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Health in Story County: Overview

Dear Community Members & Stakeholders of Story County,

We are pleased to share the Iowa County Health Snapshot series, a set of reports designed in partnership with Iowa State University's Community Economic Development to assess the overall landscape of health and well-being across Iowa's 99 counties. The following pages include the health snapshot for your county. The snapshot can be used to see how Story County ranks across various health measures compared to the rest of the state and similarly-sized counties. This comparison allows us to identify Story County's strengths and opportunities for growth by leveraging data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention PLACES dataset.

The report includes 37 health measures organized topically by general health status, risky behavior, health outcomes, prevention, and disability. We provide a general overview of each health topic, followed by a description of each health measure. Health measure descriptions include crude and age-adjusted rates and a ranking that tells you how your county ranks compared to all Iowa counties and counties of similar size to Story County. Crude rates tell you the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Age-adjusted rates account for the age distribution present in your county and presents what the rate would be if your county had a standard age distribution. Crude rates can provide a general comparison between counties and age-adjusted rates can give a fairer comparison between counties with different age structures.

Take a look at the top strengths of your county! Below are unadjusted and age-adjusted health measures that represent your county's strengths. We recommend using continued investment in these areas to maintain them as strengths, as well as building on them to improve in other health domains.

How to Use this Report


The purpose of the Iowa County Health Snapshot Series is to provide an overview of health in Story County that can be used to help inform health-related interventions and programming. This report contains five sections, including the overall health status of Story County, a review of risky behaviors in the county, and information on various health outcomes, prevention measures, and disability needs. Each section includes an overview of the health domain, a breakdown of its underlying health measures, and data to see how Story County compares to the rest of the state and similarly-sized counties.

With a population of 99,472, Story County's similarly sized counties are defined as metropolitan core counties. In Iowa, metropolitan core counties have an average population of 175,797, and there are 9 counties that are considered metropolitan core counties. To learn more about the county population classifications used in this report, please see the information below the table as well as Appendix 3.


The counties included in each category above are determined by the United States Office of Management and Budget. Iowa has counties in nine metropolitan statistical areas and 15 micropolitan statistical areas. The counties identified as metropolitan and micropolitan can be found in the link and the maps below. Metropolitan core counties are those counties in metropolitan areas that have the city that defines the metropolitan area (e.g., Des Moines and Polk County for the Des Moines Metropolitan Area). Metropolitan non-core counties are those that fall within the metropolitan area, but do not have the core city of the metropolitan area (e.g., Dallas and Jasper Counties in the Des Moines Metropolitan Area).

Using Story County as an Example

The graphic below is an example of the details included for each health measure. The table in the upper right shows your county's crude and age-adjusted rate estimates alongside their averages across all lowa counties and similarly-sized counties. The images below show the distribution of the health measure across counties. The vertical lines correspond with the values in the table to show the estimate for the specific county compared to counties across the state. The solid black line in each plot represents the county rate, with the dashed lines indicating the average rate for all lowa counties and the dotted lines showing the average rate for similarly-sized counties.



The example graphic above displays the poor mental health rate in Story County, Iowa. The left plot shows the crude rate of poor mental health in the county. Crude rates are the raw, un-adjusted percent of the population experiencing the health measure. Notice how the solid black line is closer to the right of the plot than the dashed and dotted lines; this indicates that Story County has a higher crude rate of poor mental health than most counties in the state. However, the age-adjusted rate plot on the right shows the solid line closer to the peak of the distribution and averages for the state and similarly-sized counties, indicating that when accounting for Story County's unique age distribution, Story County's poor mental health rate is not a significant outlier, and is estimated to be lower than the statewide average. Accounting for crude and age-adjusted rates is critical to help inform health interventions as age-adjusted rates can help contextualize the health measure within the population.

Health Status


This section reflects measures for overall health, including general, physical, and mental health. These measures are a valuable way to see a simple summary of the health of a country's population. The questions to calculate these measures ask respondents to evaluate their health status. General health is evaluated on a 5-point scale where respondents can report their health status as one of "excellent," "very good," "good," "fair," or "poor," from which the respondents who answer "fair" or "poor" are included in the measure. Physical and mental health are evaluated as the rate of respondents who say they have had 14 or more days in the last 30 days in which their physical or mental health was not good. Poor General Health

Story County has a crude rate of 10.4% for fair or poor selfrated health status among adults aged >= 18 years, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarlysized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 11.7%, which ranks 13th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Poor Physical Health

Story County has a crude rate of 7.9% for physical health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 9.0%, which ranks 12th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Poor Mental Health

Story County has a crude rate of 15.9% for mental health not good for >=14 days among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 99th out of 99 lowa counties (9th out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 14.4%, which ranks 5th out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties).

Health Risk Behaviors


Health risk measures are measures of individual behaviors that can lead to poor health outcomes. These include binge drinking, current smoking, physical inactivity, and getting less than seven hours of nightly sleep. Risk behaviors are the most critical intervention points as they can help save lives and drastically improve health outcomes later in life. Each measure is calculated as the rate of respondents participating in a high level of risk behavior. The exact cutoff points for the behavior depend on the health area. Binge Drinking

Story County has a crude rate of 22.7% for binge drinking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 98th out of 99 lowa counties (9th out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 21.2%, which ranks 37th out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Current Smoking

Story County has a crude rate of 11.6% for current smoking among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 1st out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 14.2%, which ranks 4th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Physical Inactivity

Story County has a crude rate of 18.5% for no leisure-time physical activity among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 1st out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 20.3%, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Sleep <7 hours

Story County has a crude rate of 26.0% for sleeping less than 7 hours among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 27.6%, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties).

Health Outcomes


This section includes measures about specific health outcomes such as chronic illness, mental health conditions, and risk factors for future disease. Health outcome measures include but are not limited to arthritis, high blood pressure, cancer, depression, and obesity. Arthritis

Story County has a crude rate of 18.6% for arthritis among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 1st out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The ageadjusted rate for Story County is 22.6%, which ranks 27th out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



High Blood Pressure

Story County has a crude rate of 23.4% for high blood pressure among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 27.9%, which ranks 47th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 9 similarlysized counties).



Cancer (except skin)

Story County has a crude rate of 5.3% for cancer (excluding skin cancer) among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 1st out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarlysized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 6.4%, which ranks 26th out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Current Asthma

Story County has a crude rate of 9.4% for current asthma among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 64th out of 99 lowa counties (3rd out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 9.2%, which ranks 11th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 5.1%, which ranks 33rd out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).







Story County has a crude rate of 7.2% for diagnosed diabetes among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 1st out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 8.8%, which ranks 57th out of 99 lowa counties (6th out of 9 similarlysized counties).



High Cholesterol

Story County has a crude rate of 29.0% for high cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5 years, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The ageadjusted rate for Story County is 29.7%, which ranks 38th out of 99 lowa counties (4th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).









Prevention



Story County has a crude rate of 6.5% for current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18–64 years, which ranks 8th out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 6.6%, which ranks 4th out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Story County has a crude rate of 73.1% for taking medicine for high blood pressure control among adults aged >=18 years with high blood pressure, which ranks 98th out of 99 lowa counties (8th out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 59.7%, which ranks 28th out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Cervical Cancer Screening

Story County has a crude rate of 78.3% for cervical cancer screening among adult women aged 21–65 years, which ranks 99th out of 99 lowa counties (9th out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 83.2%, which ranks 39th out of 99 lowa counties (7th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Story County has a crude rate of 72.0% for visits to doctor for routine checkup within the past year among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 96th out of 99 lowa counties (8th out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 73.7%, which ranks 15th out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).





The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 74.4%, which ranks 4th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Core preventive services for older men

Story County has a crude rate of 51.8% for older adult men aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, which ranks 1st out of 99 Iowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The ageadjusted rate for Story County is 52.5%, which ranks 1st out of 99 Iowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Core preventive services for older women

Story County has a crude rate of 49.0% for older adult women aged >=65 years who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services: flu shot past year, ppv shot ever, colorectal cancer screening, and mammogram past 2 years, which ranks 1st out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 49.7%, which ranks 1st out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Dental Visit

Story County has a crude rate of 71.4% for visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 6th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 9 similarlysized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 70.5%, which ranks 7th out of 99 lowa counties (2nd out of 9 similarly-sized counties).



Disability



Hearing disability

Story County has a crude rate of 5.1% for hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years, which ranks 2nd out of 99 lowa counties (1st out of 9 similarly-sized counties). The age-adjusted rate for Story County is 5.8%, which ranks 16th out of 99 lowa counties (5th out of 9 similarly-sized counties).







This report uses a novel dataset from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) called PLACES: Local Data for Better Health. The PLACES dataset uses small area estimation methods to provide estimates of health measures for counties, places, census tracts, and zip code tabulation areas. The estimates are created with a multilevel statistical modeling framework that utilizes CDC's Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census population counts, and American Community Survey demographic and socioeconomic data.







Fair or poor self-rated health status among adults aged >= 18 years






Physical Inactivity (Age-Adjusted Rate) 30%






High Cholesterol

High cholesterol among adults aged >=18 years who have been screened in the past 5






Lack of Health Insurance

Current lack of health insurance among adults aged 18-64 years






Taking BP Medication

Colorectal cancer screening among adults aged 50-75 years









Core preventive services for older men (Age–Adjusted Rate)






Visits to dentist or dental clinic among adults aged >=18 years




Mammography




Hearing disability among adults aged >=18 years








Mobility disability among adults aged >=18 years










Self-care disability among adults aged >=18 years











Independent living disability among adults aged >=18 years
