

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Health in Jefferson County: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Jefferson County,

We are pleased to share the Iowa County Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partner-ship with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa's 99 counties. The following pages include the health snapshot for your county. The snapshot can be used to see how Jefferson County ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized counties. This comparison allows us to identify Jefferson County's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your county ranks compared to all lowa counties and counties of similar size to Jefferson County. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your county and presents what the rate would be if your county had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between counties and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between counties with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your county! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your county's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the lowa County Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Jefferson County that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Jefferson County, a review of risky behaviors in the county, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Jefferson County compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized counties.

With a population of 15,647, Jefferson County's similarly sized counties are defined as micropolitan counties. In Iowa, micropolitan counties have an average population of 30,839, and there are 15 counties that are considered micropolitan counties. To learn more about the county population classifications used in this report, please see the information below the table as well as Appendix 3.


The counties included in each category above are determined by the United States Office of Management and Budget. Iowa has counties in nine metropolitan statistical areas and 15 micropolitan statistical areas. The counties identified as metropolitan and micropolitan can be found in the link and the maps below. Metropolitan core counties are those counties in metropolitan areas that have the city that defines the metropolitan area (e.g., Des Moines and Polk County for the Des Moines Metropolitan Area). Metropolitan non-core counties are those that fall within the metropolitan area, but do not have the core city of the metropolitan area (e.g., Dallas and Jasper Counties in the Des Moines Metropolitan Area).

Using Story County as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your county's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa counties and similarly-sized counties. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across counties. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific county compared to counties across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the county rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa counties and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized counties.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Story County, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the county. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Story County has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most counties in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized counties, indicating that when accounting for Story County's unique age distribution, Story County's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 14.8% for fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 42nd out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 13.6%, which ranks 57th out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Poor Physical Health

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 10.6% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 29th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 9.7%, which ranks 35th out of 99 lowa counties (4th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Poor Mental Health

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 13.4% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 6th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 14.4%, which ranks 5th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 15 similarly-sized counties).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 16.9% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 4th out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 19.0%, which ranks 3rd out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Current Smoking

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 15.5% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 19th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 16.6%, which ranks 21st out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Physical Inactivity

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 26.7% for no leisuretime physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 46th out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 25.7%, which ranks 61st out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Sleep <7 hours

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 29.0% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 17th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 30.5%, which ranks 23rd out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 15 similarly-sized counties).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Each measure is the percentage of respondents reporting receiving the diagnosis by a doctor, nurse, or other health professional. The link below includes more information about each variable.

Arthritis

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 26.6% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 18th out of 99 lowa counties (4th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 21.9%, which ranks 11th out of 99 lowa counties (4th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



High Blood Pressure

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 33.1% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 40th out of 99 lowa counties (7th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 28.3%, which ranks 62nd out of 99 lowa counties (10th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Cancer (except skin)

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 8.1% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 31st out of 99 lowa counties (8th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 6.3%, which ranks 8th out of 99 lowa counties (4th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Current Asthma

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 8.9% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 9.0%, which ranks 3rd out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Jefferson County has a crude rate of 7.0% for coronary heart disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 40th out of 99 lowa counties (7th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 5.3%, which ranks 62nd out of 99 lowa counties (9th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Jefferson County has a crude rate of 7.6% for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 35th out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 6.3%, which ranks 39th out of 99 lowa counties (7th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Jefferson County has a crude rate of 17.6% for depression among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 46th out of 99 lowa counties (4th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 18.2%, which ranks 19th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Diabetes

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 11.4% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 64th out of 99 lowa counties (11th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 9.3%, which ranks 78th out of 99 lowa counties (9th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



High Cholesterol

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 37.5% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 47th out of 99 lowa counties (9th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 30.3%, which ranks 66th out of 99 lowa counties (10th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Chronic Kidney Disease

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 3.3% for chronic kidney disease among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 33rd out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 2.7%, which ranks 49th out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Obesity

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 34.6% for obesity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 8th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 35.0%, which ranks 7th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Jefferson County has a crude rate of 3.4% for stroke among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 35th out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 2.7%, which ranks 45th out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Jefferson County has a crude rate of 10.7% for all teeth lost among adults aged >=65 years, which ranks 61st out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 11.2%, which ranks 45th out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).

Prevention



Lack of Health Insurance

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 8.0% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 54th out of 99 lowa counties (7th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 8.2%, which ranks 43rd out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Taking BP Medication

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 80.7% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 52nd out of 99 lowa counties (7th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 60.3%, which ranks 6th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Cervical Cancer Screening

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 81.1% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 85th out of 99 lowa counties (12th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 81.7%, which ranks 90th out of 99 lowa counties (12th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Annual Checkup

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 75.1% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 72nd out of 99 lowa counties (10th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The ageadjusted rate for Jefferson County is 72.4%, which ranks 60th out of 99 lowa counties (9th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Cholesterol Screening

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 80.9% for cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 84th out of 99 lowa counties (11th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 78.6%, which ranks 64th out of 99 lowa counties (11th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Colorectal Cancer Screening

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 72.4% for colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50–75 years, which ranks 69th out of 99 lowa counties (8th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 67.6%, which ranks 96th out of 99 lowa counties (13th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Core preventive services for older men

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 34.0% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 99th out of 99 lowa counties (15th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 34.7%, which ranks 99th out of 99 lowa counties (15th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Core preventive services for older women

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 39.6% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 37th out of 99 lowa counties (7th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 39.0%, which ranks 61st out of 99 lowa counties (10th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Dental Visit

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 67.9% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 29th out of 99 lowa counties (4th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 67.1%, which ranks 31st out of 99 lowa counties (4th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



Jefferson County has a crude rate of 73.0% for mammography use among women aged 50–74 years, which ranks 72nd out of 99 lowa counties (11th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 73.6%, which ranks 51st out of 99 lowa counties (7th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).

Disability


This section includes measures of physical and cognitive disabilities. Respondents were asked to report on six disabilities: hearing, vision, cognition, mobility, self-care, and independent living. Hearing disability

Jefferson County has a crude rate of 7.6% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 37th out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Jefferson County is 6.2%, which ranks 53rd out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 15 similarly-sized counties).



The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.







Fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years




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

Physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years




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


All Teeth Lost




Lack of Health Insurance

Current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18-64 years






Taking BP Medication

Taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure






Cervical Cancer Screening

Cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21-65 years






Annual Checkup

Visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years






Cholesterol Screening

Cholesterol screening among adults aged >=18 years






Colorectal Cancer Screening

Colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50-75 years






Core preventive services for older men

Older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: Flu shot past year, PPV shot ever, Colorectal cancer screening






Core preventive services for older women

Older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: Flu shot past year, PPV shot ever, Colorectal cancer screening,







Visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years






Mammography

Mammography use among women aged 50-74 years






Hearing disability

Hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years






Vision disability

Vision disability among adults aged >=18 years




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

Cognitive disability among adults aged >=18 years






Mobility disability

Mobility disability among adults aged >=18 years




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

Self-care disability among adults aged >=18 years






Independent living disability
