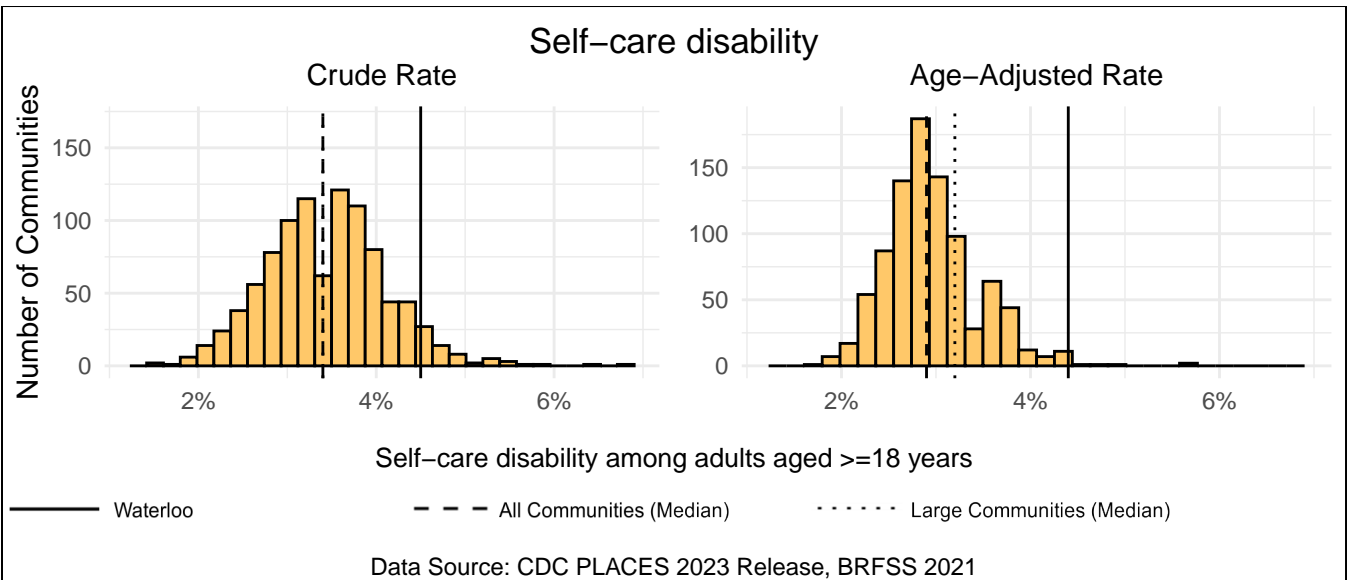

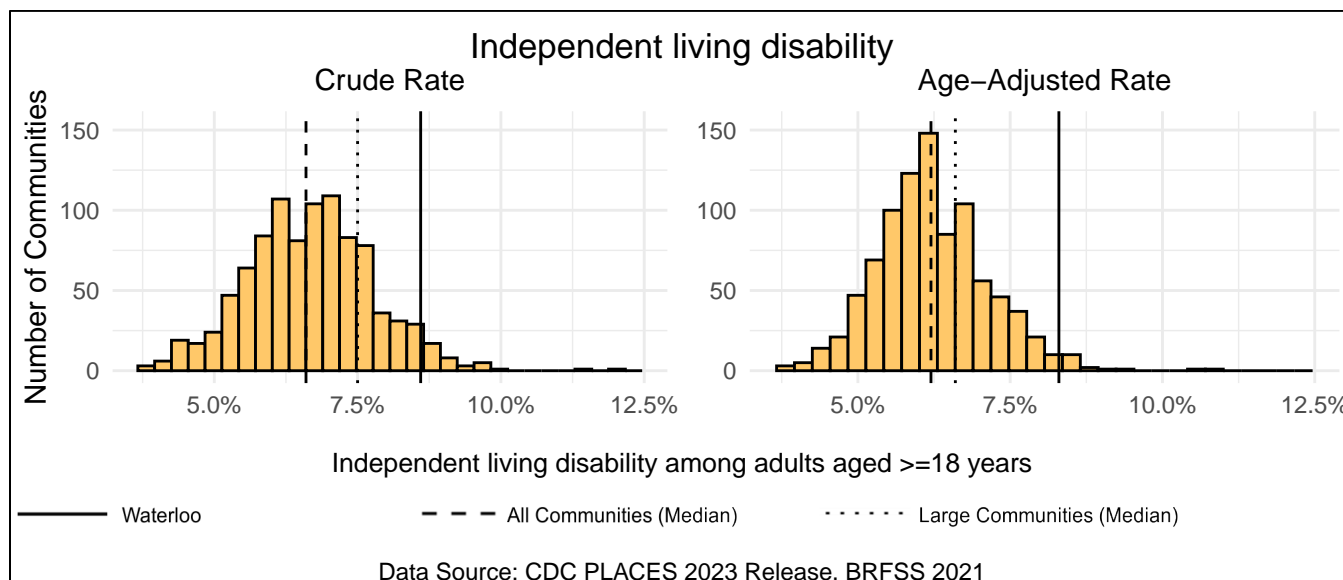

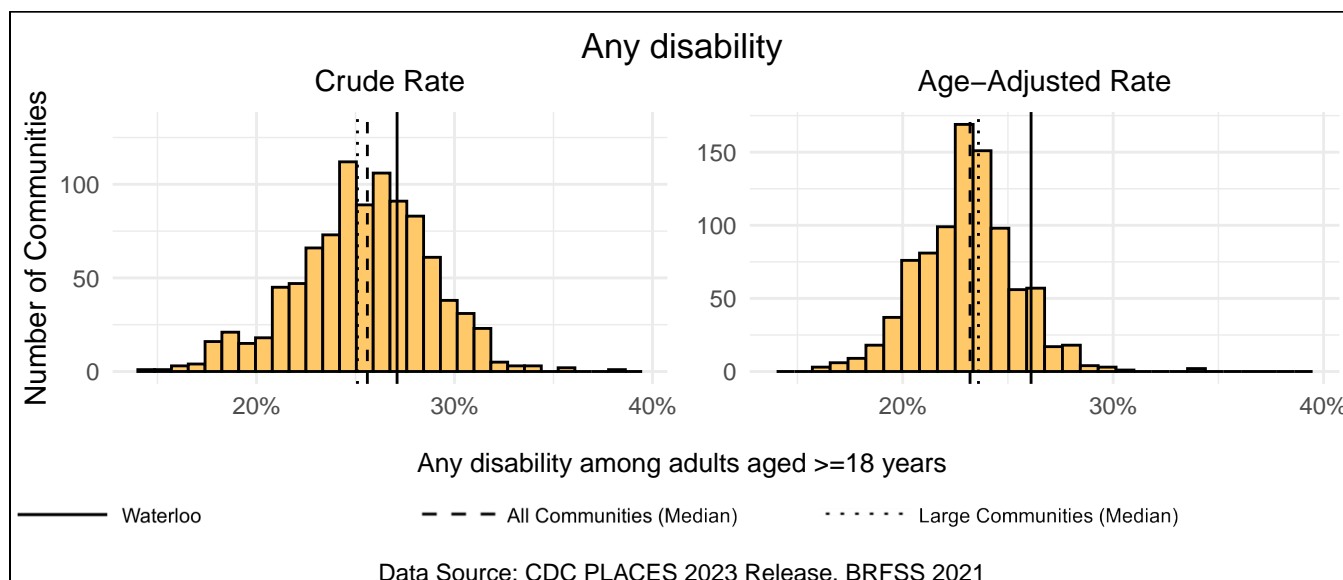

Appendix 1: CDC PLACES Data

This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.
